MoU signed for LNG supply to SSGC



SSGC and United LNG of the USA recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) pertaining to the supply of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG).

The MoU was signed in Houston, USA on December 12, 2012, the second day of the Pakistan Petroleum Exploration Promotion Conference 2012, by Zuhair Siddiqui, MD SSGC and Stephen Payne, Chairman, United LNG.

According to the MoU signed between SSGC and United LNG, the later will supply 4 million metric tons of LNG per year to SSGC.

As per the MoU, Pakistan will also own share in Liquefaction facilities in Gulf of Mexico together with United LNG of USA. In order to ensure firm and continuous supplies of LNG, dedicated ships will be inducted for transportation of LNG to Pakistan.

The ceremony was witnessed by Dr. Asim Hussain, Advisor to the Prime Minister on Petroleum and Natural Resources who was leading Pakistan's delegation to Houston, USA and London, UK to showcase investment opportunities offered by newly announced Petroleum (Exploration and

Production) Policy-2012 to International Exploration and Production Companies.

It is expected that the landed cost of LNG with an inbuilt cap, including transportation and re-gasification cost, the price of gas will be less than the price of Iran-Pakistan Gas Pipeline Project and Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan-India (TAPI) Gas Pipeline Project.

As per the MoU, Pakistan will also own share in Liquefaction facilities in Gulf of Mexico together with United LNG of USA. In order to ensure firm and continuous supplies of LNG, dedicated ships will be inducted for transportation of LNG to Pakistan.

Dr. Asim Hussain added after the signing of MoU that the import of LNG will supplement the efforts of the Ministry aiming at ensuring energy security of the country. ■

Winter Campaign gets into full throttle with seminar on safety measures Ulemas, SSGC executives stress on safe gas use

SSGC'S Winter Media Safety Campaign 2012-13, a regular annual Company event through which the concerned departments create awareness among the stakeholders about safe use of gas-related appliances, moved into top gear in December 2012. Two



events, including a seminar organized by the lead department CCD with support from Regional Office Quetta on the 9th, followed by a media briefing the next day, stressed on safe use of gas appliances especially since every winter many people die due to gas suffocation brought about by their failure to use gas heaters properly.

The seminar also provided an opportunity for the SSGC's executives to discuss anti-gas theft measures taken by the Company to substantially reduce UFG.

The seminar on December 9, 2012 featured local ulemas and Company executives based in Balochistan Region. One by one, the speakers emphasized on the need to adopt safety measures to control incidents of gas suffocation especially when the mercury drops during winters. They urged on the consumers to use their appliances on need basis by switching off their heaters after warming the room and turning them off while leaving the room and turning off the gas

valve before going to bed.

While addressing the participants, Inayatullah Ismail, CM (Media Relations), SSGC pointed out that due to the scattered demographics, a single gas connection costs Rs. 300,000 in Balochistan while it is almost 1/3rd in other provinces.

He said that despite this huge disparity in costs, SSGC was working on expanding its distribution network by reaching out to the far flung areas. He said that SSGC's media campaign creates awareness about safety measures by also incorporating ulemas' message about the use of legitimate gas which clearly shows the role of ulemas in community development. Mr. Ismail along with other speakers urged the Ulemas and local leaders to educate the public about safe and legal gas usage in their sermons.

The respected Ulemas who addressed the seminar included Abdul Rahim Rahimee, Maulana Ifthikar, Qari Nizamuddin Haqqani, Hafiz Abdul Haq Haqqani, Mohammad Qasim and Sufi Ghulam Nabi. They reiterated that food cooked from stolen gas was haram and asked the consumers to refrain from such illegal activity. The Ulema stressed that natural



gas is a gift of God and every measure should be taken by both the gas utility and the consumers to conserve it.

In his address, Rafiq Baloch, Regional Manager, Balochistan Region, in reply to the Ulemas' demand of exempting religious places from paying gas bills said that fixation of gas rates was OGRA's responsibility and not SSGC's.

Expressing concern over the gas related deaths, Shamsullah Kakar, ACM (CRD-Balochistan Region) said that last year as many as 17 people died and 36 suffered injuries while this winter so far 6 people have lost their lives because of their inability to use heating appliances properly. Shehzad Alam, Engineer, HSEQA also spoke on the occasion.

