MD, SSGC delivers inaugural address

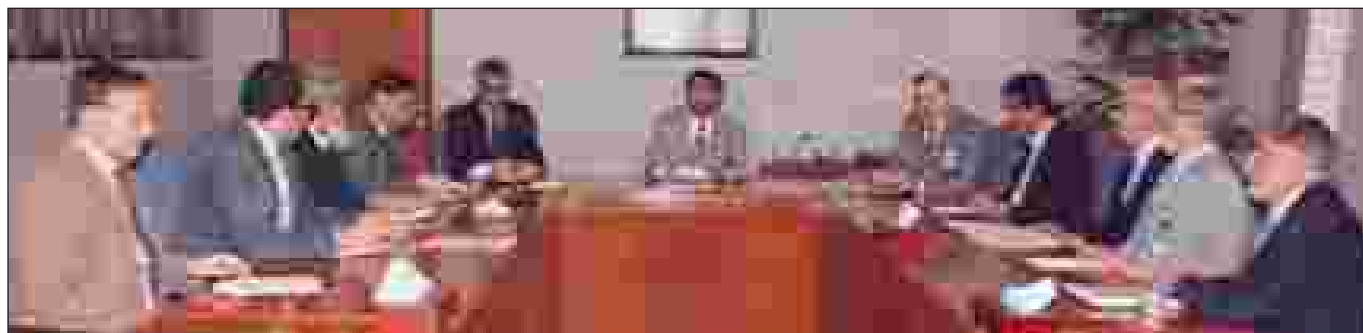

Gas to Seri town inaugurated

Syed Naveed Qamar, Federal Minister for Petroleum and Natural Resources inaugurated the supply of gas to Seri Town which is located near Hyderabad. The inauguration ceremony, held in Seri town on February 22, 2010, was also attended by Dr. Faizullah Abbasi, MD, SSGC.

Also present at the inauguration were Syed Mohsin Shah, MPA, Mir Ashraf Talpur, Nazim Seri, Mr. Shaukat Baloch, ASGM (Transmission), Mr. Mushtaq Siddiqui, AGM (Quetta), Syed Qasim Naveed Qamar and other Government and SSGC officials.

The project is being built at a cost of Rs. 19.18 million, out of which SSGC has contributed Rs. 3.13m while the Government of Sindh's share is Rs. 16.05m.

The 13-km pipeline project comprises a supply main of 4"

dia line of 3.534 km and distribution mains of 4", 2" and 1" dia covering distances of 0.798, 5.574 and 10.2 kms, respectively. ■

SSGC salutes its CRD heroes

This year on 10th Moharram, on that dreadful December day, Karachi was shaken by a horrific bomb blast that left behind a trail of death and destruction. Minutes after the blast, Customer Relations Department (CRD) received a complaint. In no time, our Service team comprising Ashraf Khan and Rizwan Mumtaz left office and reached the site.

Our CRD team found that a service line opposite Laxmi Building was on fire which was swiftly extinguished by the team using our own fire extinguishers. The team also plugged off the broken line. As a precautionary measure, six adjacent service lines were also closed.

During the process, DSM teams also reached the site and both teams coordinated with each other and not only prevented fire from spreading, but also helped in protecting gas installations. The teams remained at the site for more than twenty four hours which clearly shows their commitment towards work.

The next day the then City Nazim Mr. Mustafa Kamal met Mr. Ashraf and the DSM team who informed the

Nazim that gas had been disconnected to prevent further loss. Mr. Kamal was very pleased with the SSGC's emergency work and praised the SSGC men for their timely effort.

Mr. Ashraf along with DSM team also carried out the ditching and eliminated the line at Quettawala Market. During the process the building collapsed and the CRD teams managed a narrow escape.

Representatives of Pietro Fiorentini gave a presentation on its FIO or five-in-one automatic pressure management system to the Company's senior management.

Mr. Vito Cirreli of Pietro Fiorentini gave a comprehensive presentation to Dr. Faizullah Abbasi, MD, SSGC, Syed Hassan Nawab, DMD (Operations and Planning), Salim Ahmed Mughal, SGM (Distribution), Rahat Kamal Siddiqui, SGM (ES), Irfan Zafar, CTIO and other top managers on providing solutions for combating UFG.

