## 4. Joint Ventures:

## 13.6 Specification compliance Sheet:

Company requires a chaise-by-clause commentary on the Specifications, demonstrating the materials responsiveness to those specifications or a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the specifications, it so equired/desired. For purposes of the commentary to be furnished pursuant to above, the bidder snall to be that standards for workmanship, material and equipment and references to brand names of catalogue numbers, designated by the Company in the specifications are intended to be descriptive or and not restrictive. The bidder may substitute other authoritative standards, brand names and/or scale the numbers in its bid provided which demonstrates to the Company's satisfaction that the substitutes are equivalent or superior to those designated in the specifications by the Company.

13.7 The offer shall be accompanied with all technical data documents/certifications as required under the tender specifications. 13.8 Deviation to technical specifications:

The bidder shall fill the "technical compliance sheet" and mention of the specifications along with reference to its technical brochure/literature (page/clause No.etc). Stat here such as "Compliant" or "Confirmed" is not acceptable. Deviation to tender terms and technical specification is not acceptable. ## 14. Award/Evaluation Criteria:

- 14.2 Generally for other items other than above, ordering shall be based on technical compliance and lowest quoted price. Supplies may be subject to pre shipment inspection and post qualification by a third party in case of foreign material. If required during the process of manufacturing and / or inspection. SSGCL representative may visit the manufacturer facility to witness the manufacturing / inspection process.



- 14.3 Evaluation may be carried out both on item or on group of items/single or multiple package basis depending upon the nature of requirement exclusively at the discretion of the company to ensure economic procurement.
- 14.4 Company reserve the right to settle the final terms of supply with the lowest evaluated and commercially responsive bidder: Any effort by the bidder (s) to influence the outcome of bid evaluation or placement of purchase order may result in disqualification of the bidder.

## 15. Loading of Bids:

In the event of the bid bond validity falling short of the prescribed period of 150 days as the case may be either (i) due to extension in the bid submission date or (ii) where so required by the procuring agency, than in such an event it shall be mandatory on the bidder to extend the bid bond validity up to 150 days within 30 days of the opening of technical proposal / bid, and / or where so required by the procuring agency.

In case when bidder submit alternate bids a separate bid bond for each bid is required otherwise bid will be liable for rejection. In case of Single Stage Two Envelope bidding system (bid bond will be enclosed with "Financial" bid, unless and until specified separately in Tender terms).

## 10. Performance Bond:

## 12. Completion Period:

Subject to any requirements as to completion of any portion of the Work before he completion of the whole of Work, the Work shall be completed within the specified completion period. Work shall not be considered as completed until the Company has certified in writing that it has been completed. Should extra, altered or additional Work of any kind, or any other cause of delay, which in the opinion of the Company could not have been foreseen by the Contractor / Consultant requires extension in completion time, then on the written request of the Contractor / Consultant, the completion period as provided in the Contract shall be extended by the Company. All such extensions shall be allowed in writing by the Company's representative.

## 13. Signing / Execution of Contract / Agreement:

Formal signing / execution of Contract / Agreement shall be completed within fifteen (15) days of receipt of "Letter to Proceed". The Company shall prepare the Contract in accordance with the prescribed format (Contract Form, and Articles of Agreement) for the purpose and the successful Bidder shall be communicated the date and time by the Company for the execution of Contract.

The successful Bidder shall provide the stamp paper, of value at the rate of thirty five (35) paisa per every hundred Rupees or part thereof of the amount of the Contract, or at the prevailing rate as specified by the Government of Pakistan.

## 14. Award / Evaluation Criteria:

## 15. Commencement & Execution of Work:

Notwithstanding any delay in the preparation / execution of the Contract the successful Bidder shall commence mobilization / preparations and under take the Work within (15) days after receipt of the Letter to Proceed.

The Contractor / Consultant shall prior to commencement of Work, obtain the written authority and instruction of the Company.