CCD's Uzair Ahmed, DM (Advertising) and Mohammad Rizwan Ansari, Executive were also present to ensure a successful seminar. ■

Quetta's media briefing answers queries about safety media campaign and gas theft



As part of the 'Winter Media Safety Campaign 2012-13', a briefing was held in Quetta to apprise the media fraternity about the measures taken by SSGC to ensure safe use of natural gas, its customer service initiatives and the Company's efforts to ensure uninterrupted gas supply to Balochistan region. The briefing was organized by CCD with support from Balochistan Region's team at a Quetta hotel on December 10, 2012.

Addressing a large gathering of mediapersons, Haroon Rasheed, DGM/Incharge (Distribution-Balochistan Region) said that with the advent of winter, gas pressure

drops but SSGC in its capacity is doing all it can to ensure steady supply and pressure.

He said that gas theft has contributed to reduced pressure but said his team is using all resources available to it to crackdown on the perpetrators.

Mr. Rasheed added that gas losses in Balochistan come to around 40% which has caused a loss of Rs. 1 billion that needs to be recovered. Incharge Balochistan Region urged on the media to help the Company recover this huge amount that can be used to provide better customer

service. Mr. Rasheed said that the media can play a pivotal role in creating awareness to the consumers about the safe use of gas and related appliances so that precious lives can be saved. Others who spoke on the occasion were Balochistan Region's Rafiq Baloch, Regional Manager, Shamsullah Kakar, ACM (CRD) and Inayatullah Ismail, CM (Media Relations).

A number of queries were raised by the mediapersons about UFG, gas distribution situation and winter campaign which were deftly handled by the SSGC personnel. The briefing was followed by a hearty dinner. ■



BQATI, management discusses distribution issues

Office bearers of Bin Qasim Association of Trade and Industry (BQATI) recently visited SSGC to discuss gas supply issues to the industrial area. Zuhair Siddiqui, MD, SSGC chaired the meeting that was held on December 19, 2012.

Shoab Warsi, SGM (UFG), Aminullah Khan, ASGM (Distribution-South), Major Mohammad Akhtar (R), ASGM (Customer Services), Majid Malik, GM (Distribution-East) and Fayyaz Merchant, GM (Coordination Cell) accompanied the MD during the talks. The BQATI delegation comprised of Mian Muhammad Ahmed, Patron-in-Chief and Founder President, Usman Ahmed, President, Abdul Rasheed Jan Mohammad, Vice President and Shakil Ashfaq, Member, Managing Committee.

The BQATI office bearers were of the

view that since gas supply to industries are closed on Sundays, pressure problems prevail for the rest of the week thus hampering production processes of especially processing plants running to meet the export orders.

The SSGC management maintained that it has been forced to curtail gas supply due to uneven distribution from the gas fields which has in turn severely impacted the line pack situation. The management informed the visitors that Sunday closures which began more than a year ago have boosted up supply to 83 mscfd yet it requires the support of the industries to ensure that gas supply position improves markedly. The management attributed the curtailed supply of gas to major gap in demand and supply, corroded pipelines and mushrooming of CNG

stations. The Company management lamented the fact that many industries shut off their gas supplies when the monitoring teams visited their respective industries only to turn them back on when the teams leave the sites.

It was also suggested by the management that in order to ensure uninterrupted gas supply, especially during peak shaving periods, the industries can resort to setting up dedicated LPG-Air Mix Plants (Synthetic Natural Gas) which can also act as a backup system if the traditional supply is erratic. The management also pointed out that the consumers will not end up paying inflated bills for using SNG since the cost is calculated on the basis of weighted average cost and besides it will still be much less expensive than furnace oil. The MD stressed



that SNG can act as a useful trade off between permanently closing down units than paying slightly higher tariffs.

After the meeting, the BQATI office bearers presented a memento to the MD to felicitate him on his recent appointment as the Company chief executive. ■

Management briefs trade bodies about line pack situation



Representatives from a number of associations representing textile units held talks with Zuhair Siddiqui, MD, SSGC at the Company Head Office on December 24, 2012. On the agenda was the issue of curtailment of gas supply every Sunday for the objective of improving the line pack situation and overall pressure for the next six days.

