58th Annual General Meeting Shareholders assure SSGC full support in recovering outstanding dues

The 58th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of SSGC, held on March 19, 2013 in Karachi, approved the Financial Statements, Chairman's Review and Directors' Report along with the Auditors' Report for the financial year ending June 30, 2012. The AGM was chaired by Shahid Aziz Siddiqui, Chairman SSGC, with the participation of Managing Director, Zuhair Siddiqui, Company Directors, senior management and a large number of shareholders.

The AGM approved the payment of 22.5% cash dividend to the shareholders. During FY 2011-12, the Company registered a net profit of Rs. 2,581 million against Rs. 4,724 million in FY 2010-11.

Compared to the last financial year, the customer base grew from 2.37 million to 2.49 million, whereas the gas sales increased from Rs. 126 billion to Rs. 153 billion with an increase in sales volume from 356,040 mmcf to 364,409 mmcf. The Company management attributed the major reason in decline in the Company's profits to the rising trend of Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG) which was caused by factors are beyond the Company's control.

The Chairman and Managing Director responded to many queries raised by the shareholders. They informed the house that the Company is adhering to many initiatives taken by the former

government in bridging the energy gap, such as transnational pipeline projects including IP and TAPI and setting up of LPG-Air mix plants. MD said that the tender for LPG-Air mix plant which is expected to add 50 mmcf gas to the system by the end of this calendar year, is currently under process

Responding to the shareholder's concerns on the matters related to OGRA, Director Mirza Mahmood Ahmad said that for the last 3 years the Company has been vociferously pleading its case with the Regulator to revisit the UFG benchmark in the light of ground realities and to regulate other incomes as non-operating. The efforts were successful in the year

2010 when the UFG benchmark was revised at 7% but after that OGRA did not allow the same and the Company approached Sindh High Court whose decision is awaited on the issue. A favourable decision can result in increase in profitability whereas an unfavourable decision can adversely affect the profit margins, it was noted.

With regards to the issue of UFG, the MD informed that a Natural Gas Efficiency Project (NGEP) has been approved in cognizance with the World Bank's funding of USD 200 million that will bring about a phased reduction in UFG over a five year period by rehabilitating 5,000 kms of aging pipelines. Replying to the queries of the shareholders, the MD said that for last one year KESC has only paid the current monthly dues and mounting receivables have touched a figure of Rs. 45 billion which has led the management to take all steps to recover this mammoth amount from KESC. A suit has also been filed against the KESC in this regard. The Chairman added that KESC's annual accounts reveal a false profit, as they do not show the massive payables accruing to SSGC. He said that this receivables issue is a major sore point for the Company, compelling it to borrow from bank at higher rates.

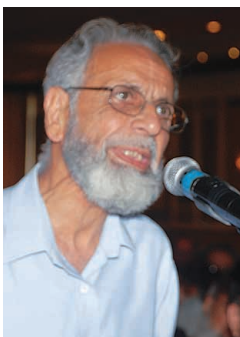
The Shareholders assured the management of their complete support in recovering the massive outstanding amount from KESC, Pakistan Steel Mills and other defaulters. They stressed the management to go all out in taking concrete steps for recovery as this would not only stabilize the



Company but will subsequently safeguard their interests as well. The MD said that in the best interest of people of Karachi, SSGC is adhering to its Boards' directives by supplying 120 mmcf gas everyday to KESC.

