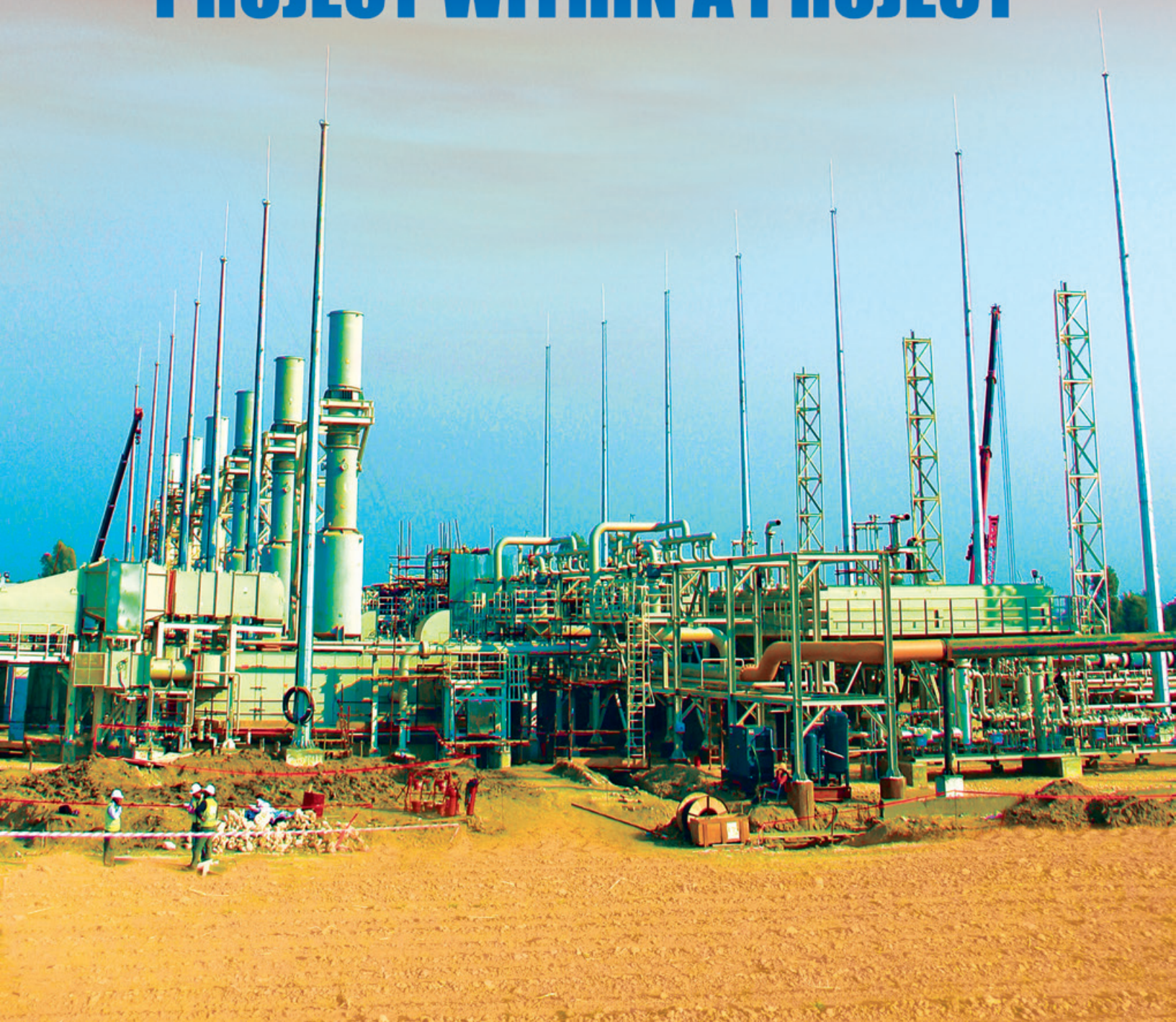

Installation of compressors - Senior management visits HQ-2 Daur

The 352 Km, 42" dia. dedicated RLNG Pipeline project has been by far the biggest project which SSGC has undertaken in its prolific history. In order to monitor the progress of the compressors being installed in HQ-2 Daur, the senior management, led by Amin Rajput, Acting MD, SSGC visited the site along with Mohammad Wasim, ADMD (Operations) and Imran Farookhi, ADMD (CS) on January 12, 2017.