The MD informed the delegation that despite strict enforcement, 2/3rd of the industrial units does not observe closure with the result that the Company continues to face shortage of gas. He said that only the export processing units which had to meet

urgent orders were provided with gas on Sundays. The MD also added that despite the fact KESC's receivables have been rising, the Company continues to provide the electric company with 120 mmcf of gas, even though the latter has refused to sign a GSA in this regard. The visitors assured SSGC of cooperation in the current scenario and said that the Association will notify SSGC of those units that are not observing closures.

The MD was assisted in the meeting by Shoab Warsi, SGM (UFG) and Major Mohammad (R) Akhtar, ASGM (Customer Services). Towels

Manufacturing Association of Pakistan was represented by Mehtabuddin Chawla, Central Chairman and members Ali Raza, Feroze Alam Lari, Waqar Alam, Syed Usman Ali, Naqi Bari and Rehan Mehtab Chawla and Muzammil Hussain. Also present were Jawed Bilwani, Central Chairman, Pakistan Hosiery Manufacturers Association, Rafiq Habib Godil, Central Chairman, Pakistan Knitwear Sweater Exporters Association, Shaikh Shafiq, Central Chairman, Pakistan Ready Made Garments Manufacturers Exporters Association and Zain Bashir, Central Chairman, Pakistan Bedwear Exporters Association. ■

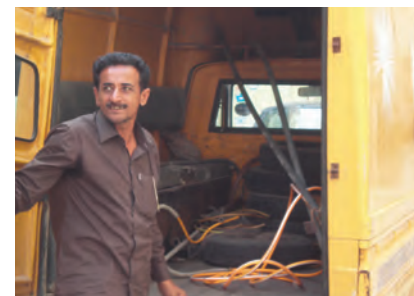


CRD takes action against direct gas

On information from reliable sources, the CRD team conducted a raid on direct use of gas in Fahad Square located in Scheme-33, Gulzar-e-Hijri, Karachi in December 2012. Being

a sensitive area owing to the prevailing law and order condition, the CRD team in coordination with the Company's Security Services Department, headed by Major Faraz

Ahmed and the area police, raided the apartment building and disconnected about 25 to 30 domestic and 4 commercial illegal connections. ■



Task Force takes on Ramazan Goth miscreants

CRD Task Force led by Abdul Razzak, Chief Manager (CRD) and comprising of former DCM (CRD) Qadeer Ahmed, Nawab Ali Shah of Security Services and the local police raided Ramazan Sheikh Jogi Goth

on December 24, 2012. The team found that illegal gas was being used through overhead and underground rubber pipes, extended and distributed from vacated service valves. The Task Force team

disconnected about 85 houses using illegal/ unregistered gas through rubber pipes, removed overhead/ underground laid rubber pipes and plugged service valves. ■

S&M undertakes a major raid in Karachi outskirts

S&M Department, along with the DSM team undertook a major raid in an illegal facility located in an area between Saadi Town and Safora Goth on December 21, 2012.

The teams discovered that the facility was being used as a laundry where some 15 to 20 workers were using gas directly from 3/4" underground clamps by puncturing 6" dia main service line. Acting

promptly, the DSM team killed the service by summarily removing the clamp. The S&M team was led by Major (R) Mohammad Hussain, DGM (S&M). ■



Sukkur teams conduct raids despite stiff resistance

A joint action against gas theft culprits was taken on December 17, 2012 under the supervision of Subhan Ali Dasti, Zonal Manager Khairpur and Zameer Hussain Wassan, Regional Incharge, CRD Sukkur in Government Scrape Colony, Khairpur where some fifteen residents were using gas through clamps.

With the help of digging and welding teams, clamps were removed. 5 illegal clamps were also removed from the officers' bungalows. The raiding teams faced tough resistance from the residents. The theft case was detected by Mir Hassan Laghari, Incharge CRD Khairpur. Other members who took part in the

action included Sukkur CRD's focal person for gas theft control Senior engineer Bashir Ahmed Bharo, CRD Incharge Khairpur, Amanullah Sheikh and executives (Distribution) M. Akber Metalo and Chander Mal.