His presentation centered on indirect flow measurement, outlet pressure local or remote set point control, flow limitation, remote monitoring and end-user management, five functions that are found in one device. Hence the term Five-in-One (FIO).

Mr. Cirreli was also aided by Mr. Mohammad Kaleem of Gas Engineering, Pietro Fiorentini's agent in Pakistan,

SSGC's meter manufacturing plant recently celebrated its highest record monthly production in the plant's premises. The meter plant produced 71,000 units in January, making it the most productive month ever.

Mustafa Abdulla, the then GM (Measurement/Meter Plant) and now GM (Cathodic Protection) joined his executives and staff as well as Peoples Labour Union (PLU)

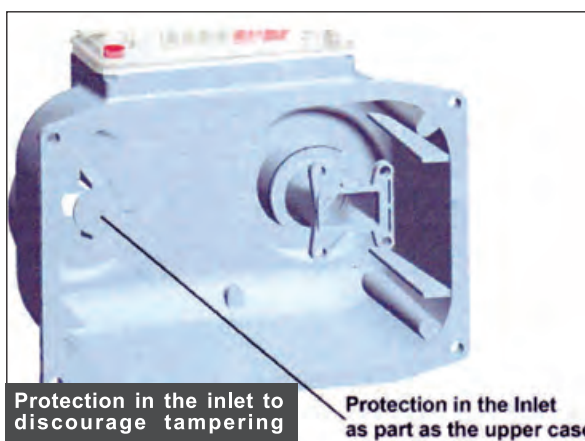
leaders in cutting a cake on February 1, 2010. Mr. Abdulla attributed the record production to team work yet stressed that the meter plant team must not get complacent but work even harder to improve on this feat.

The next day, Dr. Faizullah Abbasi, MD, SSGC also visited the Meter Plant and was taken on a guided tour of the facilities by Mr. Abdulla. ■

New G-4 version to be introduced

The meter manufacturing plant is manufacturing two types of meters, G-4 and G-1.6. The current year target is to produce 500,000 G-4 and 200,000 G-1.6 Meters. G-4 meters are produced under license from Itron of France. The meter plant is striving to keep up with new technologies to address the local conditions in Pakistan. A new version of G-4 meter is being introduced in the next financial year.

A lot of input was given both by SNGPL (which purchases 70% of the meter plant production) and SSGC along with Itron to upgrade meters vis-à-vis resistance to tampering, accuracy of meter, resistance to dust in gas, etc. Moreover, material quality for this new V-3 version meter for a number of moving parts has been improved to ensure meter's longer life and accuracy. ■

A place in the history

When SSGC's history will one day be written, Hameedullah Khattak is bound to get a deserving mention.

In 1954, as the Company's meter repair man, Mr. Khattak became the first person to have served tea to the Company's engineers and workers at Karachi Terminal (KT) from the gas distributed through the 16" dia Jhang Shahi to Karachi Terminal pipeline, the first pipeline to be laid to serve the Karachi customers.

In the late 1950s, he opened a valve to start a flare-up at the inauguration of a pipeline by the then President of Pakistan Iskander Mirza. Mr. Khattak retired as DM (Vigilance) in 1999.

A resident of D. G. Shah in Karak district in NWFP, Mr. Khattak is still going strong and sturdy in his mid-70s. He has also worked on a number of projects with Salim Ahmed Mughal, SGM (Distribution) for more than fifteen years. Recently he visited Mr. Mughal in his office and relived old memories. ■

Sukkur office holds CP Training program

A five-day technical training was conducted by Mr. Muhammad Saleem Manghi, Chief Engineer (CP), Distribution Sindh, Sukkur to impart basic knowledge of corrosion process for a better understanding of the cause of deterioration of SSGC's underground pipeline network.

Measures on how to prevent and combat corrosion occurrence on underground pipeline were also discussed. During the training, the participants were encouraged to give presentation on a selected topic to improve their confidence level. This made the training program quite interactive.

