## 12" dia. line swept away by floods in Balochistan restored

Gas supplies got discontinued due to massive destruction of SSGC's gas infrastructure after heavy flood water swept away SSGC's two main pipelines of 12" dia. and 24" dia. in Bolan River at Bibi Nani.

SSGC's technical teams were highly appreciated by Prime Minister of Pakistan Mian Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif who announced a prize money of Rs. 1 million as an acknowledgement of their outstanding performance.





# SSGC reaches out to the flood affectees



Recent heavy torrential rains swept away one third of the country, displacing millions of Pakistanis and causing a heavy death toll. SSGC instinctively rose to the gravity of the situation and implemented a strategy to provide relief to the affectees in its franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan.

In the first activity of its kind, four trucks carrying 350 packs of ration left from SSGC Head Office in Karachi on September 22, 2022 to Dera Allah Yar in Jafferabad and Naseerabad in Balochistan. The trucks were seen off by Imran Maniar, MD, SSGC. He was also accompanied by Amin Rajput, CFO, Asad Saeed Khan, SGM-HR and others. The logistics for the shipment of the relief goods were arranged by the Admin. Services Department. SSGC team distributed the goods to the flood victims in the presence of DC Naseerabad.

Later on, the second batch of goods also left from the Head Office this time to the cities in Sindh including Dadu, Johi, K.N. Shah and Mehar to provide relief goods to the affectees.





# MD SSGC inaugurates new pipeline to resolve pressure issues in old Karachi areas



Imran Maniar, MD, SSGC inaugurated a new gas pipeline that has been laid to augment the gas supplies and will largely address the low gas pressures issues being faced by the residents of Lyari, Garden and old city areas. The new line was inaugurated on *September 29, 2022*.

The newly inaugurated 12-inch diameter gas pipeline spans over 5-kilometers that starts from Mazaar-e-Quaid and concludes at Dhobi Ghaat, costed around Rs. 150 million.

At this occasion, the members of Distribution Department led by Dy. General Manager (Distribution Karachi Central) Abdul Rasheed Laghari were also present in large numbers who gave a comprehensive briefing to the Managing Director about this project.



## Operation undertaken against unregistered domestic customers in Surjani Town as mob turns unruly



SSGC's Gas Theft Intelligence Wing carried out a major raid in Surjani Town, Karachi.

Residents had reconnected the line that they had disconnected a few days ago during a raid and created a law and order situation. An elaborate operation was planned and reinforced by SSGC Police and local police. Illegal line was disconnected and around 150 meters of the Company's gas pipes were also recovered.

When the residents created a law and order situation by pelting stones at the raiding teams, the SSGC Police resorted to aerial firing to disperse the mob. FIRs were lodged against the culprits and investigation was summarily launched to apprehend them.

incorporated**

**SSGC Alternate Energy (Pvt.) Limited**, a fully owned subsidiary Company of SSGC has been incorporated as a Private Limited Company, under the Companies Act 2017.

The business model of SSGC Alternate Energy will mainly revolve around the alternate energy projects such as renewable or environmental friendly fuel like Biogas / Biomethane, electricity generation from thermal energy, futuristic energy projects like coal to gas production and hydrogen production.

Furthermore, the Company has plans to deal in waste water treatment and transportation and other energy projects as the subsidiary deems appropriate.



## SSGC participates in an international conference on pipeline corrosion

SSGC participated in the 3rd AMPP Pakistan Chapter International Corrosion Conference held in a local hotel in Karachi on September 27, 2022. The Company's Corrosion Control Department had set up a booth at the Conference venue. The event provided an opportunity to the Corrosion Control Department, led by its GM Anwer Ahsan Khan to network with the delegates belonging to the energy sector and particularly corrosion control specialists.

