Among the issues that came under discussion were gas load management plan during winters, the prevailing curtailed supply from gas fields and status of gas supply to textile units. ●



Timely raids on gas theft cases helped save valuable quantum

As part of the company-wide objective to substantially bring down Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG) volumes, SSGC has intensified its anti-gas theft campaign across its franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan. In early December 2014, the Company's Surveillance and Monitoring Department carried out major raids on commercial businesses in Karachi's Landhi area against illegal use of gas. Acting swiftly, the team disconnected illegal connections of nine commercial customers using gas directly from the main line. These raids helped the Company save an estimated 2,246 MCF volume of gas that amounts to Rs. 1.35 million in monetary terms.

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Gas theft is one of the primary causes behind the rising UFG, a phenomenon that has severely affected the Company's financial bottomline. Aided by the Criminal Law Act 2011, the Company has been waging an all out war against individuals and commercial concerns engaged in gas theft in Sindh and Balochistan. The Company encourages law abiding citizens to report any incident of gas theft in Karachi by calling, in complete confidentiality, its concerned officials on 021-99231597 (extensions 5528, 5508, 5509, 5529, 5612). ■

CRD goes on major disconnection spree

The CRD Task Force team went on a major disconnection spree in several areas of Karachi including Jamot Muhallah, Ghafoor Basti, Gulshan-e-Mustafa and Memon Goth Malir. During the raids, undertaken on November 20, 2014, the Task Force discovered that the offenders were involved in direct use of gas. The team clamped down on direct use and disconnected 4,000 illegal connections. This resulted in savings of 183.6 mmcf of gas, which amounts to Rs. 38 million in monetary terms.

During another raid in Muhammad Khan Colony, Baldia Town, on November 22, 2014, the Task Force disconnected 1,800 illegal connections. This timely action led to saving 83 mmcf of gas, which amounts to Rs. 17 million in monetary terms. ●

Mitigating the energy gap – SSGC invites bid for another LNG Terminal

Pakistan is currently facing a natural gas shortfall of over 2 BCFD which is expected to increase significantly in the next 15 years due to increasing demand and depleting gas reserves. The Government of Pakistan is pursuing a multi-pronged strategy including import of LNG as envisaged in the 2011 LNG Policy in a phased manner to mitigate the gap.

The first phase of the strategy was the fast track LNG import project at Port Qasim, Karachi, that is set to receive the first shipment of LNG in the first quarter of 2015. In order to further augment gas supplies, another LNG import is envisaged at Port Qasim, Karachi. SSGC will enter into a long term contract for LNG storage and regasification services under a LNG Services Agreement (LSA) with the LNG services provider.

In this regard, through a national and international press tender, SSGC has invited bids from interested parties to provide LNG storage and regasification services. To explain the reasons for establishing another LNG terminal as well as procedures involved in the tender process, a pre-bid meeting was arranged at the Head Office on

December 16, 2014, which was addressed by Shoaib Warsi, MD, SSGC. Representatives from bidding companies participated in the meeting in which Mr. Warsi explained the salient features and basic requirements of the tender process while also dilating on the transmission and distribution details of both SSGC and SNGPL. Mr. Warsi said that with the establishment of the second LNG terminal, the existing gas transmission infrastructure will be augmented for transportation of gas from Karachi to Northern Pakistan. He said that the current demand-supply situation has provided potential bidders an opportunity to invest in the area of LNG

storage and regasification.

The MD also took up a number of queries from the representatives of the bidding companies. He was aided in the discussions by Fayyaz Merchant, SGM (Engineering Services), Mohammad Ahmed Siddiqui, GM (Procurement) and Azam Akhtar, DGM/Incharge, Planning and Development.