Adnan Saghir Siddiqui, ASGM (Transmission) and his team welcomed the

visitors from Karachi, that also included Fayyaz Merchant, former SGM (ES), Asad Saeed Khan, SGM (HR), Syed Asim Ali Tirmizi, PD (LGs), Amir Mumtaz Khan, ASGM (GS), Kamran Ahsan Nagi, GM (P&C), and other officials. Amjad Javaid, DGM (Transmission) gave a presentation on the status of the installation of compressors at the site. He also briefed the management about activities at the tie-in point at MVA Pakland and highlighted the safety measures being implemented.

The visiting team also met with the

representatives of SAF International and Solar that are proactively engaged in this laborious task.

Later, the senior management visited the compressors site where they were briefed about the overall status of the newly commissioned compressors. The senior management was also shown the control room from which the operation is being run. Amin Rajput, Acting MD applauded the efforts of the officials and labors for their dedication and commitment towards the project. 





RLNG Project - Monitoring the progress




Transportation of compressors from Port Qasim to HQ-2 Daur – a challenging exercise



As part of the 42" dia, 352-km RLNG Project, a massive, one of its kind transportation activity was performed under the supervision of Stores Department. The activity involved commissioning of four new compressors and their ancillaries from Port Qasim, Karachi to HQ-2 Daur. The consignment consisted of 18 containers of 40 feet length. The activity of transporting the

compressors was an arduous task. However, an ingenious way out was found by transporting the four compressors in Hydraulic Detachable Low Bed Multi AxleTrailer from Port Qasim to HQ-2 Daur. The distance between axles in Hydraulic Detachable Low Bed Multi AxleTrailer guarantees equal distribution of load and also helps to ensure good control on high speed. Approximate gross weight of each

compressor was 35 tons.

During the entire activity, from PQA to the placement of the compressors on platform at HQ-2 Daur, a designated team from Stores Department supervised and remained en-route with Agility Logistics and SAF International to ensure a hassle free completion of this activity.

Hot pursuit - SSGC undertakes major gas theft raids in Karachi

The Task Force of SSGC's Customer Relations Team conducted a number of raids in various parts of Karachi recently. These raids were executed with the assistance of SSGC-backed Police Force and the Company's Security Services Department in goths and localities of Gulzar-e-Hijri, Gulistan-e-Johar, National Highway, Super Highway, Taiser Town,

Korangi, Saddar, Bin Qasim Town and Surjani Town among others.

The Task Force caught the miscreants stealing over 615,689 million cubic feet of gas directly from the main lines.

In monetary terms, this volume amounts to Rs. 119 million. The team summarily made

disconnections by dismantling the illegal lines.

The raids are conducted as part of the continuous drive by SSGC against the gas theft miscreants who are partly responsible for the menace of Unaccounted for Gas (UFG) or line losses. UFG directly impacts the profitability of the Company. ■



SSGC starts re-gasifying 600 mmcfcd LNG



As a result of extensive efforts on its part, SSGC managed to achieve re-gasification of 600 mmcfcd of LNG at the Floating Storage Re-gasification Unit (FSRU) at Port Qasim, Karachi, from January 28 onwards. With the transfer of an additional 200 mmcfcd gas, SSGC has fulfilled the Government of Pakistan's objective of re-gasifying 600 mmcfcd of LNG for onward transmission to SNGPL's system before January 31, 2017.

In this regard, the Company only recently completed the Segment #3 of the 42" dia, 337-km RLNG pipeline, which traversed from Nawabshah to Sawan, with the line now fully operational. In addition, out of the six new compressors, the Company has just made operational two compressors at HQ-2 (Nawabshah) in spite of adverse circumstances and within a short time frame while the third compressor is in its pre-commissioning phase.