### 16. Change Course

The Compaly may a tany time, by a written notice to the Contractor / Consultant, make changes within the general Scope of Work of the Contract.

Upon notification by the Company of such change, the Contractor / Consultant shall submit to the Company an estimate of costs for the proposed change (hereinafter referred to as a change) within ten (10) calendar days of receipt (10) in occupant of the change, and shall include an estimate of the impact (if any) of the change on the completion the square formula to the change, if applicable.

The Contractor / Consultant shall preferr changes in accordance with above, until the Company has authorized a Change Order in writing in the basis of the estimate provided by the Contractor / Consultant.

Changes mutually agreed upon as a charge's all constitute a part of the Work under this Contract, and the provisions and conditions of the Contract sharply to said change.

#### 17. Assignment:

The Contractor / Consultant shall not assign, it will be or in part, its obligations to perform under the Contract except with the Company's prior written contract.

## 18. - Termination of Contract:

The Company may decide to terminate the Contract in one of the sollowing situations:

## (i) Termination for Default:

The Company may, without prejudice to any other remedy or breach of Contract, by written notice of default sent to the Contractor / Consultant, terminate the Contract in whole or in part.

- (a) If the Contractor / Consultant fails to complete the conjugate Works / Services within the time period(s) specified in the Contract or any extension thereof granted by the Company.
- (b) If the Contractor / Consultant fails to perform any other obligation s) under the Contract.
- (c) If the Company during the completion period of the Contract has reason to believe that the Contractor / Consultant will not be able to fulfill the obligations in a the Contract.

Prior to the exercising of any right by the Company to terminate the Contract, the company shall issue notice to the Contractor / Consultant specifying the default(s) and the Contractor / Consultant shall submit an explanation within seven (07) days of receipt of such notice. If such explanation is not furnished within the stipulated time or if so furnished, is found to be unsatisfactory and / or the default(s) continues, the Contract may be terminated by the Company.

#### (ii) Termination for Insolvency:

The Company may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the Contractor / Consultant, without compensation to the Contractor / Consultant, if the Contractor / Consultant becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. Notwithstanding the above such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which as accrued or will occur thereafter to the Company.



### (iii) Termination for Convenience:

- a. The Company may by written notice sent to the Contractor / Consultant, terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the company's convenience, the extent to which performance of work under the Contract is terminated and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.
- b. The Works that are complete and ready for Commissioning within thirty (30) days after the Contractor / Consultant's receipt of notice of termination shall be at the Contract prices and on the existing Contract terms. For the remaining Works, the Company can also opt to have any portion thereof completed and commissioned at the contract prices and on the other contract terms.

## 19. Liquidated Damages:

If the Contractor / Consultant fails to complete the Work or perform the Services specified in the Contract within the stipulated period / scheduled time specified in the Contract, the Company, without prejudice to any other remedies, shall deduct from the bills or any other due payments / guarantees, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to 0.1 % per day of the value the Contract, until actual completion of the Work or performance of the Services. However if delay of over 100 days takes place (i.e. equal to 10%), the Company / eserves the right to terminate the Contract at the risk and cost of Contractor / Consultant. The liquidate representation of the Works / Services terminated under Clause 16.

The payment of liquidated damages shall not relieve the Contractor / Consultant from performing and fulfilling all its obligations under the Contract and nor shall the rights and entitlements of the Company be affected or reduced in any manner.

## 20. Force Majeure:

The parties will not be considered to be in default in the execution of their contractual obligations or any of them to the extent that the execution of such obligations or any of them is delayed or omitted by cause of Force Majeure. Each party will advise the other party by written notice within 07 days of the occurrence of any such case of Force Majeure. The term Force Majeure employed herein shall mean acts of public enemy, wars (whether declared or considered) is vasion, hostilities, revolution, epidemics, riots (other than among the Contractor / Consultant's own employed) fires, floods, earth quake, commotion, disorder and other causes similar in kind to those herein in an or of, not under the control of either party, which makes the performance of this agreement unfeasible and which by the exercise of due diligence the party seeking excuse from performance is unable to over control.

