The meeting was held on September 13, 2012 at SSGC House, Karachi. Representatives of 4Gas Asia explained their proposal which focused on many facets of the retrofitting model for using SSGC's existing LPG terminal facilities at Port Qasim Authority for

the purpose of importing LNG.

Dr. Asim Hussain was accompanied in the discussions by Azim Iqbal Siddiqui, MD, SSGC, Rahat Kamal Siddiqui, SGM (Engineering Services) and Malik Usman Hasan, COO (SSGC-LPG Pvt. Ltd.).

4Gas is one of several international companies that submitted their financial proposal in response to SSGC's invitation for setting up a retrofitting terminal using SSGC's LPG Terminal facilities to make it suitable for LNG reception, storage and re-gasification. Dr. Asim Hussain said that the Government is determined to bring LNG through integrated and fast track means and would give backup to SSGC's guarantees. ■

## NA Speaker inaugurates supply of gas in Badin villages



NA speaker praying for the success of the newly inaugurated scheme

Dr. Fehmida Mirza, Speaker National Assembly inaugurated the supply of gas to the Malkani Sharif

and Khairpur Gambo villages in Tando Bago, Badin on September 18, 2012. The project entailed

laying a 6" dia supply main of 15 km and 4", 2" and 1" dia distribution mains spanning 1.6, 6.9 and 6.0 kms respectively. The total length of the pipeline built at a cost of Rs. 92.7 million is 30 kms.

## Joint team undertakes raid in Karachi's Quetta Town

A joint team comprising of CRD Task Force, Sales, S&M and DSM (West) undertook a raid against gas theft culprits in Quetta Town located at Super Highway, Karachi.

During the raids conducted on September 3 and 4, 2012, the team discovered that nearly 1-km long locally made plastic pipes of different sizes were laid and tapped with SSGC's supply main of 125 mm for providing illegal and unauthorized gas connections to

the residents of Quetta Town, Sector 18/A. The Task Force found out that the residents were using gas from five illegal connections.

The Task Force summarily removed the illegal underground plastic pipeline network while the DSM team welded the source/tee connection from where the gas was illegally consumed. ■

## Sukkur, Khairpur teams take swift action

Representatives of CRD, Distribution and S&M Departments based in Sukkur and Khairpur conducted a raid in Karamabad Zone, Khairpur on September 6, 2012. The joint team discovered that a customer was found using gas illegally for commercial purposes in his small factory involved in fixing burst tyres.

The raiding team dismantled the service line and removed the meter for testing in the meter proving laboratory so that the theft claims may be raised. The joint team consisted of CRD Sukkur's DCM

Zameer Hussain Wassan, Executive G. Murtaza Ghumro, DM, S&M (Sukkur) Sardar Baloch, and Khairpur Region's DM, CRD Mir Hassan Laghari and Executive (Distribution) M. Akbar Matelo.

### Raid in Ghari Mori

Another joint action was taken against individuals engaged in gas theft on September 11, 2012 in Ghari Mori subzone of Piryaloi town where they found some unregistered customers using gas from supply mains through 2" and 1" dia underground clamps for domestic purposes. The Team

summarily removed these clamps.

## Maintenance team intensifies crackdown against gas thieves

SSGC's anti-gas theft campaigns have further intensified in the recent months in its franchise provinces of Sindh and Balochistan. In late August 2012, the Quetta's Maintenance Department team comprising Muhammad Anwar Baloch, Zonal Manager, Sher Muhammad, Engineer, Samiullah Sanjrani, Asst. Engineer and Muhammad Younus, Welding Supervisor detected illegal use of gas at various locations in Quetta.

On August 30, 2012, the team conducted a raid in the city's Sumalani Town and Labour Colony in Eastern Bypass and discovered that the residents had punctured 2" dia pipeline and were using gas directly through 3/4" dia fixed clamps extended by rubber pipes without any regulator. By acting

swiftly, the team disconnected the gas supply and applied for registration of FIR against the culprits.