Besides the theory, practical demonstration of different tools used for coating inspection and monitoring of CP potential on pipelines was given. In this regard, the participants visited Cathodic Protection station powered by thermoelectric generator and solar power system at SITE area and Airport Road, Sukkur, respectively, where they were briefed about the working of Cathodic Protection system and its components.

Mustafa Ghumro, DCE (Ops), HQ-1 also arranged a refreshing tea party for the participants at the site of Solar CP system.

There are 150 CP stations in operation to prevent corrosion on Distribution Sindh pipeline network. Of them, 112 are operated with commercial power supply whereas 38 are thermoelectric generators.

Because of the commercial power supply not being stable, which interrupts the cathodic protection to our pipelines, SSGC has a continuous plan to replace the commercial power supply with thermoelectric generator and solar power system in order to provide uninterrupted CP to its pipelines. ■

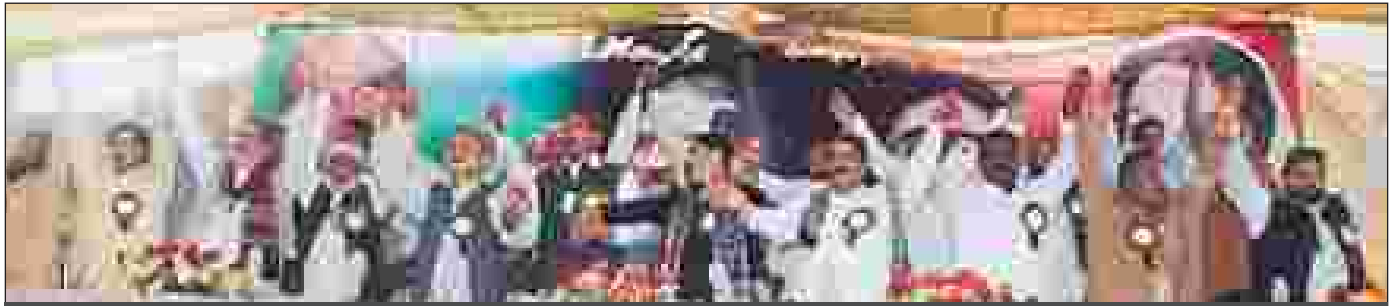

Mr. Baloch addressed the huge gathering and congratulated the Union for their continuous struggle in getting the Charter passed.