The Shareholders also paid glowing tributes to the services rendered by former Managing Director Azim Iqbal Siddiqui who was associated with SSGC for nearly four decades. Members of

SSGC's Board of Directors including Ayaz Dawood, Azhar Maud, Dr. Shahab Alam, Fazal-ur-Rehman Dittu, Mirza Mahmood Ahmad and Nessar Ahmed also attended the AGM who were seated on the stage, alongwith the Chairman, MD, Abdul Malik, CFO and Company Secretary Yusuf J. Ansari. The Company's senior management comprising of SGMs, GMs, DGMs and other officials were also present at the Annual General Meeting. ■



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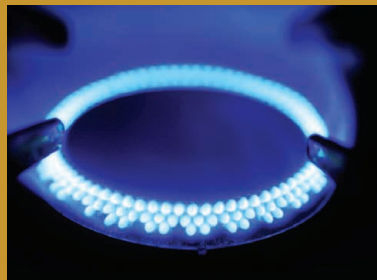

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Heads of States jointly perform ground-breaking of Iran-Pakistan Pipeline Project

The ground-breaking of \$ 7.5 billion Iran-Pakistan (IP) gas pipeline project was performed by President of Pakistan Asif Ali Zardari and his Iranian counterpart Dr. Mahmoud Ahmadinejad on March 11, 2013. Both the head of states unveiled the foundation plaque of the project that involve construction of Pakistan's side of the pipeline, at a ceremony held in Chabahar, an Iranian city near the Pakistan border and also witnessed the joining of pipeline segments that were painted with flags of the two nations. With this ground-breaking a foundation of bilateral energy cooperation was also laid which will unleash a new era of development in the region as the project will bring in 750 mmcf/d gas to Pakistan by January 2015.

Addressing the gathering, President Zardari said that Iran-Pakistan pipeline will help eradicate terrorism, bring prosperity to the region and overcome poverty.

The President termed the ceremony as a historic moment not only for the two nations but also for the region and said that many countries in the world had prospered by promoting trade within their regions and opined that this economic and energy cooperation will make Pakistan and Iran prosperous.

In his address the Iranian President Ahmadinejad said that the project had nothing to do with country's nuclear program because the gas pipeline cannot help make bombs. He said that it is a peace pipeline and if the world wants peace it should refrain from creating hurdles. The Iranian President commented that IP pipeline will become a milestone in regional cooperation and this event is a message to opponents.

The then Adviser to the Prime Minister on Petroleum, Dr. Asim



Hussain said that relations could be cold and warm, but geographic neighbours cannot change. Let us live together in prosperity and cooperation, he said and added that Gwadar port would soon have Pakistan's largest refinery, which would be built jointly by the two countries. Dr. Asim also informed that on completion, project would contribute about 5% to Pakistan's gross domestic product and create 10,000 jobs during construction and about 3,000 after completion.

The project, conceived in the early 1990s, envisages delivery of 750 mmcf/d gas from Iran's South Pars

field at the Pakistan-Iran border through a 56-inch 1150-km pipeline. A 900-km pipeline from South Pars to Sheher in Iran has already been laid while the construction of a 200-km pipeline up to Gahd-zero point is in the final stages of design. The 781-km Pakistani section of the pipeline (42" diameter) is to be laid close to Makran coastal highway from Gahd-zero point to Nawabshah.

The two countries had signed intergovernmental framework and gas sale and purchase agreements in 2009, which legally became effective on June 13, 2010. ■



Ground breaking performed for supply of gas to 20 villages

A ground breaking ceremony was held in Khairpur for supply of gas to 20 adjoining villages. The Ground breaking was performed by former Chief Minister Sindh Syed Qaim Ali Shah on February 24, 2013. Fayyaz Hussain Shaikh, ADGM (Larkana) along with other SSGC's senior officials, executives and employees were also present on the occasion.

While unveiling the plaque, Mr. Shah thanked the SSGC management for supplying the villages of District Khairpur and added that it was a long standing demand of the villagers.

