

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. **Escalation:** All unit prices quoted shall be firm and irrevocable and shall not be subject to escalation on any account, whatsoever.
2. **Bid Instructions**
 - Examination:**

Bidders shall visit the work site and shall fully acquaint themselves with the nature of requirement of work i.e. access to site, availability of materials, weather, law and order and local conditions etc.
 - Clarifications**

Each Bidder shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before submitting as to the correctness and sufficiency of its tender / offer and the rates quoted, which shall cover all its obligations under the contract and all matters and things necessary for proper completion and maintenance of the work.
3. **Bill of Quantities**

Payment shall be made on the basis of actual work quantum as measured. No claims shall be entertained on account of increase or decrease in the scope of work.
4. **Bid Documents**

Tender documents may not be used for any purpose other than tendering on this specific job and shall not be reproduced without the written permission of the company.
5. **List of Equipments**

The bidder shall submit with the bid, a complete list of equipment proposed to be used in carrying out the work.
6. **Signing Authority**

Bidder shall return all tender documents duly signed on all papers by an authorized representative of the Bidder and shall also carry official stamp of the Bidders Firm.
7. **Postal Address:**

Bidder shall provide his mailing Address, Contact number or Fax Number (if any) as provided at the time of Registration. In case of any change or amendment the bidder is liable to inform the Company concerns in his first leisure.
8. **Disqualification / Rejection of Bids**

Failure to comply with any instruction in the tender documents would render the bid liable to disqualification and rejection.
9. **Unit work rates:**

Once the bidder quoted rates against the work as per actual BoQ will be considered final and no change / excuse in accordance of work will be accepted by the bidder.
10. **Check List**

Bidder shall ensure submission of all documents as acquired i.e. all pages of the bid duly signed and stamped.
11. The lowest bidder after acceptance of LOI will submit the stamp paper valuing Rs. 1000/= (where the bid amount if from 100,000 to 500,000) as per Baluchistan Sales Tax Act. Contractor will also be liable to submit a second copy of contract duly signed & stamped on stamp paper of Rs. 50/= Rupees.

SCOPE OF WORK

Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSGC) intends to construct / lay different diameter distribution gas pipeline for **REINF. SCHEME FOR TOUHEEDI MASJID KILLI GUL MUHAMMAD AIR PORT ROAD, QUETTA.**

The scope of work under the subject tender enquiry consists but not limited to the following:

- I. Excavation for check pits for selecting pipeline route and locating underground utilities and back filling the same after finalization of route.
- II. Arrange caretaker / Chowkidar for the safety of material until the completion of job.
- III. Excavation for trenches of required size in different type of soil.
- IV. Provide 6" \emptyset sand cushioning around the pipe at the required locations as advised by site engineer.
- V. Repair of underground utilities damaged during excavation.
- VI. The contractor shall supply all finances, manpower, machinery and required material for the excavation of the work.

The contractor shall ensure safe and proper excavation of the construction work with proper and sufficient machinery / equipment and adequate manpower and shall complete the work within the scheduled time.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITION

1. The Contractor hereby agrees to carry out the work set down in the BOQ in accordance with Specifications and Instruction of this Contract.
2. The Contractor shall provide all labour, Skilled/Unskilled, tools, and any other item necessary for the work and shall be responsible for all duties / taxes and his rates shall include for all these except only the which shall be issued free of charge to him by the Company at site.
3. The work shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Company's Engineer / Manager and the Contractor's rate shall include for all incidental and contingent work which, although not specifically mentioned in this Contract are necessary for its completion in a sound and workman like manner.
4. The Company's Engineer / Manager shall have power to:
Reduce the rates at which payment shall be made if the quality of the work although acceptable is not up to the required standard.
 - a. Order the Contractor to demolish or rectify any work of inferior workmanship failing which the Company's Engineer / Manager may arrange for any such work to be demolished or rectified by any other means at the Contractor's expense.
 - b. Order the Contractor to dismiss or replace any workmen whom he considers incompetent and if in his opinion, the performance of any workman / employee of contractor or any of his acts of omission or commission are prejudicial to its interests and to remove any equipment he considers unfit.
5. The Contractor shall have no claim against the Company in respect of any work, which may be withdrawn, abandoned or postponed except for work actually completed under this Contract.
6. The Contractor hereby agrees to indemnify the Company against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, damages or expenses arising out of or in connection with the carrying out the work aforesaid whether or not such actions, suits Proceedings, claims, damages or expenses shall arise or be brought or have to be paid under the Workman's Compensation Act or otherwise.
7. That the contractor warrants that in performance of its obligations under this contract, it shall comply fully with the relevant laws of Pakistan.
8. The workmen employed by the contractor who perform the work specified in this contract shall be the employee of contractor and the contractor shall not at any time attempt to represent such workmen as employees of the Company.
9. The Contractor shall clear away all rubbish from the site after completion of the work.
10. The Contractor shall complete the above mentioned work within **30 DAYS** of the written order to commence work subject to availability of material (in case of Non-availability of material. The concern Executing Department Incharge shall notify in writing to the contractor. The Contractor shall be liable to pay the Company liquidated damages at the rate of 0.5% of the Estimated Total Cost of the work per day late in completion up to maximum of (10%) ten percent only. This payment shall be at the Company's Engineer / Manager the work has been delayed for valid reasons.
11. After Acceptance of LOI, work Contract will executed with the Contractor on the Non-Judicial Stamp Paper at the rate of 0.35% of the Contract Value and must be signed by the Concerned holding the required Authority.
12. In case of dispute the decision of the Company's Engineer / Manager shall be the final and binding.
13. **Termination of Contract:** The Company may decide to terminate the Contract in case of Following situations i.e. Termination for default, insolvency & Convenience:
The Company may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by written Notice of default sent to the Contractor, terminate the Contract in whole or in part.
 - (a) If the contractor fails to complete the contracted Works / Services within the time period(s) specified to the Contract or any extension thereof granted by the Company.
 - (b) If Contractor fails to perform any other obligations(s) under the contract.
 - (c) If the Company during the completion period of the Contract has reason to believe that the Contractor will not be able to fulfill the obligations under the Contract.

