TASK FORCE CONDUCTS RAID IN KARACHI'S LINES AREA

On a tip off from a reliable source, the CRD Task Force conducted a raid on illegal use of gas in Taj Complex located in Karachi's Lines Area in Saddar.


The team led by Syed Nawab Ali Shah, Manager (CRD-Task Force) under the supervision of Kashif Qadeer, DGM/Incharge (CRD and Recovery) carried out the raid in January 2014, assisted by DSM Central's team and heavy security. Acting swiftly, the Task Force team removed illegal connections of around 40 flats.

The Task Force conducted another raid against direct use of gas in the heavily populated Al-Asif Square in Sohrab Goth, Karachi on January 28, 2015. The team discovered that 23,000 million cubic feet gas was stolen on yearly basis in and around Al-Asif Square area. In monetary terms, this volume amounts to Rs. 7.25 million. During the raid, the team disconnected more than 500 domestic connections that were taking gas directly through rubber pipes. The Task Force also cracked down on five local

restaurants that were running their businesses by using illegal direct connection. In addition, on two locations, owners were found running heavy generators by taking illegal connections from domestic lines.


The Task Force summarily dismantled illegal connections during the raid. Application to lodge FIRs against these culprits was sent to IG office as per the Criminal Law Amendment Act 2011. 

CRIME SCENE DO NOT CROSS

Another major crackdown in Mehran Town, Karachi

SGC's Customer Relations Department's Task Force carried out a major raid against gas theft on February 3, 2015 at a Mehran Town locality in Korangi, Karachi.

During the raid, the team disconnected more than 200 domestic connections whereby the miscreants were taking gas directly through rubber pipes.


The team discovered that 9,180 MCF worth of gas was being stolen from this area on yearly basis which amounts to Rs. 3 million. The Task Force summarily dismantled illegal connections during the raid. Application to lodge FIRs against these culprits was sent by the Task Force to IG office as per the Criminal Law Amendment Act 2011. 



DISTRIBUTION NORTH TEAM MAKES MAJOR DISCONNECTIONS IN JACOBABAD

The Distribution Division-North team based in Larkana Region made major disconnections against illegal use of gas in Gulsher Kandhrani Thull Village located in District Jacobabad on January 20, 2015. The team discovered that out of approximately 450 houses, 350 were involved in direct use of gas. The successful raid is, in itself, an immense achievement since more than 75%

households were found stealing gas. Mr. Subhan Ali Dasti, Regional Manager, Larkana provided direction and full logistic support to Abdul Wahab Dayo, Sub Zonal Manager, Thull and his team to take an aggressive against the culprits.

FACE THE MEDIA – A WORKSHOP WITH A DIFFERENCE

The camera lens and microphone can, unsuspectingly, capture a moment or comment when your guard is down for a second and one wrong word or phrase within a well-defined speech could lead to a misleading headline in next morning's newspaper or the TV news bulletin. SSGC is one public utility that is invariably in news because of its importance to the energy sector.

On January 31, 2015, the HR Department in conjunction with the Corporate Communication Department arranged a day-long Media Orientation Training workshop at the Head Office.

The workshop was conducted by Menin Rodrigues and Sohaib Alvi of Shamrock Communications, one of the leading PR agencies of the country, for the benefit of the Company's senior management and the Corporate Communication Department, of which Media Relations is a vital section. The workshop participants were Abdul Majid Malik, SGM (Distribution-North), Dr. Ejaz Ahmed, ASGM (Customer Services), Saeed Larik, GM (Distribution-Central), Lt. Col. (R) Shoaib Qureshi, AGM (AS), Shahbaz Islam, AGM (Corporate Communications-CCD), Salman A. Siddiqui, DGM (CCD), Inayatullah Ismail, CM (Media Relations) and Syed Imran Ahmed, CM (CCD).

The trainers said that a crisis situation for a country or a public entity like SSGC can happen at any time and stressed that one should always be in a position to tactfully, calmly and truthfully handle a crisis.

The workshop outline was designed to give useful pointers to the senior managers and CCD officials, about handling the media effectively especially since the media is invariably looking towards developing a strong content, backed by facts and figures, with a story that would be good for TRPs and circulation. In such a situation, it is important for the spokesperson to handle the media effectively, be it attending to phone calls or participating in media briefings, through a right blend of verbal and non-verbal communication, which also involves maintaining a right posture and assertiveness.