In his address, ADGM (Larkana) welcomed one of the leading



politicians of Sindh and thanked him for performing ground breaking of gas supply to the villages. He added that more than 2,000 houses will

benefit from the supply of gas. ■

PPP's legendary leader Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto had inaugurated supply of gas to Badin for the first time and since then periodically more and more villages have been added to the network. The former speaker appreciated SSGC for completing distribution projects in time. ■



SLL signs agreement with Government Holdings for 20MT LPG

SSGC LPG (Pvt.) Limited (SLL) further strengthened its footing in the LPG industry by securing local LPG allocation from Government Holdings Private Limited (GHPL). The agreement was signed by Malik Usman Hasan (COO, SLL) and Irfan Nasir (MD, GHPL) on March 4, 2013 in Islamabad. According to the agreement SLL will uplift 20 metric tons (MT) of LPG per day from the Naimat Basal gas field owned by GHPL and operated by United Energy Pakistan (UEP). Negotiations are underway with other LPG producers for more allocation. ■



COO SLL visits Iran with Pakistani contingent

APakistani delegation recently visited Tehran on the invitation by the Iranian Oil Minister to discuss the issues pertaining to the import of furnace oil and LPG from Iran. Iran produces nearly 6.5 million metric tons of LPG per annum which is exported to India, China, South Korea, Japan and Iraq. Malik Usman Hasan, Chief Operational Officer, SSGC LPG (Pvt.) Limited was the Pakistani delegate and participated in the fruitful discussions.



These discussions deliberated on the possibilities of obtaining LPG from Iran at a considerably cheaper

cost than Saudi ARAMCO CP that would be essential for the upcoming

Synthetic Natural Gas (SNG) projects. ■

CRD undertakes major raid in Rabia City



The CRD Task Force conducted a major raid in March 2013 against households involved in gas theft in Rabia City, one of the biggest projects of residential apartments located in Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Karachi. The team disconnected gas use from 35 flats whose occupants were found using direct gas illegally through rubber pipes. CRD registered case against culprits under Section-462 of 2011.

Secure Socket Layer - Another IT achievement

SSL protects websites by encrypting important info

SSGC has successfully implemented SSL on the View Bill Server which enables secure and encrypted data communication. SSL stands for "Secure Socket Layer". SLL technology protects your website and allows customers and potential customers to trust your website with their personal information, by encrypting important information during different online transactions.

An SSL certificate provides private communication channels for data transmission and encrypts it with a special code. The encryption used for the information being transferred has been compared to that of an envelope being sent through the mail. The envelope protects what is inside, and prevents the contents on the inside of the envelope being seen until it reaches the receiver or where it needs to be.

With the implementation of SSL on the View Bill server, now, the user

name, password, and other data transmitted to and from the server is in encrypted form, securing the data communication between the server and user. The SSL Certificate has been issued to SSGC by Norton / Verisign which is the global industry standard for SSL certificates. The certificate supports 128-bit data encryption which, in future, will enable SSGC to accept credit card and online payments through the View Bill website.

Norton / Verisign has issued a Norton Secured Seal to SSGC for the View Bill server which verifies and authenticates SSGC/View Bill server to be providing the highest level of trust and security to its customers through implementation of SSL. The project was led by Mazhar Usman, DCM (VAS) whereas VAS's Executive Sharjeel Jan played the key role in the implementation of SSL who was ably assisted by Naveed Shamim.