The Company shall not be liable to the Contracted Consultant for any damage or loss caused by Force Majeure directly or indirectly.

#### 21. Safety of Employees and Works:

The Contractor / Consultant shall be responsible to take and eccessary precautions for the safety of employees on or off the Work, and shall comply with all applicable safety laws and codes to prevent accidents or injury to persons on about or adjacent to the places where the Work is being performed. All statutory rules, orders, regulation from time to time in force relating to along and observance of all safety precaution governing or which might be deemed to be given during the expection and performance of the Work. The Contractor / Consultant shall comply with any and all personnel safety regulations. Any person of the Contractor / Consultant violating the safety rules shall be removed by the Contractor / Consultant from site and replaced without delay.

## 22. Insurance:

The Contractor / Consultant shall be responsible for obtaining a Contractor / Consultant's All Risk Policy (CAR) against risks to the Works and shall make good at his own cost, all losses or damages whether to the Works or to the lives, persons, whether under the workmen's compensation Act or Third Party Risk, or property of others from whatsoever cause arising out of or in connection with the works either during the progress of the works or during the period of maintenance provided by this Contract.

The Contractor / Consultant shall arrange insurance approved by the Company fully to cover workmen compensation and other claims arising out of sickness, injury or death of his personnel working at site and also to cover theft, loss of or damage to the Company's material in his possession and to indemnity the Company for third party claims for damage done or said to have been done to those persons or their property as a result of the Contractor / Consultant's activities on and off the site.

## 23. Dispute Resolution:

If any dispute shall arise as to the interpretation of this Contract or any matter or thing arising there from, the same shall be settled as far as possible by way of amicable resolution. Failing such settlement, the dispute may be to be for arbitration to two Arbitrators, one to be nominated by each Party. The appointed Arbitrators that before proceeding on the reference appoint an Umpire. # BLACKLISTING MECHANISM (REVISION-1)

### 1 BACKGROUND

In pursuance of Rule-19 of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 read with Rule-2(f) (fa) and the criteria for Blacklisting of Suppliers and Contractors / Consultants doing business with the SSGCs is reiterated hereafter to eliminate unfair trade practices.

### 2 SCOPE

The procedure shall be applicable and remain in force, along with any amendments thereto, within Sui Southern Gas Corpany Limited ("SSGC") until any clear instructions or guidelines are impacted by the Government it such Public Procurement Regulation Authority (PPRA), Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC), or any other competent forum. The procedure shall also be applicable on the prequalified firms. The procedure shall be applicable on any "Person(s) / Firin(s)", which for the purposes of this Mechanism shall outer alia include suppliers, bidders, contractors, consultants, firms, individuals, and organizations transacting business with SSGC. Wherever any provision of this Mechanism shall be in conflict with provisions of any applicable guidelines of donor agencies, or any other applicable Statute / Law of the enforced at the time in Pakistan, the provisions of such applicable guidelines, laws, or rule shall prevail. This SOP shall become a part of the future Bidding Documents.

### 3 DEFINITION OF TERMS

- 3.1 "Appellate Authority" Authority to Appeal gainst issuance of Blacklisting Order.
- 3.2 "Appeal" Right of firm/individual to leagt protest against the issuance of Blacklisting Order.
- 3.3 "Procuring Agency" Any department/division actory/project exercising general and/or administrative control over the unit.
- 3.4 "Blacklisting Order" An administrative penalty discualifying a firm/individual from participating in procurement for a given period.
- 3.5 "Suspension" The administrative penalty imposed for increasing committed during the competitive bidding stage, whereby such firms/individuals to ohibited from further participation in the bidding process of Procuring Agency.
- 3.6 "Contract Implementation" A process of undertaking a project of contract in accordance with the contract documents.
- 3.7 "Termination of Contract" Extinction of contract by reason or resolution or rescission under applicable rules/regulations/laws arising from the default of the firms/individuals.
- 3.8 "Delist" Removal of supplier/contractor from blacklisting.
- 3.9 "PA-Project Authority -" A three-member committee comprising of User, HSE&QA & Procurement Deptt. to address the issue.
- 3.10 RPC-SSG's Rights Protection Committee To examine the justification of PC.

