Pakistan's first-ever Tight Gas Agreement signed

Pakistan's first-ever Tight Gas Sales Agreement was signed between SSGC and a consortium of Polish Oil and Gas Company (PGNiG SA) and Pakistan Petroleum Limited (PPL) in Islamabad on November 13, 2012. Zuhair Siddiqui, MD, SSGC, Asim Murtaza Khan, MD, PPL and Waldemar Wojciech Bak, Managing Director PGNiG (Pakistan Branch), signed the agreement in the presence of Dr. Asim Hussain, Advisor to the Prime Minister on Petroleum and Natural Resources (P&NR), Yusuf J. Ansari, SGM (Corporate and Legal Affairs) and ljazuddin Faruqi, ASGM (Transmission).

Subsequent to this landmark agreement, SSGC will receive 20 mmcfd gas into its system by May 2013 through two wells, each with a capacity of producing 10 mmcfd gas. This gas will be dedicated for value added production in the Nooriabad Industrial Area near Karachi. PGNiG has already invested \$40 million in this project.

Speaking on the occasion, the Advisor to the PM on P&NR reiterated that the agreement was a significant step in the implementation of Pakistan's Tight Gas Policy announced in 2011 for providing economically viable alternative sources of energy. He stressed that the Government of Pakistan has introduced incentives and investor friendly policies for boosting investment in the energy sector for substantially bridging the gap in the demand and supply of natural gas.

In his remarks, Zuhair Siddiqui,



MD, SSGC said that the gas utility shares a common vision with PGNiG and PPL for leading the industry in unconventional gas production and hoped that the collective efforts will ensure energy sustainability and security.

For the implementation of this

project, SSGC has been awarded a contract of Rs. 235 million following a tendering process for the construction of 8" and 6" dia, 52-km pipeline from Rehman Gas Field which will be integrated in SSGC's system at Naing Valve Assembly on 24" dia Bhit Gas pipeline. The project will be commissioned by May 2013.

Federal Defence Minister inaugurates gas supply to **Tando Mohammad Khan villages**

SSGC has been continuously working on village gasification projects with special emphasis on providing gas in the franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan.

On November 4, 2012, Syed Naveed Qamar, Federal Minister for Defence inaugurated the commissioning of nine villages located in his constituency Tando Mohammad Khan by unveiling the commemorative plaque. These included Kado Machi, Jamal Kachi, Khamiso Shoro, Kando Shoro, Noor Mohammad Solangi, Haji Jamshoro, Shaikh Bhirkio, Mullan and Mohammad Thebo. The projects were completed at a cost of Rs. 123 million and stand to benefit 10,000 inhabitants of the area.

In his address, Mr. Qamar lauded the efforts and efficiency of SSGC engineers for completing this project on time. He said that the present Government was determined to ensure that natural gas reaches every nook and corner of the province.

Earlier, Mustafa Abdulla, ASGM (Distribution-N) said that over the last four years, SSGC has completed laying of 314 kms of gas pipeline projects by virtue of which 109 villages in Mr. Qamar's constituency (NA-222) were gasified at a total cost of Rs. 600 million. The meeting expressed concern at the problem of low pressure in a number of industrial estates including SITE.

From the SSGC side, Shoaib Warsi, SGM (UFG), Aminullah Khan, ASGM (Distribution-South), Major Mohammad Akhtar (R), ASGM (CS) and Shakeel Bukhari, GM (Measurement), assisted the MD.

The SSGC management reiterated that the Company is taking all measures at its disposal to continue to build the gas line pack situation, for ensuring uninterrupted supply to all the customers, including the industrial units.

The MD said that in order to shore up the line pack it has become imperative to shut down gas supply

to all industrial units in Sindh once every week for 24 hours on sundays but for this measure to work it is important that the units fully cooperate with SSGC.

The MD added that any unit not observing a day long closure on Sundays will face a strong punitive action in the form of gas shutdown to such units for the next 48 hours. Improvement in line pack will help in distributing gas to KESC for ameliorating the power outages situation to a large extent, the management explained to the SITE representatives.

The SSGC management also informed the participants that the



gas supply situation will improve in the coming months since some 90 mmcfd gas will arrive from some new supply sources including Sinjhoro and Kunnar Pasakhi fields.