The trainers underscored the point that spokesperson must never get intimidated by the media persons, no matter how

aggressive they may be. One of the most interesting sessions of the workshop was mock 'interviews' taken by the trainer, Sohail Alvi, who posing as an intruding reporter-cum-interviewer, posed difficult questions from four of the senior managers in order to elicit behavioral responses from each one of them in the areas of body language, content, irritant value, technical knowledge and importance of interviews. These areas were then judged on a scale of 1 to 5, after which the trainers suggested corrective actions.

The trainers said that a crisis situation for a country or a public entity like SSGC can happen at any time and stressed that one should always be in a position to tactfully, calmly and truthfully handle a crisis. Through real life examples of Karachi Airport terrorist attack and Malaysian Airlines disappearance case, they also gave useful tips to the participants about how to face the media when the Company is on a crisis mode.

At the conclusion, the trainers presented certificates to the participants. SGM (D-North) and ASGM (CSR) also presented the souvenirs to the trainers and Ashar Noman, GM (Customer Services) at Shamrock Communications for deftly coordinating with SSGC's HR and CCD Departments in successfully staging this workshop. ■

Adhoray Khuwab revolves around 'Imran', a Company manager and his junior staff 'Sajid'. After a hectic day at work, 'Imran' goes home, instantly goes on a deep sleep and dreams that the company is financially in a bad shape since its people have not been able to solve myriad issues including UFG simply because of their lack of commitment.

The dream sequence shows it is year 2020 and 'Imran' is taken aback by a fierce demonstration going on in front of the decrepit Head Office building. He asks 'Sajid' what is going on only to be told that the Company is facing the brunt of the ongoing crisis, industries have closed down and CNG crisis has boiled over. 'Imran' laments that the sorry state

has taken its toll on the Company's financial health since he has not been paid his salaries for months with the result that he has not been able to pay his children's school fees for months.

In a soliloquy, 'Imran' laments that if the Company had understood the need to save the rapidly depleting natural gas resource, things would not have come to such a pass. SGC has been one of the prime players in the import of Liquefied natural gas (LNG) to Pakistan. The first phase of the LNG import strategy involves the shipment of the first consignment of LNG in early 2015 for which a terminal is fast under construction at Port Qasim, Karachi. The primary objective behind the import of LNG is reduce the widening demand-supply gap of natural gas in the country. Divesting of 49% of SSGC LPG shares

The Extraordinary General Meeting (EoGM) of SSGC's shareholders unanimously passed a resolution allowing SSGC to renounce the 96 million rights shares of Rs. 10 each offered by SSGC LPG (Pvt) Ltd. (SLL). The resolution paved the way for Sui Northern Gas Pipelines (SNGPL) to acquire 49% stake in SLL.



SSGC turns 25!

On March 30, 2014, SSGC celebrated the silver jubilee of its inception in its present form. Although Sui Gas Transmission Company (SGTC) was incorporated in 1954, the year 1989 saw the merger of two separate entities to form SSGC.



Making presence felt at Pak Oil and Gas Summit

SSGC was among the who's who of energy sector companies at Pakistan Oil and Gas Summit 2014, held on March 19 and 20, 2014. The Company made its presence felt with some incisive presentations on LNG and LPG as well as a corporate booth that attracted local and international delegates.

HQ-Shikarpur – A mid-point and main hub of SSGC

A Headquarter is a very vital part of the Transmission pipeline Network. HQ Shikarpur was established in 1978, and is the only Head Quarter which is the main hub and mid-point of SSGC in respect of pipeline network and compressor and Telecom/SCADA.

HQ-Shikarpur is manned by 12 executives, 29 non-executives and 18 HR-approved employees.

In HQ-Shikarpur, the pipeline network is spread in three provinces to fulfill the pressure requirements.

This is only compressor station that comprises of two units of 240 MMCFD Total Capacity which is running round the clock 24/7 for the year and fulfills the Pressure requirements of SSGC's Network. Before installation of Compressor station, the MPL free flow capacity was 135 mmcf, and after installation of 3 DC-990 compressors in 1984 the MPL flow capacity increased to 235 MMCFD. The compressor fulfills the huge amount of requirement of SNGPL

where 16" and 20" Dia MPL are going through a reverse flow.

HQ Shikarpur is the only headquarter in SSGC's infrastructure with respect to Telecom/SCADA system through which the QPL, Sui, HQ-1 and SNGPL sections are linked and mainly linked to Karachi Terminal and Head Office. HQ-S is the only HQ in the vicinity of which 95% of emergencies and blasts occurs, where huge amount of revenue of the Company is lost in the shape of UFG. Major attempt has been made to minimize line losses, through SCADA auto Valves installed at G-2 V/A, R/S-1, R/S Larkana and V/A Badah in 16", 18" and 20" Dia MPL, which were operated manually before installation of SCADA system with huge amount of UFG losses.