This major development of completing the segment #3 and commissioning two of the compressors will not only help to bridge the widening gap between the demand and supply but will also mitigate gas shortage situation during the winter season. SSGC has quite successfully utilized FSRU's capacity to the maximum with an additional supply of 200 mmcfcd to the system.

R&D organizes session on geyser timer device

Jal Bujh, a Water GTD to Monitor and Control Gas Consumption

Natural gas will remain essential to our national economic development and prosperity. Being a corporate and leading industry we recognize that excessive use and wastage of natural gas is a contributor to atmospheric greenhouse gas (GHG) concentration, and that emissions should be minimized where possible. Energy efficiency and its conservation can make a major contribution to both environmental protection and energy demand.

SSGC's R&D Department has always shown keen interest to meet the challenges of natural gas conservation and enhancement of gas equipment efficiencies. In this regards, R&D Department in collaboration with Zaheen Machines organized a seminar on "Jal Bujh", a water geyser timer device (GTD) to monitor and control gas consumption on January 25, 2017. Zaheen (Intelligent) Machines Pvt. Ltd. is an Internet of Things (IoT) start-up in Pakistan that works on resource optimization devices for the national market.

Mr. Zia Imran, CEO Zaheen Machines, invetor and developer of this smart gadget called Jal Bujh, gave detailed presentation

to SSGC's, senior management. He spoke in detail about this electromechanical device and explained the salient features of the gadget. Jal Bujh has also won first prize in the Global Cleantech Innovation Program (GCIP) 2015 competition, he informed the audience.

The device has a potential to reduce gas consumption up to 30-50% of gas bill in a month. He added that "Jal Bujh" is an indigenously developed smartphone based device to control gas-fired water heaters (geysers). The product can convert gas-powered water heaters into eco-friendly gas-saving appliances.

The product, therefore, is capable of reducing the country's domestic gas consumption and help consumers save thousands of rupees on their gas bills. Moreover, this device is useful for traditional (water storage) types geysers though it is not suitable for instant geyser. It works according to a set of schedule by the user. For example one can turn it ON for a specific period of time after which it will turn to pilot mode automatically. Some salient features of GTD device are mentioned below;

- It saves 30% to 50% gas consumed by traditional style water geyser.
- It runs via Bluetooth Smart mobile phone through BLE (Bluetooth Low Energy). User friendly mobile App (Android, iOS).
- It saves from making repeated trips to the geyser to turn it to low and high settings to save gas.
- It results in energy saving.
- It makes city healthy by reducing carbon dioxide and pollution.
- It can be easily installed.

Moreover, gas saved in domestic consumption using this device can be sold to industrial users and yield high profits as their tariffs are higher. Management appreciated the efforts of Zaheen Machines for developing the sustainable solutions for energy optimization and agreed to provide them platform to publicize "Jal Bujh" in Sindh and Balochistan.

Madni Siddiqui, AGM (R&D) and his team played an important part in organizing the session.



Presentation on Camera for gas leak detection



In order to combat the menace of gas leaks in distribution network, R&D Department in collaboration with Sumico Technologies arranged a technical presentation and an on-field demonstration on the latest Thermal Imaging Camera for detecting Gas Leaks.

The presentation was held in SSGC's P&D conference room on January 27, 2017. Active participation was seen from the Distribution Department. Detailed cross questioning was done regarding the technology by Leak Detection Team.

The Thermal Imaging Camera has been long used in various industrial sectors for detection of overheated boiler tubes, overloaded electrical wires and heated bearings of rotary equipment etc., but recent advancements in technology has found its applications in Gas Leak Detection.