The Chairman recalled that the Government announced a loan running into billions at a very nominal interest payable over ten years, followed by a sizeable grant by the Japanese government, Saudi Government, the European Community and Kuwait Development Fund.

Mr. Jilani remembered that the implementation was not without its share of challenges in the form of traditional resistance to construction of roads through sensitive areas, age old corrupt practices and lack of trained and motivated staff, all of which were deftly overcome through handling by the then Governor and divisional commissioners. Mr. Jilani recounted that Project Balochistan brought





about a massive change not just to the localities where the projects started but in the attitude of the people too. There was a great perceptible sense of people's involvement and in two to three years, by the time he had left Balochistan to take up his next assignment, most of the schemes

were completed and peace reigned over this largest province of Pakistan for quite sometime, the Chairman concluded.

Hyderabad's Task Force goes full throttle against gas

CRD Hyderabad's Gas Theft Task Force team after detecting illegal and un-authorized use of gas through rubber pipes in different parts of the city undertook a successful exercise of disconnecting illegal connections,



removing rubber pipes, gas theft points and dummy meters. As part of SSGC's ongoing initiative against UFG, the Task Force team, in conjunction with other departments, undertook raids at Bakhtawar Colony, Baldia Colony and Hala Nakka. The team was Jamil Ahmed, Dy. Chief Engineer CRD (Gas Theft Control Section).

At the site, the team discovered that the company's 2" dia pipeline was punctured. The inhabitants were using gas directly through rubber pipe with the help of clamps. Through this illegitimate arrangement, more than 65 houses

were using gas. The team instantly removed all rubber pipes, clamps and rectified the gas pipeline by welding all the punctured spots.

ASGM (D-N) inspects UFG control activities in Hyderabad


One of the regular tasks undertaken by Mustafa Abdulla, ASGM (Distribution-North) is routine visits of interior Sindh to supervise ongoing UFG control activities. These activities involve underground leak survey, followed by digging and repair of leaks in pipeline and leak survey of above ground piping and meter connection, followed by replacement of defective sections of pipe and fittings and PUG meters. During these activities theft cases are also identified and corrective actions are taken on the spot.

The engineers informed ASGM (DN) that most theft cases are due to delays in providing legal connections to the domestic consumers. They pointed out that the Company's approved contractors are mostly responsible for this delay in providing legal connection to domestic gas consumers.

A Q&A session followed the presentations. The last item of the seminar was a quiz in which the chief guest asked the participants questions about the presentations.



Stress as an Ergonomics Hazard

The term Ergonomics is used for work place hazards in HSE. Stress in the workplace can be defined as the harmful physical and emotional responses that occur when the requirements of the job do not match the capabilities, resources, or needs of the worker. Workplace stress can lead to poor health and even injury. It is seen that for 10 women there is one man prey to this disease.

The concept of job stress is often confused with challenge, but these concepts are not the same. Challenge energizes us psychologically and physically, and it motivates us to learn new skills and master our jobs. When a challenge is met, we feel relaxed and satisfied. The importance of challenge in our work lives is probably what people are

referring to when they say "a little bit of stress is good for you".

Causes of job stress

According to one school of thought, differences in individual characteristics, such as personality and coping style, are most important in predicting whether certain job conditions will result in stress - in other words, what is stressful for one person may not be a problem for someone else. This viewpoint leads to prevention strategies that focus on workers

and ways to help them cope with demanding job conditions.

Scientific evidence suggests that certain working conditions, such as excessive workload demands and conflicting expectations, are stressful to most people. Such evidence argues for a greater emphasis on working conditions, as the key source of workplace stress, and for job redesign as a primary prevention strategy.

Job conditions that may lead to stress

The design of tasks: Heavy workload, infrequent rest breaks, long working hours and shift work; hectic and routine tasks that have little inherent meaning, do not utilize workers' skills, and provide little sense of control.

Management style: Lack of participation by workers in decision-making, poor communication in the organization, lack of family-friendly policies.

Interpersonal relationships: Poor social environment and lack of support from coworkers and supervisors.

Work roles: Conflicting or uncertain job expectations, too much responsibility, too many "hats to wear".