Mustafa Abdulla, ASGM (Distribution-North) who was on an official visit to Quetta also met the raiding team and inspected the

confiscated rubber pipes and other accessories. Haroon Rasheed, AGM (D-Balochistan) and M. Anwar Baloch, Zonal Manager, Quetta briefed the ASGM about the raid. ■

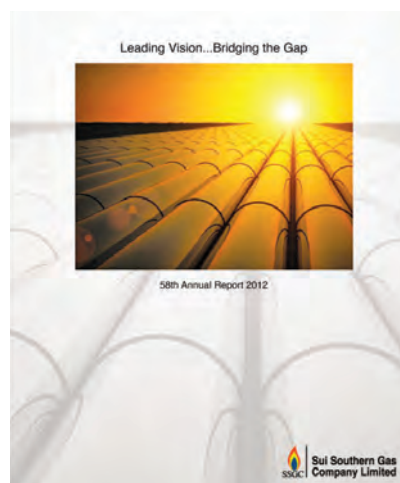

## Shaukat Baloch - A man fond of challenges

The history of SSGC is replete with exemplary performance of its officers, who did their duty with relentless dedication and devotion in the Company's best interest and raised the image of their organization.

Shaukat Hussain Baloch, Senior General Manager (Transmission) retired on July 1, 2012 after 31 years of illustrious service. He was interviewed in September, 2012 by the representative of The Flame Muhammad Ali Gohar, DCM (CCD) at his residence.

### Early years

Shaukat Hussain Baloch was born in Hyderabad on July 1, 1952. He wanted to be an engineer from an early age and his father and other family members also had the same desire. He obtained his primary education from Mian Ali Baksh Government Primary School, Hyderabad and passed his matriculation from Noor Muhammad High School, Hyderabad in flying colours.

Mr. Shaukat then did his FSc. (Pre-Engineering) from Government College, Hyderabad with distinction.

To realize his dream he got admission in Sindh University Engineering College (now Mehran University of Engineering and Technology, Jamshoro) from where he obtained his Mechanical Engineering degree.

Mr. Shaukat's first job was with Allied Paper Industries, Thatta but he wanted to move ahead and decided to proceed to UK so that he could serve his country better after obtaining higher education.

In the UK, he obtained a Post-graduate Diploma in Control System Technology from the University of Surrey, England. Then in 1980 he got a Masters' degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow.

### Professional career

Mr. Shaukat joined SSGC as Assistant Mechanical Engineer on April 15, 1981. He was posted initially in the P&D Department where he got the opportunity to tackle many challenging projects.

He was then promoted to Grade 4 and sent to Sui in Balochistan to work on Sui Compressor Station Installation Project. This project offered a huge challenge to him because it was the opinion of the famous foreign company, Dresser and Co. that it was not a very feasible proposition, while the SSGC management believed that it was practicable and 'do-able' assignment. As he had been selected to do this task, Mr. Shaukat undertook it in all seriousness and with the guidance of his seniors, his own untiring efforts and the blessings of Allah Almighty, he worked hard and on June 30, 1984 (which was the Eid day) at 10 pm he informed the Company management by telex that the Compressor has been successfully commissioned in Sui.

Impressed by his performance, in 1986 he then GM (P&D)

Mukhtar Ahmed (later MD of the Company) placed him on an important construction project called the Sui Purification Plant Bank project which he and his team completed as per schedule in 1988. The same year he was appointed Senior Maintenance Engineer, Sui Purification Plant. In 1992 he was transferred to the HSE Department, while he was also assisting the late Nauman Ansari, SGM (T).

In 1993 he was promoted to the rank of Chief Engineer (Special Assignment) and sent to Canada to receive specialized training on "Maintenance and Operation of Pipeline". On his return from abroad he was transferred to P&D Department.

Mr. Shaukat Baloch's career blossomed over the years in SSGC as per following:

- 1995 - Promoted as Chief Engineer (Purification Plant Cell)
- 1996 - DGM (PP Cell)
- 2000 - DGM (Regional Manager) Hyderabad
- 2001 - GM (Distribution)
- 2005 - GM (Transmission)
- 2007 - GM (Interior Sindh)
- 2010 - SGM (T) in which capacity he worked till retirement.

### Secret of success

Mr. Shaukat believes in the dignity of honest hard work and it was this quality which took him to the senior management level. He believes that anyone who works efficiently will be successful. He said with great pride that after 1980 all the successful projects involving Compressors in Sui are to his credit. He praised Mr. Mukhtar Ahmed and the late Nauman Ansari and said that he personally had learned much from such distinguished senior officers.



### Family

About his own family, Mr. Shaukat stated that his father, Mitha Khan, was an office Superintendent in the Police Department. His father was also a famous artist of Sindh, accomplished in the art of '*ghara-bajana*' (drumming the clay pot). Former President Ghulam Ishaq Khan had conferred Mr. Khan a presidential award for his musical accomplishments.