Good governance, according to Salim Abbas Jilani



1944: Mr. Jilani at age 7

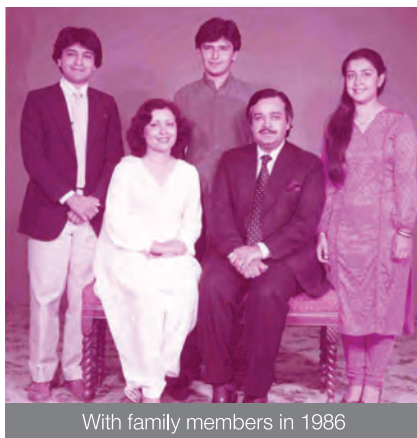
In February 2008, Salim Abbas Jilani, Former Federal Minister for Defence and Defence Production was appointed Chairman of SSGC, the office he held till November 30, 2012. Mr. Jilani who had carved out a reputation as an honest and committed public servant and was revered in political, agricultural, military and bureaucratic circles made his presence felt in SSGC with his deep knowledge of energy-related issues and the Company's board and management's regard for his ideas and business solutions. Mr. Jilani recently sat down with The Flame Editorial Team in his DHA Karachi home to talk about his prolific and unblemished career. He shared some memorable experiences in different postings, gave pointers for effective management and expressed his hope that the Company by surmounting some urgent technical and non-technical issues will continue to move forward.

Younger Days

I was born in Jhelum but since my father was in Police, he would be posted in different cities and towns which explained why I had schooling from Sialkot, Burewala, Gujrat and Multan. I did my Masters in Political Science from Government College Lahore in 1st Class with Roll of Honours. In 1957, I joined the Civil Service of Pakistan. A little later, I proceeded to UK where I secured my Diploma in Public Administration from St. John's School, Cambridge

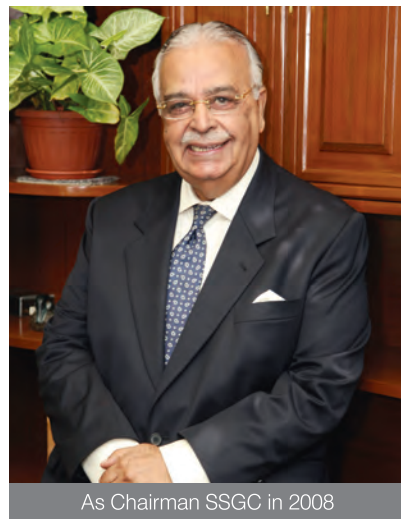
University. My first real posting was as Assistant Commissioner in Peshawar. I was selected for political cadre whereby I was required to serve in the Frontier regions (Tribal regions). Subsequently I served in Mardan, Peshawar, Malakand Agency and then in early 1970s as Commissioner of Peshawar, a privileged position which allowed me to serve a greater area that included Swat, Chitral, Orackzai and Kurram Agency.

I distinctly remember my tenure as Deputy Commissioner, Sialkot in 1965, when during the Presidential elections, I was pressurized to take sides in the polls but being the returning officer I maintained my neutrality. I had to pay a heavy price for this act by being transferred to the remote area of Kharan. Such incidents are part of the civil service career and while they may hurt an individual momentarily yet it is one's clean reputation that travels with him.

Although I have been fortunate that I have formulated and implemented many big projects, it is smaller projects such as building roads and schools in down trodden areas that have given me greatest satisfaction. Those were the days when there was more focus on quality work than on politics. We were young and full of energy and regarded public service as *ibadat*. I am glad to say that the projects that I implemented were invariably people oriented. I should also add here that people who have benefited from our schemes still remember me and send me gifts as

a token of respect.