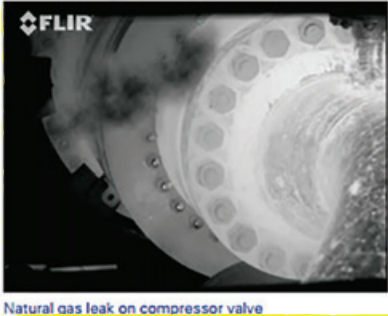
The latest FLIR GFx 320 Infrared Camera is tailor made for detecting Methane Gas and is a preventative maintenance solution to spot leaks in piping, flanges and connections. The infrared camera can

rapidly scan large areas and pinpoint leaks in real time.

After the presentation, a team from R&D and Distribution Department comprising of managers and executives proceeded to a test site in DHA Phase 7 to analyze the performance of the camera. The camera was successful in detecting significant overhead leaks but found difficulty in detecting minor leaks. For detection of leaks in buried pipes, it was necessary to use plunger (used to make hole in the ground) to route gas to the surface for the camera to detect.

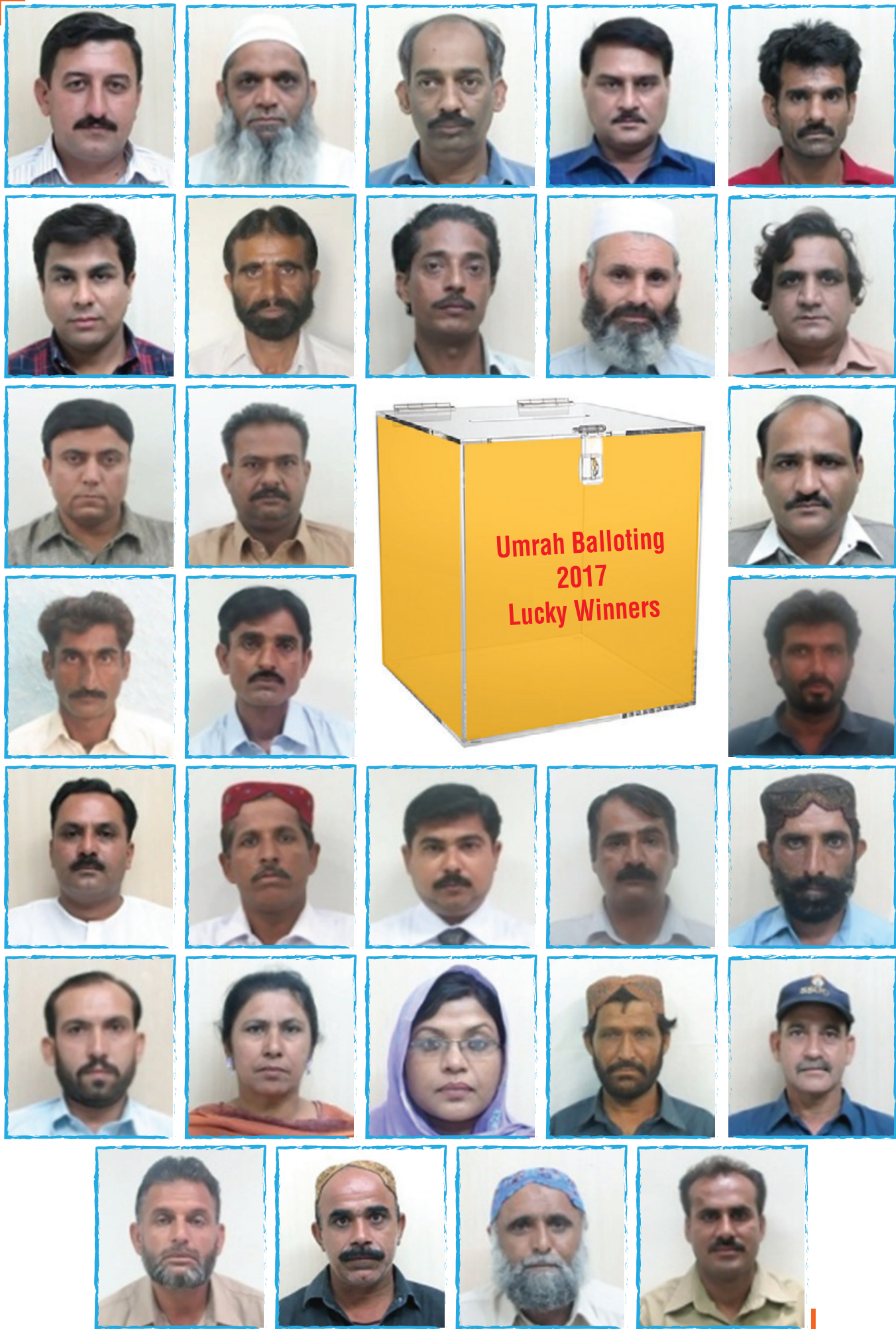

Evolution of Cricket in SSGC



Since last one year, SSGC Cricket team has been seeing its best days. A month ago, the team ended up as Runners up in National Inter Departmental Cup 2017 and before that finished amongst top four teams in the Quaid e Azam Trophy 2016-17. The team was studded with some household names like Shoaib Malik, Muhammad Amir, Sohail Khan, Babar Azam and Fawad Alam as well as rising stars like Umar Amin, Asif Zakir, Saifullah Bangash and Awais Zia. These stars have not only brought laurels for SSGC but also have gained all round praise as the most well-disciplined team around.

Today where we stand, most teams only dream to aspire but conquering this summit in such a short period of time involved lots of effort coupled with hard work and support from the SSGC management. In order to assess the efforts involved in the evolution of Cricket in SSGC it is necessary to have a look at the evolution of cricket in SSGC.

The foundation of SSGC Cricket team was laid in 1993-94 by then MD SSGC, Mr. Javed Hussain. Team SSGC took part in all the events of Karachi Region in which the upcoming players got chance to show their worth and gain experience to contest in upper level. It is worth mentioning that the Sports Department in SSGC was created some ten years after the creation of its official cricket team i.e in 2003-04, primarily due to the efforts of Munawar Baseer Ahmad, the then MD SSGC.

In order to organize and establish the Cricket team in a most professional pattern,