Mr. Shaukat's mother is alive and well. His wife, Dr. Rashida Zardari, is posted in the Health Department of Gulshan-e-Iqbal Town, Karachi. His son Zafar Hussain Baloch has obtained a degree in Finance and Accounting from the University of Manchester. His elder daughter Zareen Baloch is doing BBA from IBA while the younger daughter Mehreen Baloch is an 'A' level student at Beaconhouse School.

The trainer interspersed classroom training with practical demonstrations



GTI Hyderabad recently conducted a two-day training on "Corrosion and Cathodic Protection Techniques" for the subordinate staff of Hyderabad region. Naik Muhammad Shaikh, DCE (CP) supervised the training from September 4-5, 2012. The focus of the training was to apprise the staff involved in the field of operation and maintenance of gas pipeline about methods to ensure the integrity of underground and overhead structure against corrosion and protect the pipelines through existing resources.

Mr. Shaikh prepared this course material in Urdu language so that all subordinate employees could easily understand. He used videos and photographs of corrosion and showed how it develops in pipelines through a brief presentation.

The trainer also dwelled on the types of corrosion, soil classifications, environment conditions affecting the pipe and how corrosion can be mitigated through cathodic protection, coating and painting. He also focused on how corrosion directly impacts UFG.

During the training all the participants took part in practical use of instruments in fields like ultrasonic thickness gauge, pit gauge, line locator, holiday detector and PSP taking by multimeter with half cell electrode. Amir Jatoi, Assistant CP assisted Naik Muhammad during the sessions.

On the last day of the training, Ghulam Muhammad Mangi, Chief Engineer /Incharge (CP) Hyderabad, GTI distributed the certificates to the participants. Talking to the participants, Mr. Mangi said that cathodic protection is the back bone of pipeline and cathodic engineers are like doctors who diagnose the disease of corrosion.

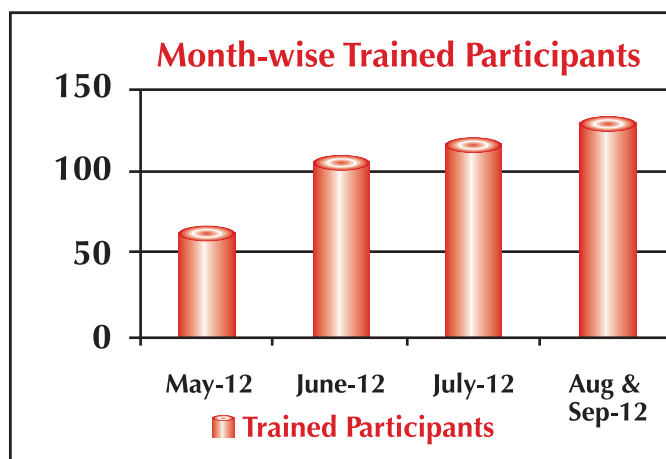
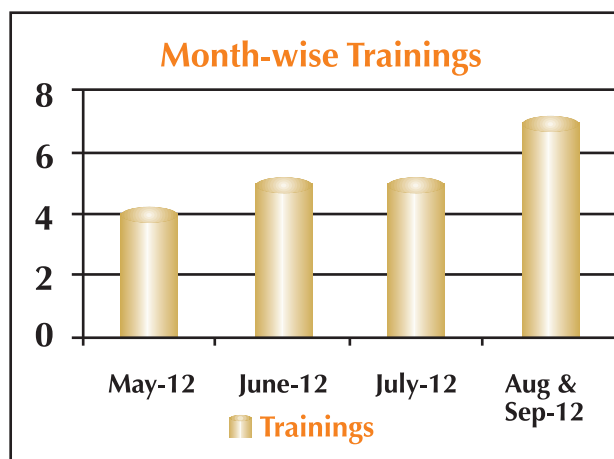
Trainings have already been arranged for the employees of Sukkur, Larkana, Nawabshah and Hyderabad at their respective

## Fruits and their benefits

### Cherries

Cherries have the highest content of iron and disease fighting antioxidants compared to other fruits. The fruits contain vitamin C and E, iron, fiber, potassium and magnesium. Cherries can reduce cholesterol level, insulin levels and blood sugar, besides raising the antioxidant capacity of the blood. Every 100 grams of fresh cherries have higher percentage of vitamin A which is five times more than apples and grapes and twenty fresh cherries may keep us away from depression mood.