The IT system of Quetta, Sukkur, Larkana and Nawabshah (Benazirabad) Regions is connected with Telecom system through HQ Shikarpur, and the Billing of SSGC network works at all mentioned Regional Offices.

Like all other HQs, HQ-Shikarpur has a

certain segment of high pressure pipeline network of 12", 16", 18" and 20" diameter to look after total main pipeline length of 605.3 kms laid in a Right of Way (ROW) of about 314.7 kms in which 16" and 20" Dia main pipelines are reverse flow to SNGPL.

The 12" dia main pipeline is the only main pipeline from R/S-1, through which the Gas supplied to the entire Balochistan province. Now another 18" Dia main pipeline has been laid from HQ Shikarpur to Balouchistan province.

The integrity of the Main Pipeline structure is the responsibility of Corrosion Prevention section of Transmission Department. There are three types of CPS (Corrosion prevention Stations) installed in the section, namely Solar System, TEG (Thermo Electric Generator) and TR (Transformer Rectifier) constructed all along the length of High Pressure Pipeline for supplying right amount of DC current to the pipeline for prevention of corrosion.

A Point of Delivery (POD) is a point where

the custody transfer of gas takes place from producer to SSGC, and there are 3 PODs in HQ-Shikarpur section namely Mazarani Gas Field (injection in 18" Dia MPL at R/S Larkana), High Carbex Gas Field (inject in 18" Dia Inlet at HQ Shikarpur) and Konj Gas Field (injection

in 16" Dia MPL near R/S-1)

For smooth operation of compressors, there are three Generators (one in operation and two are standby) to provide required electrical power for running auxiliaries of compressor station

was also installed.

HQ-Shikarpur has a big workshop at compressor station as well which cater for the routine maintenance jobs of Compressor Station. 📍

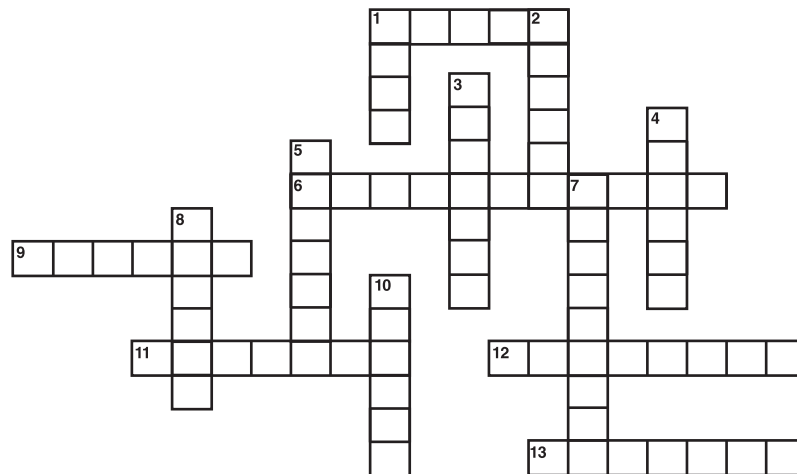

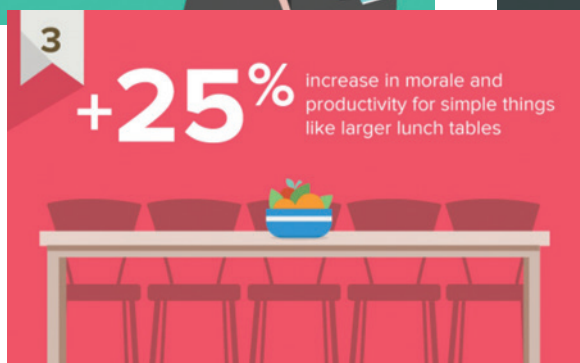
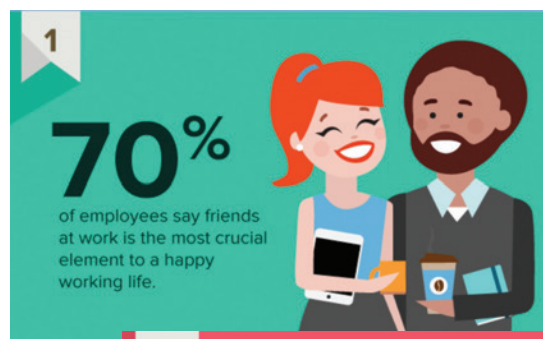