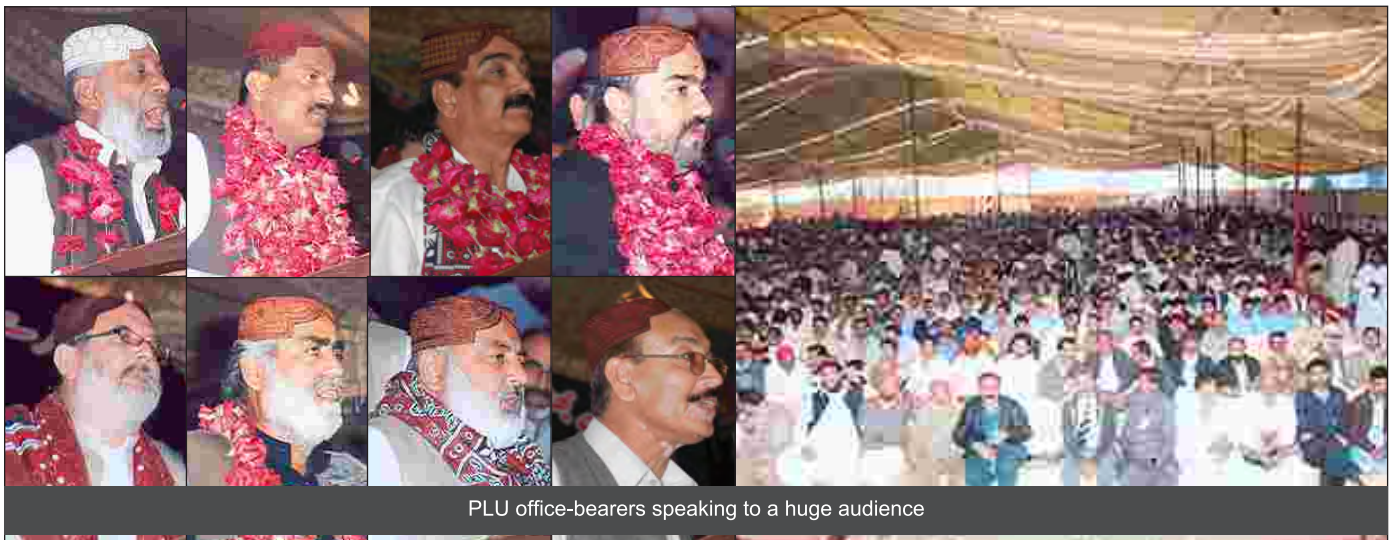

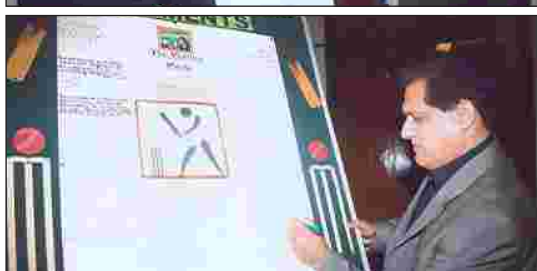
All of them shared interesting and at times humorous incidents and anecdotes about Hanif and Shoaib's cricketing career much to the interest and amusement of the audience.

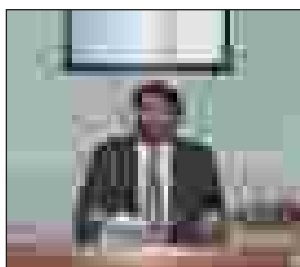


SSGOA congratulates MD

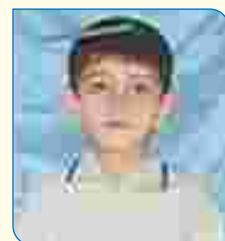

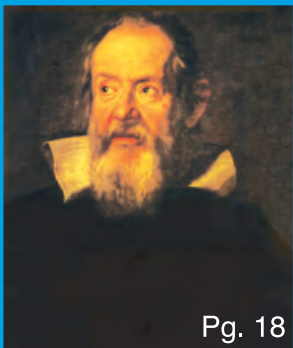

Please remember that many 'foolish' ideas have eventually become a reality and changed the course of history.

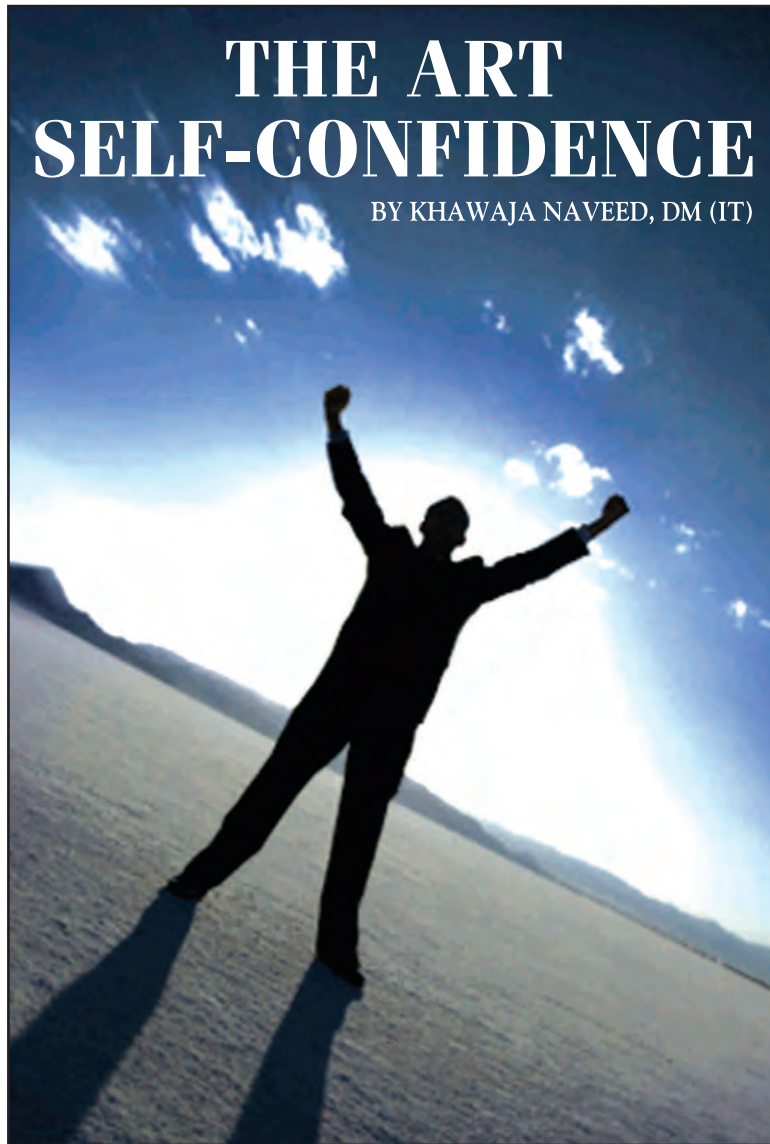
Take the case of Galileo. He was the first person who proclaimed: "The Earth revolves around the Sun." Until then, the whole world believed that the Sun revolved around the Earth. Everyone thought that Galileo had made a foolish statement. He was accused of misguiding people and challenging religious faith, and was imprisoned by the