SSGC hired the services of an eminent Pakistan's former test cricketer Sikander Bakht as a coach during the year 2004-05. SSGC in the same year participated in Quaid-e-Azam Grade II. The team also participated in Ramazan Tournament in Karachi Gymkhana and secured first position by winning the tournament.

The winning trend continued in 2005-06 also as Team SSGC participated in Quaid-e-Azam Grade II cricket tournament under the leadership of Test Cricketer Atiq Uz Zaman and won the championship. However due to unforeseen circumstances the performance deteriorated and the team was relegated to Grade II in 2010-12 after qualifying for Grade I.

Major changes in the team were then incorporated for improvement in their performance. The team after hiring services of number of professional players won the Grade II and qualified for Grade I championship in 2012-13 under the able leadership of Asif Zakir.

In 2013-14, Team SSGC played the semi finals of Grade I Championship. In 2014-15, PCB changed the format of National Cricket, according to which SSGC had to qualify for the Quaid e Azam Trophy. Team SSGC not only qualified for the tournament but also remained unbeaten throughout the qualifying round.

The new look side was given a much needed shot in the arm with the hiring of famous international cricketers such as Shoaib Malik, Babar Azam, Muhammad Amir, Sohail Khan and Umar Amin. The team

performance did not stop here. They ended in first eight teams of the tournament which was an achievement to be reckoned with. After this superlative performance, there was no looking back.

In order to further improve the performance of SSGC Cricket team in the domestic circuit, lots of efforts were made by the Management and team officials. The foremost challenge was the fitness of the squad. This aspect led to the hiring of a foreign trainer well before the start of domestic season of 2016-17, services of Richard Stonier, a professional trainer from England were hired by SSGC. This was the first time a foreign professional was engaged for the purpose of sports training. Stonier brought a new dimension to the training mechanism which is clearly evident from the fitness standard of the team. Chairman National Cricket team Selection Committee, Inzamam-ul-Haq also praised the fitness standards of SSGC Cricket Team. He complimented SSGC Management on the social media.

