# BLACKLISTING MECHANISM (REVISION-1)

#### 1 BACKGROUND

In pursuance of Rule-19 of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 read with Rule-2(f) (fa) and the criteria for Blacklisting of Suppliers and Contractors / Consultants doing business with the SSGCs is reiterated hereafter to eliminate unfair trade practices.

#### 2 SCOPE

, r

The procedure shall be applicable and remain in force, along with any amendments thereto, within Sui Southern of a Company Limited ("SSGC") until any clear instructions or guidelines are impacted by the Government through Public Procurement Regulation Authority (PPRA), Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC, or any other competent forum. The procedure shall also be applicable on the prequalified firms. The procedure shall be applicable on any "Person(s) / Firm(s)", which for the purposes of this Mechanism shall be inited alia include suppliers, bidders, contractors, consultants, firms, individuals, and organizations transacting business with SSGC. Wherever any provision of this Mechanism shall be in conflict with provisions of any applicable guidelines of donor agencies, or any other applicable Statute / Lawe. Rule enforced at the time in Pakistan, the provisions of such applicable guidelines, laws, or tales shall prevail. This SOP shall become a part of the future Bidding Documents.

#### 3 DEFINITION OF TERMS

- 3.1 "Appellate Authority" Authority to A al against issuance of Blacklisting Order.
- 3.2 "Appeal" Right of firm/individual to large protest against the issuance of Blacklisting Order.
- 3.3 "Procuring Agency" Any department/division/fractory/project exercising general and/or administrative control over the unit.
- 3.4 "Blacklisting Order" An administrative penalty associatifying a firm/individual from participating in procurement for a given period.
- 3.5 "Suspension" The administrative penalty imposed for intractions committed during the competitive bidding stage, whereby such firms/individuals are prohibited from further participation in the bidding process of Procuring Agency.
- 3.6 "Contract Implementation" A process of undertaking a project or contract in accordance with the contract documents.
- 3.7 "Termination of Contract" Extinction of contract by reason or resolution or rescission under applicable rules/regulations/laws arising from the default of the firms/individuals.
- 3.8 "Delist" Removal of supplier/contractor from blacklisting.
- 3.9 "PA-Project Authority -" A three-member committee comprising of User, HSE&QA & Procurement Deptt. to address the issue.
- 3.10 RPC-SSG's Rights Protection Committee To examine the justification of PC.

#### REASONS FOR BLACKLISTING 4.

The following shall comprise the broad multilateral guidelines for blacklisting: 4.1

4.1. I "Corrupt Practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution;

4.1.2 "Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to

influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract;

4.1.3 "Collusive Practice" means a scheme of arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the Purchaser, designed to establish bid price at artificial, non-competitive levels, and

4.1.4 "Coercive Practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, Person(s) / Firm(s) or their property to influence their participation in the

procurement process or affect the execution of a contract.

In addition to above, blacklisting of firms/individuals may be resorted to when the 4.2 charges are of serious nature, which include but are not limited to the following:

In addition to the penalty of suspension, the bid security posted by the concerned bidder or prospective bidder could also be forfeited / encashed.

#### 4.2.2 Purchase Order / Contract Implementation Stage

During the Purchase Order / Contract implementation stage, the procuring entity shall impose on contractors after the termination of the contract the penalty of suspension from participating in the public bidding process, without prejudice to the imposition of additional administrative sanctions as the internal rules of the agency may provide and/or further criminal prosecution, as provided by applicable laws, for violations committed which include but are not limited to the following:

Failure of the contractor, due solely to his fault or negligence, to mobilize and start work

or performance within the specified period in the Letter to Proceed.