Catholic Church. In those days the Catholic Church was very powerful in Italy and it was virtually ruling the country. The Church believed that God created the earth first and then created Sun to provide light and heat!

In Galileo I find a man full of self-confidence, a man who trusted himself. Otherwise, he would not have had the courage to utter such 'foolish' and rebellious statement and stick to his words defying the punishment.

Hundreds of years have passed since then. Now we respect him as great discoverer, who created a major turning point in the study of astronomy.

What I am trying to impress upon you is the role of self-confidence in every success story. To help you build self-confidence, I have a capsule for you.



Every morning and evening, in a serene and peaceful atmosphere, close your eyes and proclaim loudly the following statements:

- I trust myself more than anybody else.
- I am competent as any other person.
- I will work hard to achieve my goals.
- I am more confident today than I was yesterday.

Some people may think that this is foolish advice. But I am sure that, its regular practice will bring about a change in your attitude to life and work, and that this will mark a turning point in your life. ■

New Company Rules (Alternatively Speaking)

Sick Days

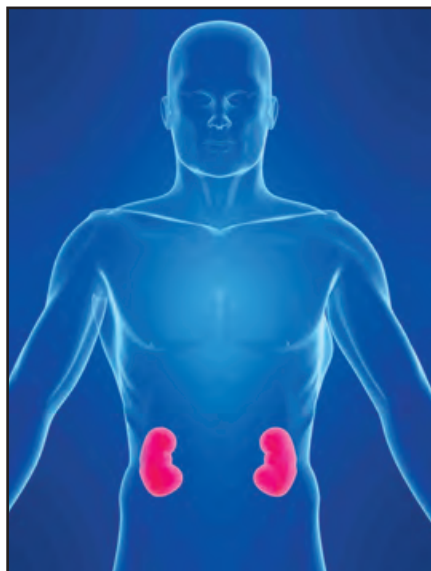

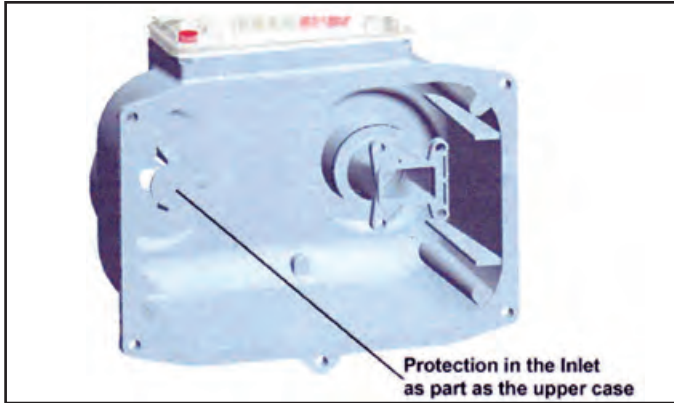