Career concerns: Job insecurity and lack of opportunity for growth, advancement, or promotion; rapid changes for which workers are unprepared.

Environmental conditions: Unpleasant or dangerous

physical conditions such as crowding, noise, air pollution, or ergonomic problems.

Job stress and health

Stress sets off an alarm in the brain, which responds by preparing the body for defensive action. The nervous system is aroused and hormones are released to sharpen the senses, quicken the pulse, deepen respiration, and tense the muscles. This response (sometimes called the fight or flight response) is important because it helps us defend against threatening situations.

Short-lived or infrequent episodes of stress pose little risk. But when stressful situations go unresolved, the

body is kept in a constant state of activation, which increases the rate of wear and tear to biological systems. Ultimately, fatigue or damage results and the ability of the body to repair and defend itself can become seriously compromised. As a result, the risk of injury or disease escalates.

Evidence is rapidly accumulating to suggest that stress plays an important role in several types of chronic health problems - especially cardiovascular disease, musculoskeletal disorders, and psychological disorders. Health care

expenditures are nearly 50% greater for workers who report high levels of stress.

Early warning signs of job stress


- Headache
- Difficulty in concentrating
- Upset stomach
- Low morale
- Sleep disturbances
- Short temper
- Job dissatisfaction

Steps toward prevention

- Low morale, health and job complaints, and employee turnover often provide the first signs of job stress. But sometimes there are no clues, especially if employees are fearful of losing their jobs. Lack of obvious or widespread signs is not a good reason to dismiss concerns about job stress or minimize the importance of a prevention program.
- Even the most conscientious efforts to improve working conditions are unlikely to eliminate stress completely for all workers. For this reason, a combination of organizational change and stress management is often the most useful approach for preventing stress at work.
- Introducing site chair massage as an initial stress management technique is a good incentive for employee health and wellness participation.

The world at 8 billion: Sustainable?

Introduction

The challenge for mankind is to take the appropriate action early enough to avoid an 8-Billion person stampede, as some nations have already commenced the race to secure the energy, food and water that all citizens need.


Demand for oil has also changed dramatically. Passenger jet travel was born in 1958 when Boeing unveiled the 707, while the era of mass automobile ownership was only just beginning: Toyota sold its first car in the United States in 1957, while in Britain the first Mini rolled off the production line in 1959.

Energy demand is forecast to increase by more than 50% between 2010 and 2035. And over the same timeframe, world population is expected to expand from 6.9 billion to almost 8.6 billion. Eighty million people a year are joining the global middle class approximately half in China. This is more than double the recent historical average of 30 million. These new consumers need energy for homes, for appliances, automobiles and workplaces. This creates significantly higher oil demand in the developing countries. 92% of oil demand growth will come from the emerging non-OECD countries. This means that oil demand from these countries will be far more resilient and strong over the next decades than what has been witnessed up until now.

Role of various fuels in 2035

Fossil fuels - which currently account for 87% of the world's energy supply - will still contribute 82% by 2035. Oil will retain the largest share for most of the period to 2035, although its overall share falls from 34% to 28%, it will remain central to growth in many areas of the global economy, especially the transportation sector. Currently, more than a third of our energy portfolio and almost all the energy use in the transport sector rely on oil. At the same time there have been huge leaps in the improvement of car engine's fuel efficiency. Coal's share remains similar to that of today, at around 29% in 2035. Keep in mind that an earlier transition - from coal to oil as the world's leading energy source - took about a century. And even decades afterward, coal remains the secondleading source.

For oil, conventional as well as non-conventional resources are sufficient for the foreseeable future. Significant increases in conventional oil supply from Brazil, the Caspian Region, and of course OPEC, as well as steady increases in non-conventional oil and natural gas liquids will be coming to meet the rising demand. It is expected that U.S. shale liquids production to grow 150% by 2012. Thanks to both shale and the Canadian oil sands, North America

could become self-sufficient in oil as well by 2035 and even a net exporter. As the previously discovered fields began reaching maturity in the 1990s, many of them ceased to be commercially attractive to the handful of major British and Norwegian companies. Twenty years ago, the rule of thumb in the North Sea was that no field was economically viable if it held less than 60 million barrels of oil. Today the cut-off point is nearer three (3) million barrels when the fields are economical and small oil companies are making their fortune in such fields.