Before and well after I retired from civil service in 1996, I have had the distinction of having held the most coveted jobs in Pakistan including that of Federal Minister for Defence and Defence Production, Defence Secretary and Chairman of PIA, Civil Aviation Authority, Fauji Foundation, Pakistan Steel, KESC, Rice Export Corporation of Pakistan, PARCO and more recently of SSGC. Moreover, I have been Chief Secretary of the provinces of Sindh and Balochistan. In 1988 I was appointed Principal Secretary to late Prime Minister Benazir Bhutto. Apart from the fact that the Bhuttos were our family friends, we developed a strong camaraderie back in early 70s with her when she was a student at Harvard and I was enrolled at the Masters in Public Administration program at the University's JFK School of Government.

Although I have been chairman of many corporations, I would regard my stint as Chairman of KESC in early 70s to be the most challenging since I had to develop a winning team, motivate them and ensure that they work with full independence and with little or no interference. I am happy to note that during my term in KESC we were able to improve customer redressal system to a great extent. I can safely say that SSGC's customer service is second to none. Any complaint here

is attended to in hours rather than in days which is unfortunately common in many utilities.

Good Governance

A leader has to show personal character, establish credibility, display tolerance and utmost respect for all cadres. In addition, a good leader must be able to differentiate between good work and a bad work by supporting the good and discouraging the bad. Having said that, an effective leader must be able to trust his team members. From my own experience, one has to develop a rapport with his team by maintaining regular personal contacts with them. As a Deputy Commissioner, for instance, I would spend several weeks in remotest of areas to monitor the pace of work. My advice to today's managers is to establish demonstratable superiority by knowing the technicalities of a particular job better than people who actually do it. For instance, I have donned the mantle of patwari (rural accountant) and performed such menial tasks as girdawari or keeping a record of land cultivation.

As Chairman SSGC

When I was appointed the Chairman of this great organization, I had two options. One was to sit at home and only attend board meetings. The other was to attend office regularly. I chose the latter because only then can one decipher strengths and weaknesses of the organization and pass them on to the directors to help them make sound decisions in the greater interest of the Company. I can confidently say that I chaired a board that consisted of directors who had the requisite acumen, drive and vision to take the Company forward. Having said that, I would have wished we had made more progress on the UFG front. In my view, gas theft, which is one of the main causes of UFG, is a battle of wits between the Company's anti-theft drive and the actual perpetrators. SSGC must not rest until we bring these miscreants to book and control UFG drastically. I also hope that the World Bank funded Natural Gas Efficiency Project (NGEP) will be implemented in letter and spirit since this project may well be our best chance to bring down UFG.

SSGC dominates National Men's Road Cycle Race

Pakistan Army's Asad Mahmood won the 142-km Karachi to Hyderabad National Men's Road Cycle Race, reaching the finishing line in 4 hours, 19 minutes and 38 seconds. The race, organized under the aegis of Pakistan Cycling Federation was hosted by SSGC's organizing committee set up under the chairmanship of Lt. Col. (R) Raashid Ahmed. SSGC's Toor Jan (4:20:50) and Asif Junior (4:22:19) clinched 2nd and 3rd positions while the 4th position was earned by Army's Sajid. Naimatullah and Habibullah of SSGC bagged 5th and 6th positions, respectively.

6 cyclists from each team belonging to 3 provinces namely Punjab, Balochistan, KPK and 2 squads from Sindh along with FATA, SSGC, Pakistan Army and a combined unit of riders participated in the race.

A true spirit of competitiveness was witnessed in the race which kicked off from SSGC Head Office in Karachi and culminated at Toll Plaza, Super Highway, Hyderabad without any untoward incident. Zuhair Siddiqui, MD, SSGC, who was the chief guest at the opening ceremony, sent off the riders by customarily waving the race flag.

It was a major struggle for the cyclists to cover the stipulated distance as they had to battle strong winds blowing at the rate of 10-12 km/hr. The first group that broke out in the race consisted of three riders, one each from Army, SSGC and Sindh A who maintained their lead for considerable period of time. They were later joined by another group from behind that comprised of eight riders. The ultimate winner Asad Mahmood of Army maintained overall lead for most part of the race and crossed the line first.