**The Conference was organized to foster collaboration in corrosion management community between industries, government and academia.**



**The Corrosion Control Department has 617 CP Stations, with Transmission network having 141 and Distribution stations having 476 stations. Coating systems, galvanic cathodic protection and impressed Current Cathodic Protection (CCP) are three most common corrosion control techniques being applied by the Department.**





# SSGC facilitates Koohi Goth Hospital in developing a new wing of Medical Ward



Under its Corporate Social Responsibility program, SSGC covered entire expenses of building and equipping three furnished rooms (2 bedded each, total 6 beds) in the newly constructed wing of Koohi Goth Hospital.

SSGC under its CSR program collaborated with a leading not-for-profit organisation, Association of Physically Handicapped Adults (APHA). The gas utility provided 5 tri-cycles motor bikes loaded with TUC shops to the Person With Disabilities (PWDs) for them to earn their livelihoods with dignity and without becoming dependent on anyone.

In this regards a simple yet impressive ceremony was held at APHA House in Karachi. As Chief Guest of the ceremony SSGC's Head of Corporate Communications and CSR, Mr. Salman Ahmed Siddiqui handed over the keys of these tricycle motor bikes to their owners. On this occasion Guest of Honour, Mrs. Mussarat Nasreen, Director Social Welfare, Govt. of Sindh, was also present whereas APHA was represented by its President Mr. Shareef Muzaffar, General Secretary Mr. Nishat and Vice Chief Patron Syed Khalid Husain, besides dozens of PWD members on wheelchairs.

While speaking on the occasion, Mr. Siddiqui congratulated all five PWDs for embarking on a new journey of self-dependency with pride. He said that SSGC besides its prime role as a gas transmission and distribution company has been vibrantly pursuing its CSR program for over two decades in collaboration with selfless organisations like APHA.

In their speeches, APHA officials registered their gratitude to SSGC for supporting them in their endeavours to provide entrepreneurship to the PWDs, enabling them to live a life with dignity. Mrs. Mussarat appreciated SSGC for facilitating APHA and advised the benefitting PWDs to support at least one handicapped individual to become self-dependent, from the income they would be generating from their new business through these tricycle motor bikes.

APHA established in 1975 is the largest voluntary social welfare organization in Pakistan that is engaged in the welfare and rehabilitation of PWDs, especially physically handicapped. Affairs of the association are managed by a Managing Committee elected amongst the disabled members and remains unique as its being run and managed by handicapped themselves. APHA is endeavouring to eliminate problems and difficulties faced by PWDs in society on the basis of mutual understanding, respect and co-operation.







## NDF's Disability Centre in Nawabshah solarised

National Disability and Development Forum (NDF) a not-for-profit organisation, based in Nawabshah has been providing selfless and free of cost services mainly in the areas of Disability Rights, Health, Education and Gender Mainstreaming since 2014. NDF serves communities irrespective of their ethnic, social, religious or political belongings to meet the needs the rights of the most disadvantaged people.



Keeping in view the huge data of intellectual disabilities in Sindh, NDF established a Rehab Centre in Nawabshah. The centre provides regular services to more than 100 children with intellectual disabilities, such as life therapies including Physiotherapy, Psychotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, vocational / non formal education and independent living along with boarding facility.

Under its CSR initiatives, Sui Southern Gas Company gifted a complete Solar Plant with mounting structure, inverters, batteries and air conditioners for meeting the power requirements of NDF Rehabilitation Centre, Nawabshah.

As chief guest of the ceremony, Mr. Salman A. Siddiqui, Head of Corporate Communications and CSR SSGC inaugurated the operations of this solar plant by switching ON the button. Dy. Manager CSR Mr. Sadaf Abbas accompanied him on this occasion.

## SSGC gifts a computer lab to hearing impaired students of DEWA



In its quest to promote vocational education amongst the hearing-impaired children, under its CSR program, SSGC partnered with a leading not-for-profit organisation DEWA to set up a state-of-the-art Computer Laboratory in its main campus in Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi.

On behalf of Sui Southern Gas Company, Head of Corporate Communications and CSR Mr. Salman A. Siddiqui inaugurated this Computer Laboratory. It was heartening to see the hearing-impaired students passing out as the first batch from this lab, had some impressive projects to their credit after completing a six months rigorous learning program.