## REASONS FOR BLACKLISTING

The following shall comprise the broad multilateral guidelines for blacklisting: 4.1

4.1. I "Corrupt Practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution;

4.1.2 "Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to

influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract;

4.1.3 "Collusive Practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the Purchaser, designed to establish bid price at artificial, non-competitive levels, and

4.1.4 "Coercive Practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, Person(s) / Firm(s) or their property to influence their participation in the

procurement process or affect the execution of a contract.

In addition to above, blacklisting of firms/individuals may be resorted to when the parges are of serious nature, which include but are not limited to the following:

Competitive Bidding Stage

During the competitive bidding stage, the Procuring Agency shall impose on bidders or prospect; bidders the penalty of Suspension from participating in the public bidding process, wit out prejudice to the imposition of additional administrative sanctions as the agency may provide and/or further criminal prosecution, as provided for violations committed which include but are not limited to the by applicable law following:

- Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder to unduly influence the outcome xi. of the bidding in his favor.
- Any attempt to give illegal gratification to any representative of the purchaser to ·xii. influence the process of procurement.

In addition to the penalty of suspension, the bid security posted by the concerned bidder or prospective bidder could also be forfeited / encashed.

### 4.2.2 Purchase Order / Contract Implementation Stage

During the Purchase Order / Contract implementation stage, the procuring entity shall impose on contractors after the termination of the contract the penalty of suspension from participating in the public bidding process, without prejudice to the imposition of additional administrative sanctions as the internal rules of the agency may provide and/or further criminal prosecution, as provided by applicable laws, for violations committed which include but are not limited to the following:

- Failure of the contractor, due solely to his fault or negligence, to mobilize and start work i. performance within the specified period in the Letter to Proceed.
- there by the contractor to fully and faithfully comply with its contractual obligations valid cause, or failure by the contractor to comply with any written lawful on of the Procuring Agency or its representative(s) pursuant to the impleme ration of the contract. For the procurement of infrastructure projects or consultancy contracts, lawful instructions include but are not limited to the following:
  - Employment of competent technical Person(s) / Firm(s)nel, competent engineers and/or w/rks pervisors:
  - ng signs and barricades in accordance with approved plans and
  - specifications and contract provisions;

  - Defective design resulting in substantial corrective works in design and/or construction;
  - Failure to deliver critical outputs due to. consultant's fault or negligence;
  - Specifying materials which are inappropriate, substandard or way above acceptable standards;

- Allowing defective workmanship or works by the contractor being supervised by the consultant; and
- Submitting CV's of key Person(s) / Firm(s)nel in the prequalifying process or bid documents of professionals that are not in actual employment of the bidder.
- VI. For the procurement of infrastructure projects, poor performance by the contractor or unsatisfactory quality and/or progress of works arising from his fault or negligence.
- vii. Willful or deliberate abandonment or non-performance of the project or contract by the contractor resulting to substantial breach thereof without lawful and/or just

In addition to the penalty of suspension, the performance security posted by the contractor could also be forfeited.