"We should see the fitness standards of SSGC Cricket Team. They have hired a foreign trainer and other Departments should also hire in the same manner. These types of fitness standards are required nowadays in International Cricket".

The efforts taken by the team management in the areas of coaching and training materialized into a brilliant run of performance in the Quaid e Azam Trophy and the National One Day Departmental Championship. ●

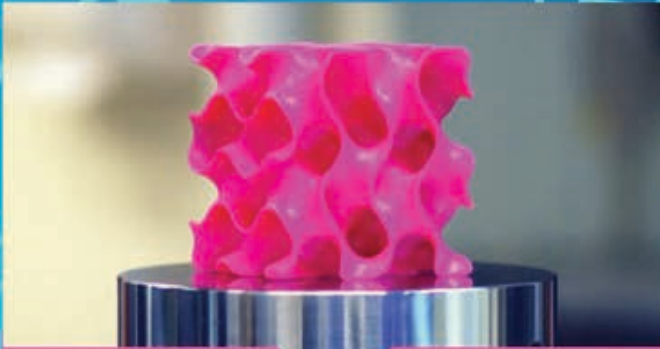

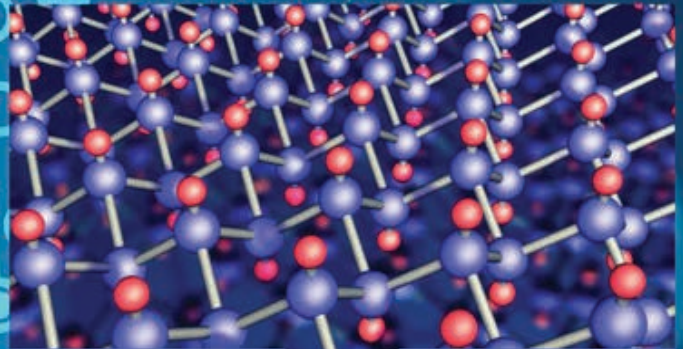

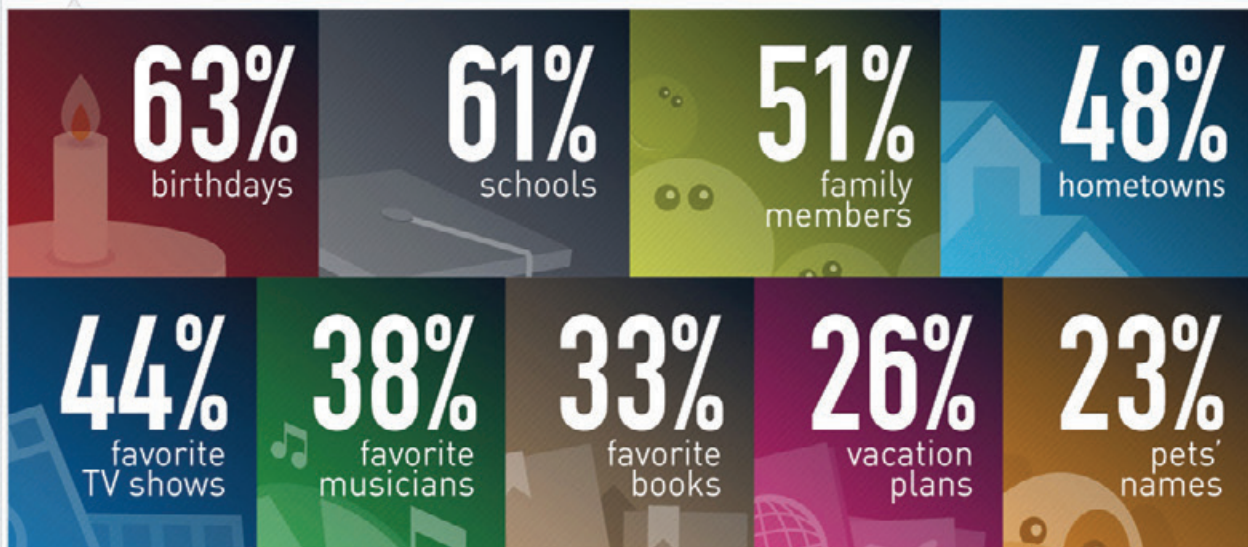

Energy Snapshot



Solar power in US employs more people than any other energy sector


In the United States, more people were employed in solar power last year than in generating electricity through coal, gas and oil energy combined. According to a new report from the U.S. Department of Energy, solar power employed 43 percent of the Electric Power Generation sector's workforce in 2016, while fossil fuels combined accounted for just 22 percent.