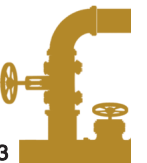

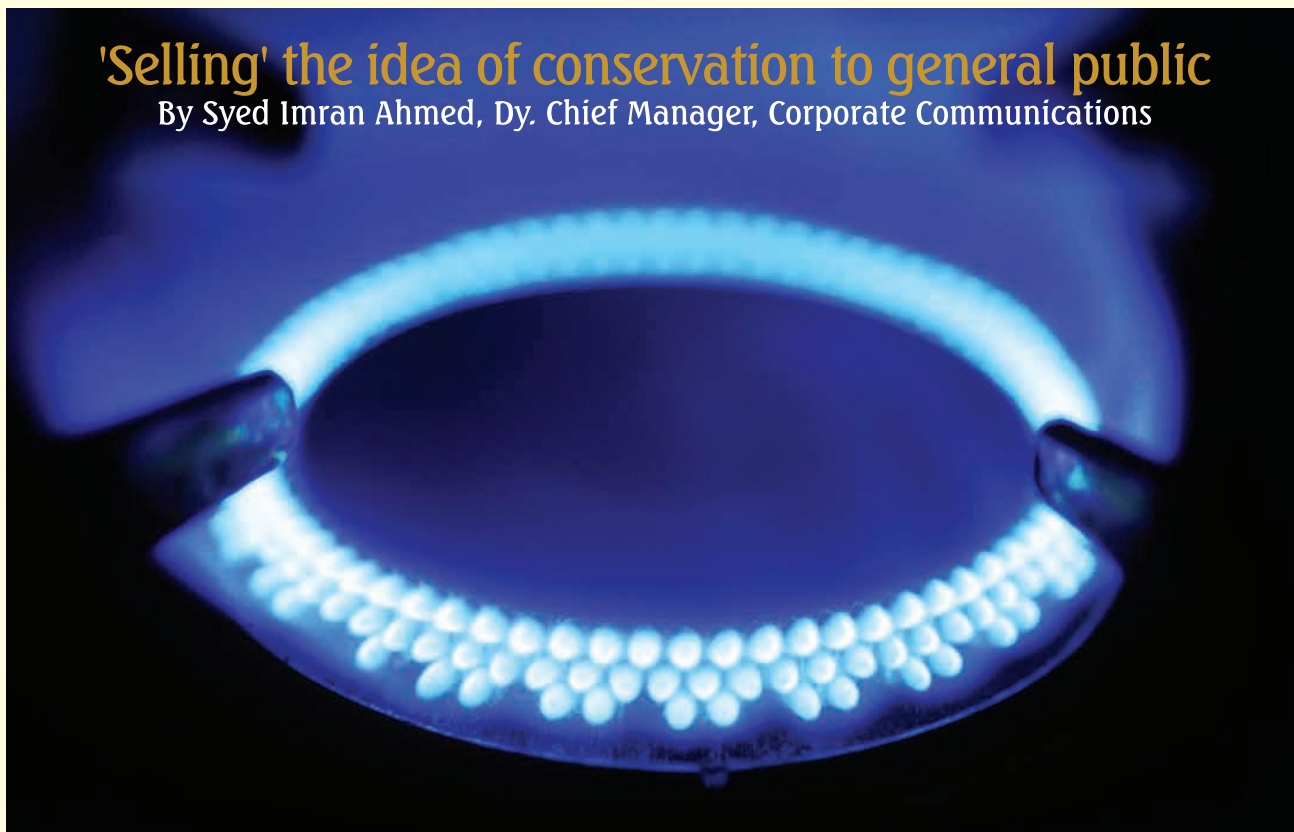

'Selling' the idea of conservation to general public

We never know the worth of water till the well is dry,' so goes an old saying. These days, the saying can be rephrased to read as, 'we never know the worth of gas till the well is dry.' If we had foreseen a bigger picture, the country would not have been faced with an energy crisis of serious proportions. Against the total demand of 8 billion cubic feet per day (bcfd), supply is 4 bcfd, creating a shortfall which made our winters quite hard. Domestic sector being a high priority segment gets preference in the use of natural gas followed by commercial, power, general industries, and cement and CNG sectors. In spite of regular curtailment of gas to CNG and the industrial sector, it sometimes becomes difficult for SSGC to even service the domestic consumers properly.

A ray of hope recently came in the form of the inauguration of Iran-Pakistan gas pipeline project, which is expected to go a long way in bridging the gap in the demand and supply of natural gas. If Pakistan completes its portion

of the pipeline by 2016, the country will have access to about 750 mmcf/d thus helping to bridge the widening fissure. Projects such as Iran-Pakistan pipeline are macro level decisions taken by the governments to sustain energy supplies. On the micro-level, with the demand and supply gap showing no signs of closing in, it becomes incumbent on all stakeholders to play their part in conserving gas, regardless of whether it is a winter or a summer season.