- 4.2.3 In addition to above, other grounds for blacklisting of firms/individuals include but are not ted to the following:
  - Obtaining fraudulent payments;
  - ii. Obtaining outracts by misleading the purchaser:
  - iii. Refusal to pay SGC dues etc.;
  - iv. Failure to ful incontractual obligations:
  - Changes in the atty of firm's ownership/partnership etc. causing dissolution which existed at the i to of inspection / bidding prior to original registration of the firm;
  - vi. Registration of a firm, 7th a new name by the Proprietor or family or a nominee thereof of a firm that has been already to klisted;
    vii. Consequential operational drugges caused to SSGC equipment or infrastructure as a result
- of equipment or parts thereof stopled on trial basis or due to failure of such equipment;
  viii. Contractors who have negotiated the Sargain under the National Accountability Ordinance
  1999, or contractors involved with any other criminal proceedings conducted by any proved specifically in relation to supplies made investigation agency where default has be to or contracts concluded with SSGC.
- ix. Involved in litigation or needless petitioning of induence or obstruct the procurement process either on his own behalf or at the behest of an other yested interest;
- x. A firm may be disqualified for a period extendable way years in case a decision by a court is awarded against the said firm after litigation, or where a transfer is involved in litigation at least three times during two financial years, or where a transfer on account of litigation caused substantial financial losses to SSGC;
- xi. Blacklisted by other Federal and Provincial Government Minister s / Divisions / Departments and organizations / autonomous bodies subordinate thereto; and

# 5. SYSTEM OF PENALTIES

For the purpose of uniformity, following system of penalties shall be adopted for procurement of goods, works and services:

However, procuring agency shall initiate such blacklisting or debarment proceedings after exhausting the forum of arbitration, provided that such provision exists in the conditions of contract, and if such failure or breach is covered in the respective dispute settlement clauses of the contract, and
- 5.3 blacklisted and henceforth cross debarred for participation in respective category of public procurement or disposal proceedings for a period of not more than six months, if the bidder fails to abide with a bid securing declaration, however without being indulged in any corrupt and fraudulent practice.

## 6. SUSPENSION AND BLACKLISTING PROCEDURE

- 1. The support or contractor who is to be blacklisted for a specified period is given adequate opportunit of being heard.
- 2. The supplier or contractor who is to be blacklisted for a specified period is called for meeting by providing adequate time, so as to given him adequate opportunity of being heard before taking an action.
- 3. In case the supplier or contractor does not attend the meeting on the given date and time a final notice is served to him, her to attend the meeting on the revised date and time. Despite the final notice, if the draftier or contractor does not attend the meeting as per schedule, automatically be considered at fault. Action will be taken as per below clauses 5 to 9.
- 4. A three-member committee will form or rising of User, Procurement and HSE&QA departments to address the issues in the mer has with the supplier or contractor. Members of committee may not below of grade IV.
- 5. In case the supplier or contractor is found at default bared on the fact of the case as well as the tender terms and conditions, and do not just by the grounds of his default as per the tender terms and conditions, the approval is sought on the management for their temporary or permeant blacklisting alongwith encashment and bond or PBG as the case may be.
- The decision of the management is communicated to the defaute supplier or contractor through a formal letter.
- 7. A copy of the letter of the defaulted supplier / contractor along with covering letter with pertinent documents is / also forwarded to the Authority (PPRA) for uploading on PPRA website.
- 8. The blacklisting information of the supplier / contractor is uploaded on the websites.

- 9. Any bidder not satisfied with the decision of the procuring agency, may lodge an appeal in the relevant court of jurisdiction.
- 10. After coming into force the procurement contracts, the dispute between the parties to the contract shall be settled by arbitration.

### STATUS OF BLACKLISTED FIRM/INDIVIDUAL

Blacklisting of a firm/individual will not affect other ongoing contracts/works/supply orders. However, such blacklisted firm shall stand harred from all future tender processes/participation and Standing Security, if any, could be confiscated until recovery of financial damages ascertained by the authority while issuing Blacklisting Order.

### 8. DELISTING

A temporary lacklisted firm / individual shall be automatically restored after the period for the penalty has eleps d, unless the procuring agency wants to maintain the blacklisted status of firm / individual due to justifiable reasons with the prior approval of Appellate Authority. In the latter case, the temporary blacklisted firm / individual shall be restored.

### 9. AMENDMENTS

- 9.1 In the implementation of cacklisting Mechanism, the modifications may be introduced thereto through the amendment of its specific provisions as the need arises.
- 9.2 Any amendment to this Blackly dry Mechanism shall be applicable to tenders advertised for bid after the effectivity of the said amendment.