SSGC's team mingled up with these children and talked to them in sign language through the help of interpreters. The excitement on completion of this skill-based course was evident on their happy faces. Later on, certificates were awarded to each one of them with special recognition certificates for their teachers who worked hard on them. Present on the occasion were Head of DEWA Mr. Rizwan Lodhi, the School Principal and members of Board of Directors along with other team members of DEWA.

DEWA is a charitable institute, imparting free education or on minimal fees to students, once they are approved by

DEWA's Sharia Board for Zakat or Donation fund that believes that the only way the children with special needs can be transformed into self-reliant individuals is by being nurtured in an environment of utmost love and care, as they are innocent and lovely souls.

In 1965 DEWA came into existence as a small academy for hearing impaired in Karachi that later turned into DEWA School for hearing impaired that further developed into a Junior Degree College, affiliated with Higher Secondary Board and Karachi University in 1999. They are now on the verge of becoming a State-of-the-art University for Inclusive Education, as their case is under consideration of Sindh Assembly. DEWA Institute in Islamabad, set up in 2013 has become first Institute in Federal Capital to award a degree in Inclusive Education.

## TBS Assemblies installed for optimizing pressure

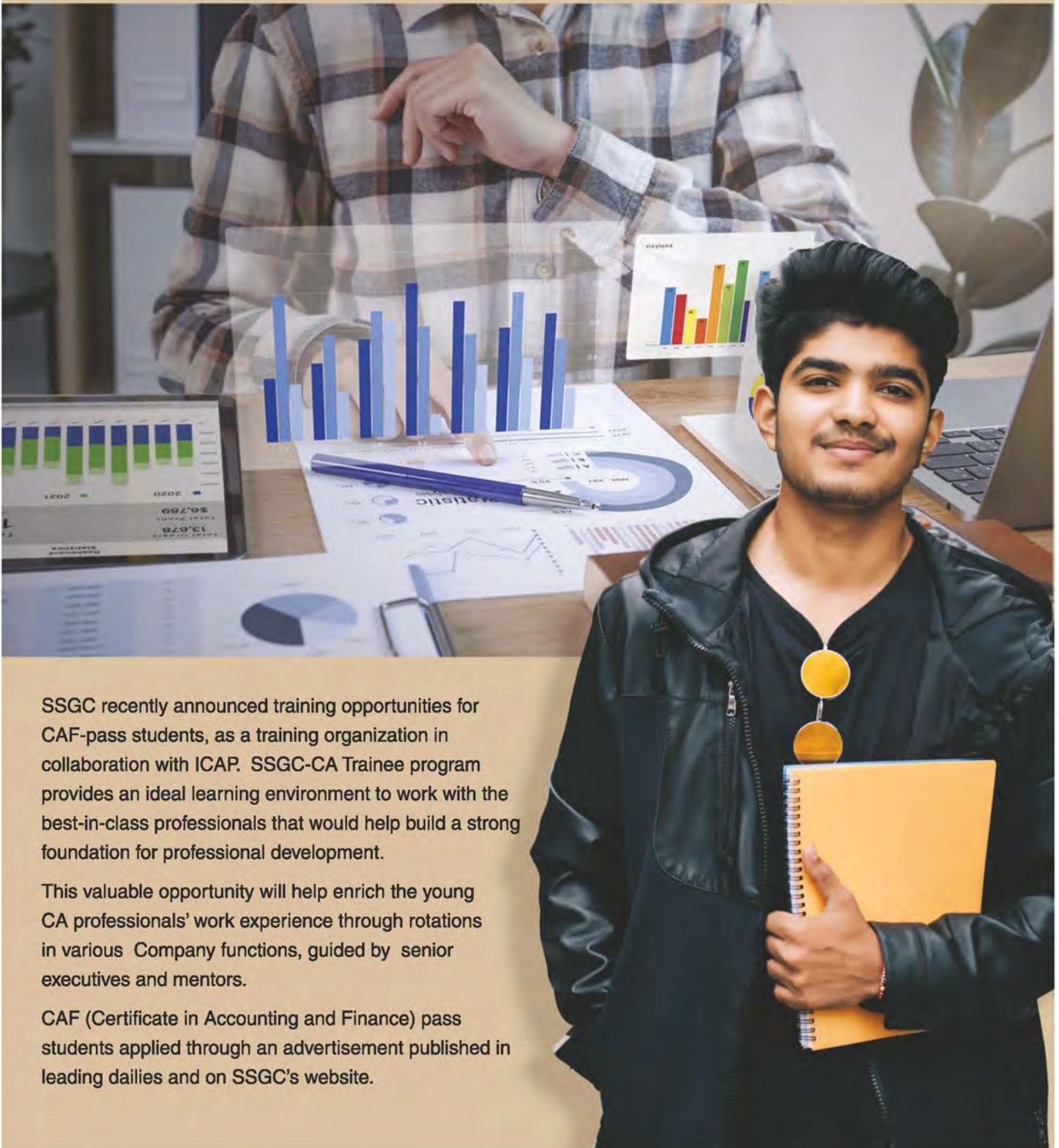

Early detection includes doing monthly breast self-exams, and scheduling regular clinical breast exams and mammograms, the learned doctors stressed.

Exercise offers so many health benefits, it's nothing short of a magic bullet. Something as simple as a brisk walk for half an hour a day dramatically reduces the risk of heart disease, diabetes, and several forms of cancer, including colon cancer, one of the leading killers.

"A lifetime of regular exercise improves brain function, allows people to be active and independent in their later years, and adds years to life," says Steven Blair, PhD, professor of exercise science at the University of South Carolina, who has helped shape federal exercise guidelines. "That addresses most of the leading chronic health threats we face."

A 2008 study by researchers at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston showed that regular exercise lowered the risk of dying prematurely by 30%.