The MD and the LNG team also held discussions with the USAID-funded consultants for the LNG terminals from December 16 to 18, 2014. ●

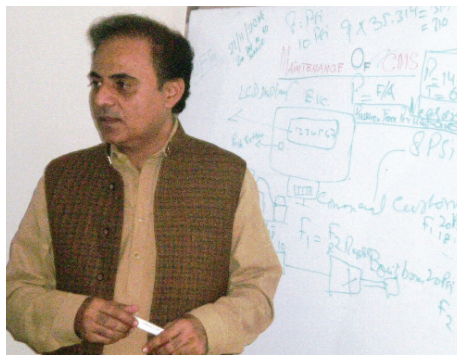

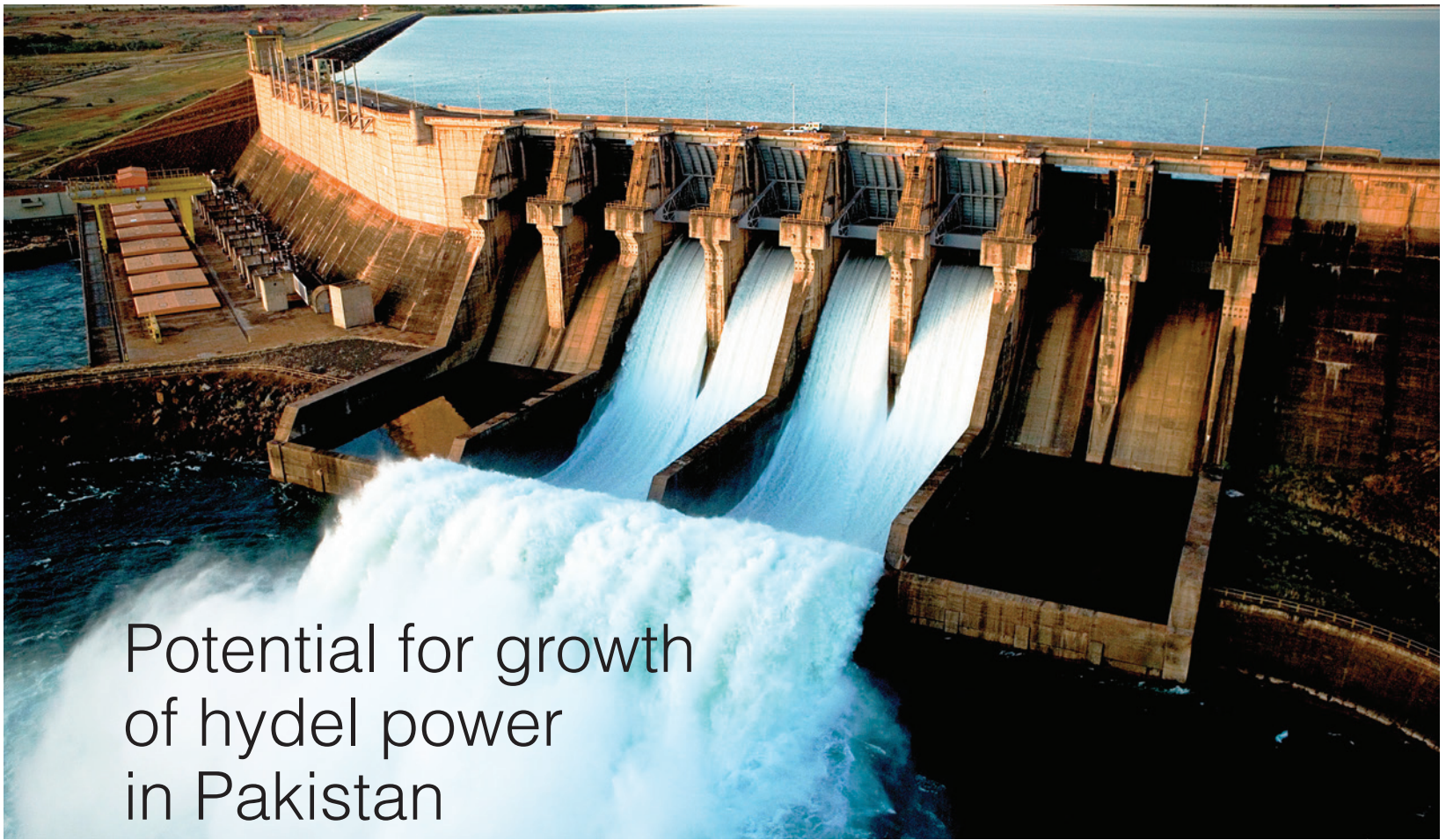
SSGC participates in NED's seminar-cum-exhibition

Potential for growth of hydel power in Pakistan

POWER GENERATION CAPACITY OF PAKISTAN

The total power generation capacity in Pakistan is in the vicinity of 17,457 MW. This includes the hydropower generation capacity of around 5,013 MW, the thermal power generation capacity of nearly 12,169 MW and the nuclear power

generation capacity of almost 462 MW. Based on the present generation capacity, the hydrothermal / nuclear mix in the country is 29:71.