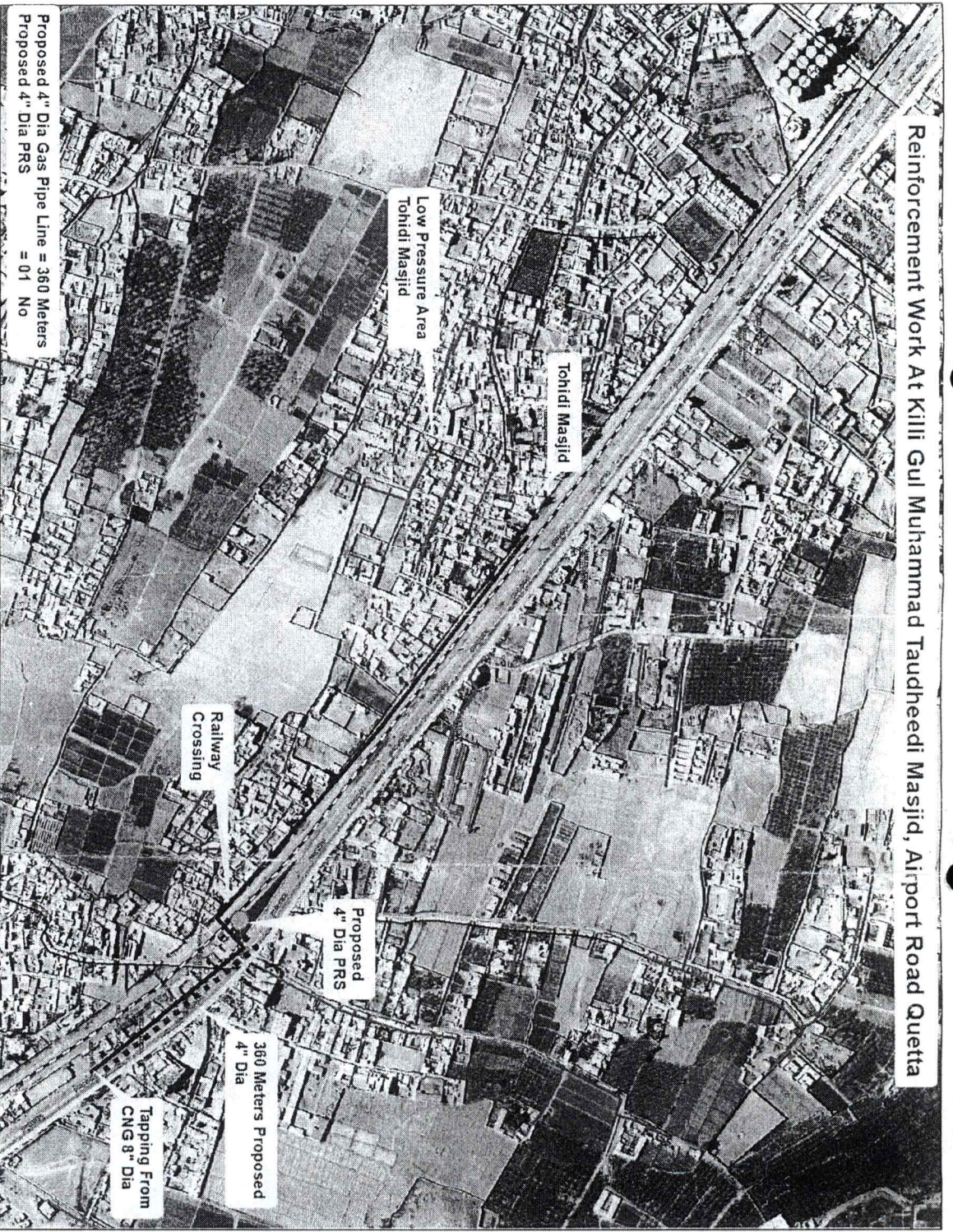
Bid Validity: Ninety (90) Days

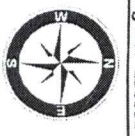