### 2. LOSING WEIGHT



Losing weight and keeping it off is difficult. Yet studies show that losing weight just a few pounds if you're overweight will improve your health. If your weight is normal, work to keep it there by reining in calories and exercising frequently. A healthy diet includes abundant fruits, vegetables, and whole grains. A good diet limits refined sugars and saturated fats. One easy way to shed calories from your diet: drink water instead of sugary beverages. They account for more and more calories in the American diet.

### 3. GET SCREENED AND GET YOUR SHOTS



Routine health screens are also lifesavers. Knowing and managing your cholesterol levels and blood pressure is crucial to reducing your risk of heart disease. Cancer screening tests have been shown to catch some forms of the disease early enough to eliminate them.

### 4. DON'T SMOKE - QUITTING SAVES LIVES



A no-brainer. But lung cancer remains the leading cause of cancer death -- and between 80% and 90% of cases are directly caused by smoking, according to the National Cancer Institute.

### 5. FIND JOY FROM FAMILY AND FRIENDS



Enjoying life and maintaining a circle of supportive friends is a big part of good health. Indeed, having friendships may be second only to not smoking for preventing heart attacks. People with extensive social networks, according to research at the Uniformed Services University, are less likely to have calcification in their arteries, a sign of heart disease risk.

One way to increase your happiness is to foster cheerful friends. "Happiness turns out to spread through social networks," says James D. Fowler, PhD, an associate professor of political science at the University of California, San Diego.

# 'A new industrial age': The coming Renewable-Energy Boom

The world is at the “dawn of a new industrial age” of clean energy technology manufacturing that will triple in value by 2030 and create millions of jobs, according to the International Energy Agency (IEA).

The global market for key mass-manufactured technologies – including solar panels, wind turbines, electric vehicle batteries, heat pumps and electrolyzers for hydrogen – will be worth about \$650bn a year by the end of the decade, the IEA said in a report released recently.

The figure is more than three times larger than current levels but is conditional on countries fully implementing their energy and climate pledges.