### 10. EFFECTIVITY

The Blacklisting Mechanism or any amendments the conshall take effect immediately and from the date of its issuance. All future tender documents must be governed by these instructions. However, these cannot override the provisions of Public Providement Rules, 2004.

# 11. The Steps to be Followed are As Index

The causes and reasons to be taken into consideration for Debarment / Black sting of any Person(s) / Pirm(s) are given as under:

### 1. PRE-AWARD STAGE:

The following shall be considered, inter alia, the events / reasons for initiating proceedings under this Mechanism at the Pre-Award Stage:

- i Indulging in Corrupt: Fraudulent as well as Collusive practices.
- ii Submission of false and spurious documents, making false statements, making frivolous complaints and allegations to gain undue advantage.

- commission of embezzlement, criminal breach of trust, theft, cheating, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, false use of trademark, securing fraudulent registration, giving false evidence, furnishing of false information of serious nature.
- iv Submission of false bid security or infringement of documents to get undue monetary or any other benefit.
- v Breach of confidentiality of evaluation process based on illegal access or in any way to get undue benefit or to provide benefit or to frustrate the bidding/evaluation process. This will also include attempts to sabotage the bidding process directly or indirectly.

### 2. POST-AWARD STAGE:

The following shall be considered, interalia, the events / reasons for initiating proceedings under this Mechanism at the Post-Award Stage:-

- i. Extractionary delay in signing or refusal to accept the Notification of Award and/or the contract with ut any cogent reason.
- ii. Misconduct, e., failure to proceed with the signed contract, withdrawal of commitments, quoting an unrear tably and unfairly low financial offer and subsequently withdrawing such an offer, frustrain, the evaluation/bidding process and not responding to written communication in a respect to time.
- iii. Causes mentioned in Sub-Claussi, ii and iii above:
- iv. Submission of fake / frivolous or min ted Performance Guarantee or Advance Payment Guarantee etc.
- v. Non-satisfactory performance during the execution of the contract / purchase order.
- vi. Non-performance or Breach of provisions / Ja ses of the contract agreements/tender terms.
- vii. Notwithstanding the warranty/defect liability period, any defect in a product, equipment, plant, facility or services rendered that may subsequently up and during field operations within 5 years of its commissioning.
- viii. Failure to honour obligations within warranty period or defect liability period as defined in the contract.

### 3. OTHER CAUSES:

- i. The Person(s) / Firm(s) is blacklisted by any Government department in Pakistan, or it is established that the firm is involved in any kind of corruption or corrupt practices anywhere in the world.
- ii, Violations-of provisions / instructions set down in the Bidding Documents.

### 6. INITIATION OF AN ACTION

- (i) Within a period of 15 days after receiving the recommendation of Blacklisting / Debarment from the concerned Project Authority, the Convener of the Committee shall issue a Show Cause Notice ("Notice") thereby informing the Person(c) Firm(s) about the alleged charges and shall provide an opportunity to the defend said charges within a time period of 15 (fifteen) days.
- (ii) The Person(s) / Firm(s)(s) shall be accorded adequate opportunity of hearing in order to defend the charges within the given timelines.
- (iii) The Notice to the Person(s) / Firm(s) shall be sent at the mailing/postal address as provided under the Contract or any other address provided by way of subsequent written communication by the Person(s) / Firm(s) The non-receipt of the Notice due to incorrect / change in mailing address without any written communication shall not be attributable to

The committee shall hold an independent inquiry/investigation as the case may be, and, which may include site visits and interviews with the parties concerned. The Committee shall complete the entire inquiry/investigation, preferably within a period of 30 days after receipt of response from the Person(s) / Firm(s) against whom proceedings under this Mechanism has been initiated and shall present the report to the Managing Director, SSGC. If required, the Committee may report the case to an appropriate law enforcement agency depending upon the nature of the case for detailed investigations with the prior approval of Managing Director, SSGC. iii. 