The main sources of electricity generation in Pakistan are hydel, oil, gas,

coal and nuclear power. Among these, hydel power is the only renewable source of energy; the others are mainly fossil fuels. Hydel power is also the least expensive form of electricity. The potential for hydropower generation in Pakistan is in the vicinity of 40,000 MW.

POWER DEMAND OF PAKISTAN

According to a study, the provincial power demands in Pakistan are:

The current power demand in the Punjab is in the vicinity of 7,027 MW, which is expected to rise to around 29,103 MW in

2024-25 under the most conservative growth rate of 6.1%. In Sindh, the current power demand is 2,642 MW, which is expected to rise to 10,993 MW in 2024-25. The current power demand of KPK is around 1,697 MW, which is

expected to rise to 7,018 MW in 2024-25. Balochistan having the current power demand of nearly 474 MW is expected to rise to 1,964 MW in 2024-25 as the usage of energy is rising day-by-day.

HYDROPOWER AND HYDROLOGIC VARIATIONS

Hydropower generation is dependent on hydrological variations and irrigation release requirements. In early summer, the reservoir levels are generally low and the turbines operate at relatively low heads with consequently low power output. In flood season, the reservoir levels are high and large discharges can be passed through the turbines for maximum power generation. In winter,

the irrigation requirements are low and the discharges for power generation are limited resulting in lower power output.

The hydropower production capacity of the existing plants, in a typical year, varies widely and gets as low as about (+/-) 2,650 MW in May. However, the yearly average hydropower generation is of the order of (+/-) 3,700 MW.

Hence, the installed capacity of hydropower plants has to be compared with the actual power generated during the year in order to assess the effects of hydrologic variations. In 2000-01, the total electricity generated was around 68,117 GWh, of which only 25.2% was from a hydel source.

HYDROPOWER GENERATION PROJECTS

There are five major hydropower generation projects in Pakistan, namely, Tarbela, Mangla, Warsak Chashma and

Ghazi Barotha which have a capacity, on average, of 3478, 1000, 240, 187 and 1450MW respectively. There are also

several smaller hydel schemes whose combined capacity is about 108 MW. ▶

GENERATION COST

The generation cost of hydel energy is the lowest among all the options but is also more prone to variations due to seasonal, peak vs. average and other

effects. Therefore, there is a higher tendency of cost fluctuation in hydel energy compared to thermal or nuclear energy. The average cost in the year

2000-01 of hydel energy generation in Pakistan was 19.95 paisas per kilowatt-hour.

UTILIZATION FACTOR

The Utilization Factor indicates the amount of energy utilized against the total available energy. This can also be interpreted by the energy consumed versus installed capacity.

The Utilization Factor of hydel energy is usually lower compared to thermal or nuclear energy. This is because hydel capacity/ potential is dependent on the water head in the reservoir and cannot

be influenced. It is not necessary that higher energy may be available at the time of peak load vis-à-vis excess hydel power cannot be stored when the requirement is low. However, thermal or nuclear plants can be run at the desired capacity and their costs and overheads also reduce proportionately.

Utilization Factor also changes from year to year depending upon the national

needs, variation in needs and available water head in the reservoir during the whole year.

Energy Data of Hydel Power Stations 2000-01 ranges between approximately (+/-) 17-76 %. The utilization factor of the two largest contributors i.e. Tarbela and Mangla was approximately 42% and 32%, respectively.

HYDROPOWER DEVELOPMENT

There is a need to develop the hydropower capacity of Pakistan. The government is considering large projects like Basha to take care of future needs. Such projects will also add to the national storage capacity. Since the completion of Tarbela Dam in 1977, no major storage facility has been constructed. However, to augment the hydropower capacity, additional power units have been installed at Tarbela and the Mangla Raising Project is being undertaken. Two other hydroelectric power projects,

namely the Chashma Hydropower Project and the Ghazi Barotha Hydropower Project, which do not include additional storage capacity / facilities, have also been initiated. The Chashma Plant is now in operation and the Ghazi Barotha Project is nearing completion.