Historically, there is a huge variation in demand for natural gas during summer and winter seasons. Because the use of heating appliances increases substantially during winters, the demand for gas in Balochistan, Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa increases four times more in winters than in summers. This does not mean that with the widening gap, the customers will have the luxury of consuming enormous quantities of gas in summers. Those days perhaps are over, unless we want to turn this bleak situation around.

Reasons for Disequilibrium

A number of factors have contributed to the present state of affairs. While on the exploration side, gas discoveries have become few and far between, the rising trend of Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG) caused by gas theft, underground and overhead leakages, illegal connections and meter tampering along with gas distribution in economically unfeasible areas owing to the Government's socio-economic considerations, third-party damages and law and order situation have placed a strain on the already depleted natural resources.

In addition, the inability to practice alternative energy solutions have left us with little choices, although LNG, LPG and transnational pipelines remain our best bets to augment medium to long-term supplies. Space heating at homes is considerably reduced in summers, for obvious reasons, but the rising UFG trend, despite the efforts of both the gas utilities to stem it, is making demand-supply equation highly vulnerable. ►



Developing an effective message

Such a scenario should not put fears in our minds about a gasless future but a steely resolve to act fast to reverse the situation. SSGC has always been on the forefront of not just taking strategic measures to ensure uninterrupted gas supply but in making the public owe up to the crisis and make an effective in alleviating it. But how do you 'sell' the idea of conserving gas to its biggest group of stakeholders - the domestic consumers? What areas to focus on? What messages to communicate? How best to portray these messages for effective results?

In the recent past, as the demand-supply disequilibrium worsened, the Company's Corporate Communication Department almost instinctively intensified its mass education and awareness campaigns related to natural gas conservation, along with other media campaigns.

Tips for Summer Season

The Company's public awareness media campaign on energy conservation stresses on giving handy tips to the customer to ensure that they use gas sensibly and safely. These campaigns run during both summer and winter seasons. For summers, the

Company's message for customers using gas-fired appliances including stoves, geysers and heater revolves around the following basic tips;

- Turn off the geyser with the advent of the summer season
- Switch off stoves when not in use
- Report unauthorized use of gas or incidents of gas theft by calling the Company's 24/7 Contact Centre agents on 1199
- Always use good quality gas appliances that conform to standards laid down by Pakistan Standard and Quality Control Authority (PSQCA) and
- Periodic check of gas appliances by qualified plumbers to ensure their maximum effectiveness.

An SSGC television commercial currently doing the rounds shows a young kid asking his mother a much dreaded question, "Mom, can gas ever be finished?", which prompted a stunned, yet thought provoking look from her. The role of the child is apt since he is the one who represents the future generation for whom enough gas should be available.

To reach out to diverse demographics, the TVC runs in Urdu and Sindh languages. And while the underlying motive is

conservation, SSGC's campaigns also expect its customers to be a little more proactive by reporting leakages and theft in their surroundings.

Side by side with these conventional tools, the Communication Department recently came up with an ingenious and cost-effective idea of having scrolls; break bumpers (minute long brief announcements placed between a pause in the program and its commercial breaks) and sponsorship announcements run on television and radio channels to convey UFG related messages.

The frequency of insertions is quite high especially during prime time programming, ensuring that the listeners are able to register the Company's messages related to gas theft, leakages and other issues that directly impact the Company and its consumers.

Recurring messages create a top of the mind recall and ultimately a positive action from the customers.

At the end of the day, the message is simple yet strong: While strategic decisions to conserve natural resources are necessary, a customer's role is equally vital to create a win-win situation. ■

CP Transmission - Committed towards keeping pipelines safe

Maintaining Integrity of 3,354 Kms of SSGC underground Transmission pipeline is not an easy task. SSGC's Cathodic Protection is continuously enduring to prevent corrosion on gas transmission pipelines to ensure safety and security of pipelines and its neighbor along the route. Cathodic Protection is operated uninterrupted through Thermoelectric Generators, Solar and Commercial Power system with standby generator backup.