Just under 374,000 people were employed in solar energy, according to the report,

while coal, gas and oil power generation combined had a workforce of slightly more than 187,000. The boom in the country's solar workforce can be attributed to construction work associated with expanding generation capacity.

The gulf in employment is growing with net generation from coal falling 53 percent over the last decade. During the same period, electricity generation from natural gas increased 33 percent while solar expanded 5,000 percent.

Fuel production and electricity generation together directly employed 1.9 million workers last year, according to the report, with 55%, or 1.1 million, working with fossil fuels. The DoE identifies another 2.3 million jobs associated with energy transmission, distribution and storage.

Solar energy added 73,615 new jobs to the U.S. economy over the past year while wind added a further 24,650.

Scotland eyes 50% renewable energy by 2030 in shift away from North Sea oil energy sector



The Scottish government has taken the first steps to heavily cutting the country's reliance on North Sea oil and gas after calling for 50% of Scotland's entire energy needs to come from renewables.

In a subtle but significant shift of emphasis for the Scottish National party after decades championing North Sea production, ministers unveiled a new energy strategy

intended to push motorists, homeowners and businesses into using low- or zero-carbon green energy sources for half their energy needs by 2030.

Currently, 47% of Scotland's total energy use comes from petroleum products largely extracted from Scotland's North Sea oil platforms, and 27% from domestic and imported natural gas needed for home heating.

With opposition parties and environment groups expressing scepticism about a lack of detail in the new strategy, Scottish ministers privately admit cutting oil use is their biggest challenge in hitting far tougher targets unveiled last week to reduce Scotland's total greenhouse gas emissions by 66% by 2032.

Is the Era of Oil and Gas Mega projects Over?


With oil prices still trading around the \$50/barrel mark, oil and gas companies will likely revisit costly field development projects, as BP plc did late last year with Mad Dog 2 development project.

The company was able to reduce project costs through system optimization, collaboration with co-owners, simplification of the design using industry-led solutions and competitive bidding to capture deflationary pricing. BP also changed the development concept which can take advantage of standardized designs, BP spokesperson Jason Ryan told

Rigzone. The Mad Dog 2 design now looks more similar to field development projects pursued in the past, Caitlin Shaw, research director with Wood Mackenzie, said.

Does BP's design signal the end of the oil and gas megaproject era? For the most part, yes, industry insiders told Rigzone.

Megaprojects, particularly for deepwater, might crop up occasionally over the next five to 10 years. However, Wood Mackenzie expects to see far fewer of these projects compared to the first half this decade, Shaw said.

Offshore field development costs were already out of control prior to the 2014 oil price collapse. To keep costs under control going forward, oil and gas operators will forgo standalone production facilities altogether for some projects, opting instead to use existing production facilities or subsea tiebacks, Shaw said. Companies may also opt to stretch out project development. Rather than execute a major project in a year, they might develop a field over a four to six year period, Shaw said.

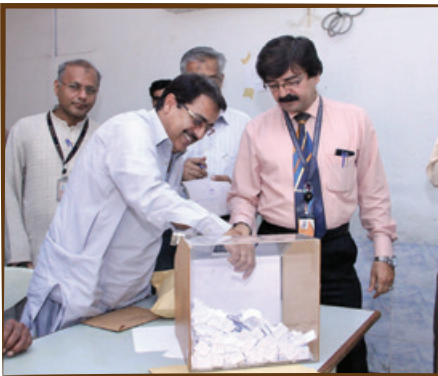