- callure by the contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual obligations with ut valid cause, or failure by the contractor to comply with any written lawful instruction of the Procuring Agency or its representative(s) pursuant to the implementation of the contract. For the procurement of infrastructure projects or consultant a contracts, lawful instructions include but are not limited to the following:
  - a. Employment of competent technical Person(s) / Firm(s)nel, competent engineers and/or respectively.
  - b. Provision of warning signs and barricades in accordance with approved plans and specifications ar contract provisions;
  - c. Stockpiling in purper places of all materials and removal from the project site of waste and excess in erials, including broken pavement and excavated debris in accordance with approach plans and specifications and contract provisions;
  - d. Deployment of committed edipment, facilities, support staff and manpower; and
  - e. Renewal of the effectivity date of the performance security after its expiration during the course of contract in the performance.
  - f. Non-Performance of the supplier it respect of tender terms & conditions and the delivery / supply of material.
- iii. Assignment and subcontracting of the contract of any part thereof or substitution of key Person(s) / Firm(s)nel named in the proposal with a prior written approval by the Procuring Agency.
- iv. For the procurement of goods, unsatisfactory progress in the delivery of the goods by the manufacturer, supplier or distributor arising from his fault or negligence and/or unsatisfactory or inferior quality of goods, as may be provided in necontract.
- v. For the procurement of consulting services, poor performance by the consultant of his services arising from his fault or negligence, any of the following act by the consultant shall be construed as poor performance:
  - a. Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and/or construction;
  - b. Failure to deliver critical outputs due to. consultant's fault or negligence;
  - c. Specifying materials which are inappropriate, substandard or way above acceptable standards;

In addition to the penalty of suspension, the performance security posted by the contractor could also be forfeited.

    - ix. Involved in litigation or needless petition in the influence or obstruct the procurement process either on his own behalf or at the behest of any other vested interest;

#### SYSTEM OF PENALTIES 5.

For the purpose of uniformity, following system of penalties shall be adopted for procurement of goods, works and services:

5,1 Blacklisted and henceforth cross debarred for participation in any public procurement or disposal proceedings for the period of not more than ten years, if corrupt and fraudulent

However, procuring agency shall initiate such blacklisting or debarment proceedings after exhausting the forum of arbitration, provided that such provision exists in the conditions of contract, and if such failure or breach is covered in the respective dispute settlement clauses of the contract, and
- 5.3 blacklisted and henceforth cross debarred for participation in respective category of public procurement or disposal proceedings for a period of not more than six months, if the bidder fails to abide with a bid securing declaration, however without being indulged in any corrupt and fraudulent practice.

#### 6. SUPENSION AND BLACKLISTING PROCEDURE

- The surplier or contractor who is to be blacklisted for a specified period is given adequate opportunity of being heard.
- 2. The supplies or contractor who is to be blacklisted for a specified period is called for meeting by providing adequate time, so as to given him adequate opportunity of being heard before taking in action.
- 3. In case the supplier or co to ctor does not attend the meeting on the given date and time a final notice is served to him, her to attend the meeting on the revised date and time. Despite the final notice, if the supplier or contractor does not attend the meeting as per schedule, automatically be conclude at at fault. Action will be taken as per below clauses 5 to 9.
- 4. A three-member committee will form openising of User, Procurement and HSE&QA departments to address the issues in the me ting with the supplier or contractor. Members of committee may not below of grade IV.
- 5. In case the supplier or contractor is found at default based on the fact of the case as well as the tender terms and conditions, and do not justify the grounds of his default as per the tender terms and conditions, the approval is sought from the management for their temporary or permeant blacklisting along with encashing of bid bond or PBG as the case may be.
- The decision of the management is communicated to the decuper supplier or contractor through a formal letter.
- A copy of the letter of the defaulted supplier / contractor alongwith covering letter with pertinent documents is / also forwarded to the Authority (PPRA) for uploading on PPRA website.
- 8. The blacklisting information of the supplier / contractor is uploaded on the websites.

- Any bidder not satisfied with the decision of the procuring agency, may lodge an appeal in the relevant court of jurisdiction.
- 10. After coming into force the procurement contracts, the dispute between the parties to the contract shall be settled by arbitration.

## 7. STATUS OF BLACKLISTED FIRM/INDIVIDUAL

Blacklisting of a firm/individual will not affect other ongoing contracts/works/supply orders. However, such blacklisted firm shall stand barred from all future tender processes/participation and Standing Security, if any, could be confiscated until recovery of financial damages ascertained by the authority while issuing Blacklisting Order.

#### 8. DELISTING

A temporary blacklisted firm / individual shall be automatically restored after the period for the penalty have lapsed, unless the procuring agency wants to maintain the blacklisted status of firm / individual the to justifiable reasons with the prior approval of Appellate Authority. In the latter case, the tem or a blacklisted firm / individual shall be restored.

#### 9. AMENDMENTS

- 9.1 In the implementation of Blacklisting Mechanism, the modifications may be introduced thereto through the angent pient of its specific provisions as the need arises.
- 9.2 Any amendment to this Black ting Mechanism shall be applicable to tenders advertised for bid after the effectivity of he said amendment.