The pipeline CP potentials are regularly monitored as per schedule and different types of pipeline coating inspection surveys like CIP, C-Scan and DCVG are carried out to assess the condition of pipeline coating and consequently bad coating portions are rehabilitated.

The sacrificial CP system is applied to new pipeline segments during





construction phase and impressed current CP stations are added to the existing system to meet the increasing CP current requirement. Recently company installed a new Solar Power CP System at KMP-391 on 18" dia IRBP, off Nooriabad, Super Highway.

Besides this, different pipeline Integrity Inspection tools are used to utilize latest available technologies like Intelligent Pigging and Long Range Ultra sonic Testing (LRUT) to obtain the true picture of 1.6 Km pipeline metal body. In this regard, LRUT Inspection of 16" dia Indus Left Bank pipeline (ILBP) crossing over Sukkur Barrage executed. This pipeline is the oldest one of SSGC, constructed in 1954 by Mother Cat Construction Company. After almost 60 years service the pipeline is still in good condition and is operating satisfactorily. This is the first test ever carried out in 58-year life of ILBP.

Pipeline coating rehabilitation is of course, the major activity to physically inspect and maintain the pipeline integrity. Coating rehabilitation work is mostly carried out on old coaltar coated pipelines, having service life 30 - 60 years i.e. 16" dia ILBP, 18" dia IRBP, 18" dia BGFIP and 12" dia Quetta Pipeline (QPL).

Ensuring the optimum use of company resources, special attention is given to arrange repair of old useable costly pipeline protection and inspection tools equipments. Minor repairs are carried out at CP workshop KT and repair of hi-tech sophisticated equipments is out sourced.

Upgrading of CP power source is paced in accordance with the requirement to maintain pipeline potential within protective levels. In this regards the low output generators are replaced with high power and additional batteries and

solar modules are added besides replacing the old units. CP stations are regularly visited to evaluate their efficiency and arrange necessary repair and maintenance work.

CP Department (Transmission) is committed to maintain SSGC pipelines intact, safe and serviceable without gas losses risk and threat. The department operates as a Transmission team in coordination with its colleagues and under the guidance of GM and ASGM (T). ■

Store your olive oil in a room-temperature cupboard or in the refrigerator to keep it cool. A bottle of oil will last about a year on your shelf, according to the Stillwater Olive Oil Co. "After this time, the taste and health benefits, such as Vitamin E, beta-carotene, and other phenol levels decrease dramatically," the company's website states.

Fastest growing industry. Olive oil is one of the fastest-growing global industries, according to a report from Research and Markets, an international market research and data site. While Spain and Italy top the list of both producers and consumers, Americans seem to have jumped on the Mediterranean diet bandwagon in full force. If you're not ready to spring for the professional products, you can use olive oil at home to create a hair mask or as a cheap eye makeup remover. ■

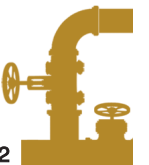

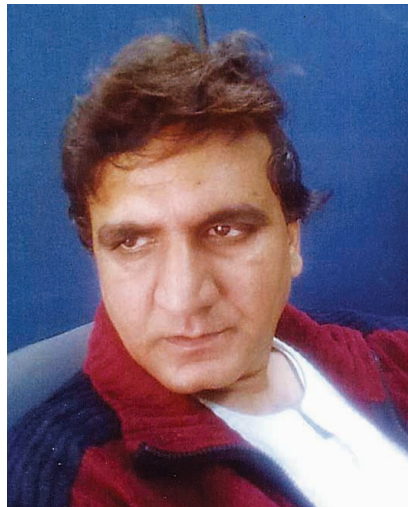

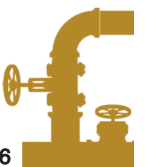