### Grapes

Grapes are good for females since they help them to avoid the painful wound related with breast cancer treatment. Grapes also protect heart and blood vessels against oxidative tissue damage. Hypertension could be controlled by consuming one cup of grape juice and one cup of celery juice each with warm water three times a day for twenty days. ### Oranges

Orange is one of most popular fruits in the world. It is a citrus fruit with excellent source of vitamin C. They are also good source of dietary fiber, vitamin A, B, B1, calcium and potassium. By consuming oranges frequently we can reduce the risk of cancers and heart diseases. Oranges containing the smooth textured skin will have higher juice content than those that are spongy or lighter in weight. Small oranges are juicier than the larger ones.

### Grapefruit

Grapefruit has lot of natural fiber and reduces the blood pressure, blood sugar, cholesterol, insulin, cardiovascular diseases, etc. It also promotes salivary and gastric digestion, eases constipation, stimulates appetite, maintains the health of intestines, etc. Infact, this is the best fruit to protect us from diseases like dysentery, diarrhea, typhus, etc. It also induces the production of enzymes to prevent from cancer. Patients suffering from diabetics are advised to eat three grapefruits three times everyday to improve their diabetic condition. The purple grape fruit with plenty of antioxidant compounds is recommended for great health benefits. It protects from liver and kidney disorders and also improves skin form.

### Strawberries

Strawberry is the most delicious and nutritious fruit that has the ability to remove harmful toxin in the blood. This fruit is recommended for constipation, high blood pressure, skin cancer, sluggish liver, rheumatism etc. It is yet another fruit which is consumed as skin cleansing food. The strawberry is cut into half and rubbed on teeth and gums to remove tartar from the teeth and to strengthen and heal the gums. In order to dissolve the tartar the juice has to remain on teeth as long as possible and later the mouth has to be rinsed with warm water.



### Banana

Banana has a high amount of carbohydrate that can be transformed into energy in our body. Its nutrient benefits our heart, kidney, muscle, nerve and bones. For the people suffering with symptoms like potassium deficiency which include mind fogginess, nervous shaking, body tiredness, excessive perspiration of their limbs, etc., can be improved by eating banana.

### Apple

Modern scientific studies discovered that an "An Apple a day keeps the doctor away". While diabetes patients are supposed to eat sour apple, people suffering from cardiovascular and obesity should eat sweet apple. Eating a ripe apple is a good remedy to cure constipation. The powerful antioxidants and anthocyanin found in red apples prevent us from cancer development and cardiovascular disease.

### Pomegranate

According to studies pomegranate juice daily help support the normal blood flow to the heart due to which it reduces the risk of having heart diseases and heart attacks. The antioxidant properties in pomegranate keep away from forming bad cholesterol and also help in keeping the arteries clear of clots. It may also help reduce the risks of diabetes, cancer etc. This fruit is a good natural source of vitamins A, C, E and folic acid.

Pomegranate supports the blood by supplying it with iron which also may help protect anemia symptoms like weakness, dizziness, hear loss and exhaustion. ■

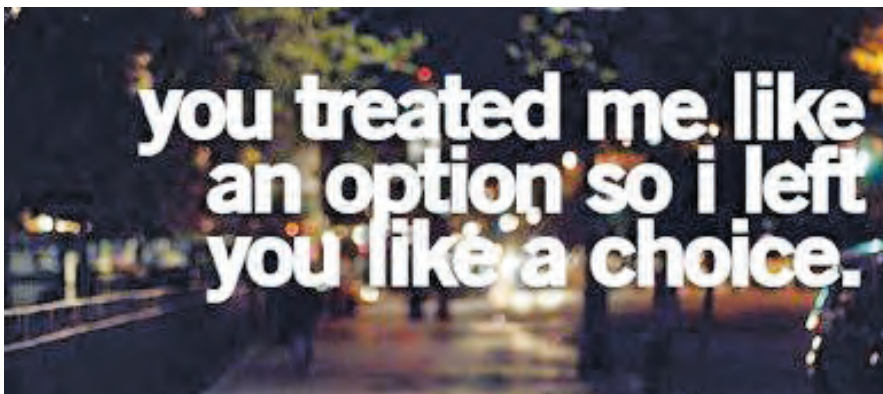
you could do is make a lot of noise about changing things, only to revert to the old destructive, familiar patterns. To talk about change and not to do it is to teach that person to treat your statements and