#### 10. EFFECTIVITY

The Blacklisting Mechanism or any amendments, ereof shall take effect immediately and from the date of its issuance. All future tender documents must be governed by these instructions. However, these cannot override the provisions of Pul as Procurement Rules, 2004.

## 11. The Steps to be Followed ar A Under

The causes and reasons to be taken into consideration for Debarment / la Aisting of any Person(s) / Firm(s) are given as under:

#### 1. PRE-AWARD STAGE:

The following shall be considered, inter alia, the events / reasons for initiating proceedings under this Mechanism at the Pre-Award Stage:

- i Indulging in Corrupt: Fraudulent as well as Collusive practices.
- ii Submission of false and spurious documents, making false statements, making frivolous complaints and allegations to gain undue advantage.

#### 2. POST- AWARD STAGE:

The following shall be considered, interalia, the events / reasons for initiating proceedings under this Mechanism anthe Post-Award Stage:-

- i. Extend an ary delay in signing or refusal to accept the Notification of Award and/or the contract validation ary cogent reason.
- ii. Misconduct, i.e. a ilure to proceed with the signed contract, withdrawal of commitments, quoting an unleasonably and unfairly lew financial offer and subsequently withdrawing such an offer, frestraing the evaluation/bidding process and not responding to written communication in a reso able time.
- iii. Causes mentioned in Sub-Causes i, ii and fii above:
- iv. Submission of fake / frivolous emplifated Performance Guarantee or Advance Payment Guarantee etc.
- V. Non-satisfactory performance during the every urion of the contract / purchase order.
- vi. Non-performance or Breach of provisions / tlauses of the contract agreements/tender terms.
- vii. Notwithstanding the warranty/defect liability period, any direct in a product, equipment, plant, facility or services rendered that may subsequently so the during field operations within 5 years of its commissioning.
- viii. Failure to honour obligations within warranty period or defect lia fility period as defined in the contract.

#### 3. OTHER CAUSES:

- i. The Person(s) / Firm(s) is blacklisted by any Government department in Pakistan, or it is established that the firm is involved in any kind of corruption or corrupt practices anywhere in the world.

#### 7. DECISION

The committee shall hold an independent inquiry/investigation as the case may be, and, which may include site visits and interviews with the parties concerned. The Committee shall complete the entire inquiry/investigation, preferably within a period of 30 days after receipt of response from the Person(s) / Firm(s) against whom proceedings under this Mechanism has been initiated and shall present the report to the Managing Director, SSGC. If required, the Committee may report the case to an appropriate law enforcement agency depending upon the nature of the case for detailed investigations with the prior approval of Managing Director, SSGC. iii. The Person(s) / Firm(s) against whom proceedings have been initiated under this Mechanism shall not proceed for arbitration/litigation during the proceedings for blacklisting.

### 8. COMMUNICATION OF DECISION

After recommendation for temporary & permanent blacklisting by "SSGC's Rights Protection Committee (RPC)", the Person(s) / Firm(s) concerned shall be informed within 10 days of such decision. The decision of the Committee will be notified on SSGC 's and PPRA's websites and shall also be conveyed in kistan Engineering Council.

The temporary Blacklisting or the grounds and reasons specified herein above shall be for a reasonable specified period of time and as a general rule of prudence, the period may not exceed three years, except in cases of re-debarment/blacklisting has been done by any other government department or an International Financial Institution (Donor Agency). In case the Person(s) / Firm(s) has been blacklisted by the government department or the International Financial

Institution (donor agency), the period of term rary blacklisting/debarment shall be for a maximum period of 3 years or the time period for which the concerned government department/International Financial Institution (I of or Agency) debarred the contractor (whichever is higher). However the permanent blacklisting a mot be revived.

- ii. In case of a contract already awarded to a Person(s) / Firm(s) which has be in blacklisted and termination is either not possible or not feasible, the concerned Project Authority. (iii) The blacklisted Person(s) / Firm(s) shall stand disqualified from bidding from the date of decision against them. Any pending bids shall also stand rejected. If a contract has already been awarded to Person(s) / Firm(s), it shall be voidable at the option of SSGC. (iv) A separate register or data base will be maintained for blacklisted firms indicating reasons and period.

#### 9. Effectiveness