The capacities of the three existing reservoirs of the Indus Basin: Tarbela, Mangla and Chashma are declining due to sedimentation. The live storage

capacity of the three reservoirs has been reportedly reduced by about 20%.

WAPDA recently announced plans to undertake studies for a number of storage projects on the Indus and its tributaries including the Basha dam as well as several off channel storages in the Vision 2025 programme. This document forms part of the Ten Years Perspective Plan of the Government. The shortfall in power generation would be met through thermal generation. ■

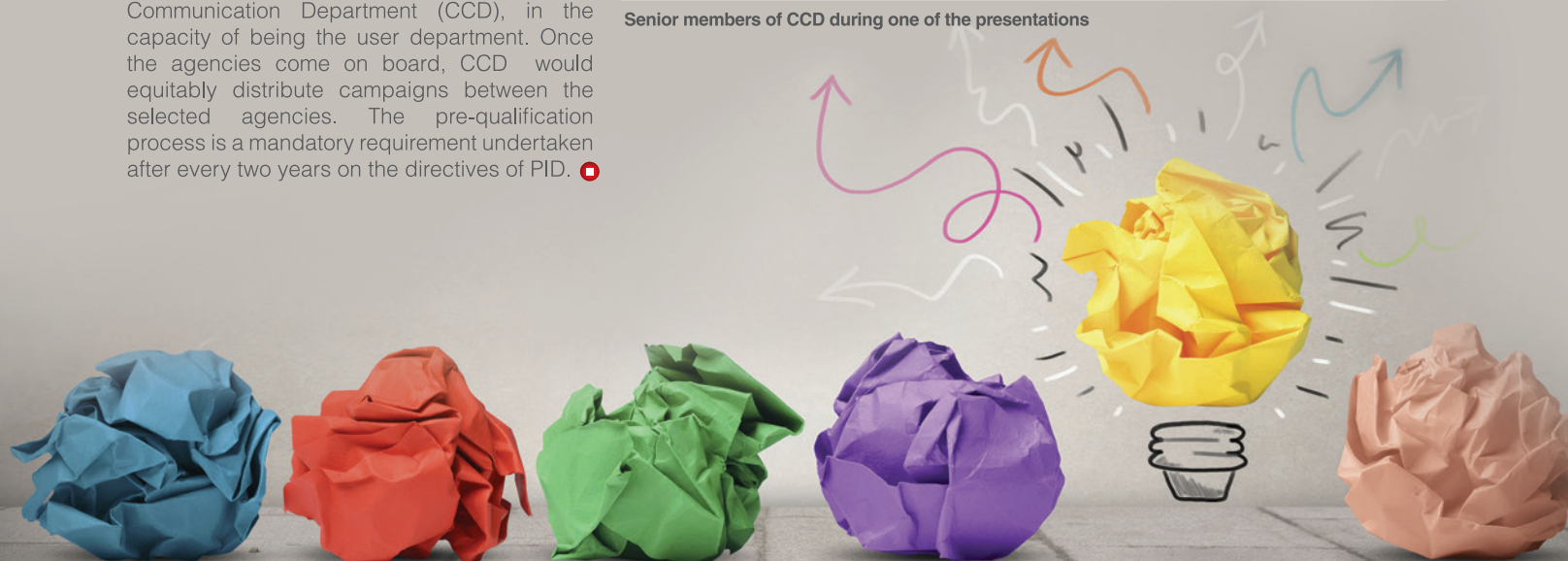

Fifteen advertising agencies gave presentations related primarily to two of the Company's regular ad campaigns, before an evaluation committee comprising of Tariq Asad, Asst. Director, Press Information Department (PID), Anwar Saeed, external media expert, Major Mohammad Akhtar (R), SGM (MS), Shahbaz Islam, DGM (CCD), Mohammad Amin, GM (CRD) and Ziker Kapadia, CM (Procurement), the last two having participated on behalf of Dr. Ejaz Ahmed, SGM (CS) and Mohammad Ahmed Siddiqui, GM (Procurement), respectively. The three-day exercise provided some of the best ad agencies of the country to showcase their creatives before the panelists.

The results were then tabulated by the panelists and shared with the PID by the Corporate Communication Department (CCD), in the capacity of being the user department. Once the agencies come on board, CCD would equitably distribute campaigns between the selected agencies. The pre-qualification process is a mandatory requirement undertaken after every two years on the directives of PID. ■