The winners were pleasantly surprised when Syed Azhar Ali Shah, Secretary General, PCF announced cash awards for them whereby the winner received Rs. 20,000 followed by cash awards of Rs. 15,000 for runner-up and Rs. 10,000 for second runner up, respectively. Riders bagging fourth, fifth and sixth positions also received cash prizes of Rs. 5,000 each. ■

Tips on foot care

Take care: Wash feet daily with warm water and soap, dry well, then soften with lotion, cream, or petroleum jelly, avoiding the areas between toes. Trim or file toenails into a shape that's almost square but with no corner points to break skin or cause ingrown toenails.

Be sure the shoe fits: Indoors or out, wear properly fitting, closed-toe shoes to protect feet from stubs and bangs. After age 40, when feet get wider, consider prescription orthopedic footwear for better balance and stability. Never go barefoot.

Wear socks: Clean, light-colored, and lightly padded socks will show blood or draining wounds so you can easily spot problems. Avoid slow-drying, 100% cotton socks in favor of synthetic blends that wick moisture away and discourage fungus.

Fight fungus: Fungus, which thrives in moisture, can lead to infection. Where can you pick up fungus? From carpet, showers, and gym floors. To help kill it, use medicated foot powders like Tinactin or Micatin, and spray Lysol inside your athletic shoes.

Inspect daily: Take a good look at your feet every day.

A recent study of male veterans with diabetes found that more than half couldn't see or reach the bottom of their feet. If you aren't flexible enough to see your soles, ask someone to help or use a magnifying mirror to scout trouble spots like redness, bruises, and tiny punctures.

Shake things up: Give your shoes a good shake regularly. Seemingly harmless debris like coins and pebbles can fall unnoticed into shoes, injuring feet.

Don't go to extremes: Insensitivity to temperature means you could accidentally damage your feet, so avoid becoming too hot or too cold. ■

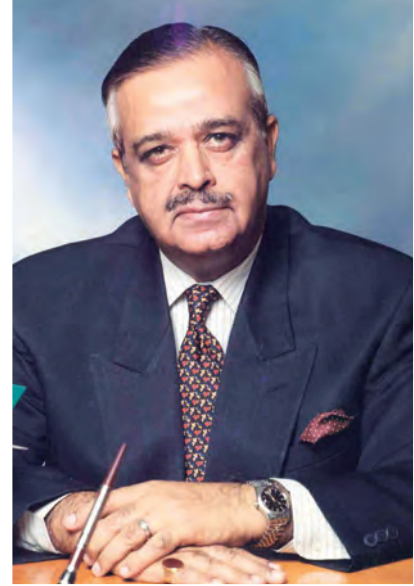

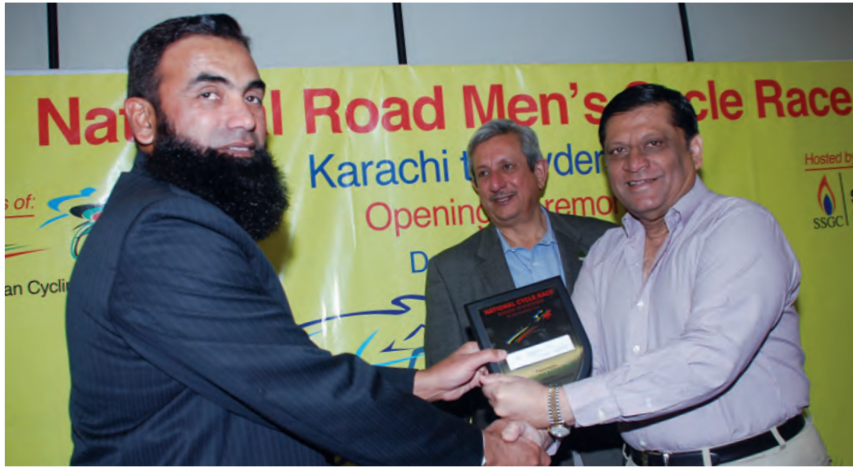

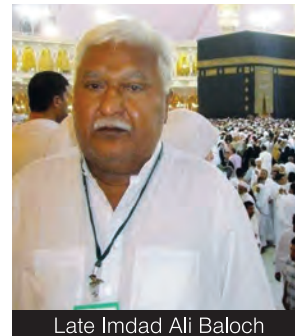