Related jobs in clean energy manufacturing will more than double from six million to nearly 14 million by 2030, and “further rapid industrial and employment growth is expected in the following decades as transitions progress,” the agency said.

“The energy world is at the dawn of a new industrial age – the age of clean energy technology manufacturing,” it said. China has been dominating both the production and trade of “most clean energy technologies”, it added.

However, the Paris-based organisation warned the concentration of resource extraction and manufacturing posed risks to supply chains. Three countries account for 70 percent of the manufacturing capacity for solar, wind, battery, electrolyser and heat pump technology, with China “dominant in all of them”.

Democratic Republic of the Congo produces more than 70 percent of the world's cobalt, and three countries – Australia, Chile and China – account for more than 90 percent of the global production of lithium – a key resource for electric vehicle batteries.

# Hydrogen Patents

## for a clean energy future



A successful transition to a clean energy future will be supported by rapid changes in the global economy and in people's patterns of energy consumption, all of which have the potential to sustain healthier societies, more equitable outcomes and a more resilient planet. Technology will be at the heart of many of these changes, and nowhere more so than in the scale-up of hydrogen as a clean energy carrier.

While strong policy will be needed to make low-emission hydrogen cost-competitive, it will not be possible without technology improvements across a value chain that touches nearly every part of the energy system. Innovators around the world are ramping up their efforts in areas as diverse as fossil fuel conversion, electrochemical splitting of water, graphene tanks, cryogenic storage, fuel cell motors for aircraft and the reduction of iron ore. If hydrogen is to play a major role in reducing fossil fuel emissions, its future depends on uniting a wide range of advances

in different types of hardware and creating new markets for them.

Compared with digital technologies such as software, hardware generally takes more time to develop and involves greater investment risk during the prototyping and market entry phases. Through patenting, inventors seek to ensure that they can recoup these investments in innovation.

Coordinating the deployment of the full hydrogen energy value chain is perhaps the most complex of all the technical challenges facing energy engineers and it is sometimes hard to discern the status of all the underpinning technology areas. Patents are strong indicators of innovation activity which can give very detailed insights into the state and direction of the science.

## Gas theft - Awareness symposium held at KASBIT



SSGC has intensified its efforts against the menace of gas theft through coordinated raids and prosecution as per the Gas (Theft Control and Recovery) Act 2016.

This was stated by Brigadier (R) Mohammad Abuzar, DG (Security Services and Counter Gas Theft Control Operations-CGTO) SSGC during an awareness session held at KASBIT Institute of Technology. The session was an initiative of the gas utility which is aimed at bringing to fore natural gas-related issues directly to its customers through discussion and dialogue.

In his presentation, DG (SS and CGTO) reiterated that since the inception of the Company's CGTO Department in 2017, the Company has been constantly creating deterrence against gas theft, a major factor behind Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG) or line losses. SSGC is doing so by effectively using the Operational, Prosecution, and Intelligence wings of the Counter Gas Theft Operations Department by conducting regular raids against domestic, commercial, and industrial customers and then prosecuting the miscreants in accordance with the Gas Act 2016.

The head of CGTO said that since the inception of his department, claims worth Rs. 3 billion have been raised against gas theft offenders and an amount worth Rs. 2.5 billion have been recovered, with more than 100 persons convicted by the Gas Utility Courts especially set up for the purpose of prosecuting the wrongdoers.

DG (SS and CGTO) also said that the Company also has a zero-tolerance against industrial and domestic customers who use gas compressors at the expense of other customers in the vicinity, an act which is illegal, dangerous, and unethical.

Earlier, in their speeches, SSGC's Corporate Communications Head Salman A. Siddiqui and Chief Manager Syed Imran Ahmed dilated on the reasons behind the widening demand and supply of natural gas and the need for a concerted effort by both the Company and its customers to resolve to issue. In his remarks, Dr. Kashif Mehmood, Director, KASBIT acknowledged SSGC's efforts to control the scourge of gas theft and lauded the Company to create awareness about gas-related issues.



## Newly pre-qualified Advertising agencies welcomed on board