In terms of non-fossil fuels, renewable energy grows fast. But as it starts from a low base, its share will still be only 3% by 2035. It will take decades for renewable sources to achieve the price competitiveness and scale, they'll need to meet a major portion of society's energy needs. Hydropower will increase only a little - to 3% by 2035. Nuclear power will also witness some expansion, although prospects have been affected by events in Fukushima. It is seen as having only a 6% share in 2035. The new shale technologies are being applied to production of light, low-sulfur liquids. Keep in mind that U.S oil reserves peaked in 1970, then by 2008 had fallen by half. But since then reserves have grown, while annual production is up 14% mostly from shale. This is the first meaningful growth in 20 years.

As recently as the early 1990s U.S. natural gas production, reserves and demand were all falling. But since 2007 proven reserves are up 68%. The U.S. now has nearly a century of natural gas supply and production is up one-third, just since 2005, with further growth of 20% expected by 2035.

The greater availability of natural gas has brought prices down and helped revive demand, particularly in energy-intensive industries. Construction of new petrochemical plants, steel mills and other facilities in the U.S. has been

undertaken in last two years that would have gone elsewhere due to the technological breakthrough of shale gas.

The near-global availability of LNG is already helping fill the energy gap created by countries that are abandoning nuclear power following Fukushima. And for countries that wish to quickly and inexpensively reduce their greenhouse gas emissions, natural gas can replace other fossil fuels.

The European Union is currently importing more than 80% of its oil needs. Even with the energy efficiency policies and broader energy base strategy, this figure may increase up to 90% or more within ten years. Challenge therefore is to keep a secure and affordable oil supply against a background of rising demand from other parts of the world to ensure European energy supplies.

Investments in oil and gas industry

Significant investments are being made today. For the five-year period 2012 - 2016, OPEC's Member Countries currently have 116 upstream projects in their portfolio. Should all projects be realized, this could translate into an investment figure of close to \$280 billion. The IEA estimates that cumulative investments of \$20 trillion will be necessary to satisfy energy demand by 2035.

Taking into account all OPEC liquids, the net increase is estimated to be close to 7 million barrels per day, above 2012 levels. Moreover, technological advances will continue to extend the reach of the oil & gas industry helping to reduce costs, unlock additional resources and increase supplies. It is clear that future oil demand can be met.

Availability of trained manpower in oil and gas industry. The oil industry has experienced a number of "boom

The oil industry has experienced a number of "boom and bust" cycles since the 1970's and each oil price crash has led to massive cuts to keep operating costs

low. Unfortunately the first cuts almost always hit training budgets, and the 10\$ oil in the late 90's once again - predictably led to a freeze on hiring new graduates into the industry and massive cuts in training and development. In the 1990's there were thousands of graduates in Petroleum Engineering worldwide, however by 2005 there were only a handful. This trend was exacerbated by the rise in demand for graduates in the dotcom businesses of IT and telecommunication. By the early years of the 21st century it was obvious that the combination of the lack of graduates, cuts in International Oil Company (IOC) training budgets and the looming retirement of the baby boomers (in USA) lead to severe shortages in the marketplace - a radical change in strategy would be required to ensure that projects would continue.


The industry faces a severe shortage of the talented engineers, geoscientists and project managers, and there's no way that smaller Exploration and Production companies can retain this full capability in house for very long. The ageing of trained manpower in oil and gas industry is being viewed as a serious threat to implementation of the huge investments being made in the industry. The National Oil Companies (NOCs), super majors, independents and service companies needs to adapt to the changing demands of the industry. There remains a significant need to transfer skills from the talented oilfield workers of the IOCs' to the developing staff of the NOCs - driven by the demographics in these countries, the aspirations of the NOCs and the competitive necessities of the market place.

Such oil giants as Halliburton, Saudi Aramco, BP, Shell, Unocal, etc. have aligned their training experience and resources for the purpose of offering important, non-unique training by forming a joint institute Petroskills to train their manpower. The more dynamic, flexible and collaborative the industry becomes, the better position it will be in to help keep the lights on.

How to eliminate germs

All clothes, sponges and towels should be washed above 60°C to kill germs or they should be disinfected regularly;
