Check your Gas Lines for Leakages.

Regular check-ups minimise the dangers of gas leaks and help manage your gas bill. The following are 2 simple ways you can check for leakages in your home:

Home Appliances Test Shut off all home gas appliances at night and note the meter reading.

Next morning read the meter again before switching on any appliances. A change in figures would determine the leakage.

Soap Test: Make a solution of soap and water and apply to all gas pipes in your premises. In case of leakage the soap solution will produce bubbles at point of leakage.

Caution: Do not check by using matches as this can be highly dangerous!

To report leakages, call the SSGC helpline at 1199.

Editor's Note

We are delighted to share the excitement of being back at a time when SSGC has made a turnaround and is now on a recovery path. After registering positive numbers in FY 2022-23 compared with previous reporting years, the Company has been rising on an upward trajectory. SSGC reported a net profit of Rs. 8 billion for nine months ending March 31, 2024. Significantly, EPS improved to Rs. 8.88 from a loss of Rs. 19.10 last year.

The year has clearly got off to an impressive start. The challenge for all stakeholders will be to ensure that the momentum is maintained, and even increased. The teams that have worked with a laser-focused approach on reducing UFG remain firmly committed towards bringing down line losses even further. Rehabilitation projects across the franchise areas are in full flow with the objective to control UFG, and at the same time to increase gas pressures for our customers.

In January 2025, ASGM (SBU)-Sindh and Balochistan, Abdul Waheed Jumani bid farewell to the Company after an illustrious career that spanned nearly 35 years. SSGC management acknowledged Mr. Jumani's contribution towards the Company's progress and spoke highly about his commitment to tasks. Veterans like Quetta's Mohammad Altaf and Sales' Malik Javaid Hamoka also reached superannuation. They will sorely be missed indeed.

SSGC reported Rs. 8 billion profit for 9 months, reversing Rs. 17 billion loss

SSGC reported a net profit of Rs. 8 billion for the nine months ending March 31, 2024, reversing last year’s Rs. 17 billion loss. The turnaround is driven by a 63.8% surge in revenue, reduced operating expenses, and a 74% increase in other income.

Despite a 76.7% rise in finance costs, profit before tax stood at Rs. 12 billion. Earnings per share (EPS) improved to Rs. 8.88 from a loss of Rs. 19.1 last year. This marks a strong financial rebound for SSGC.



SSGC remained committed towards providing gas during Ramazan

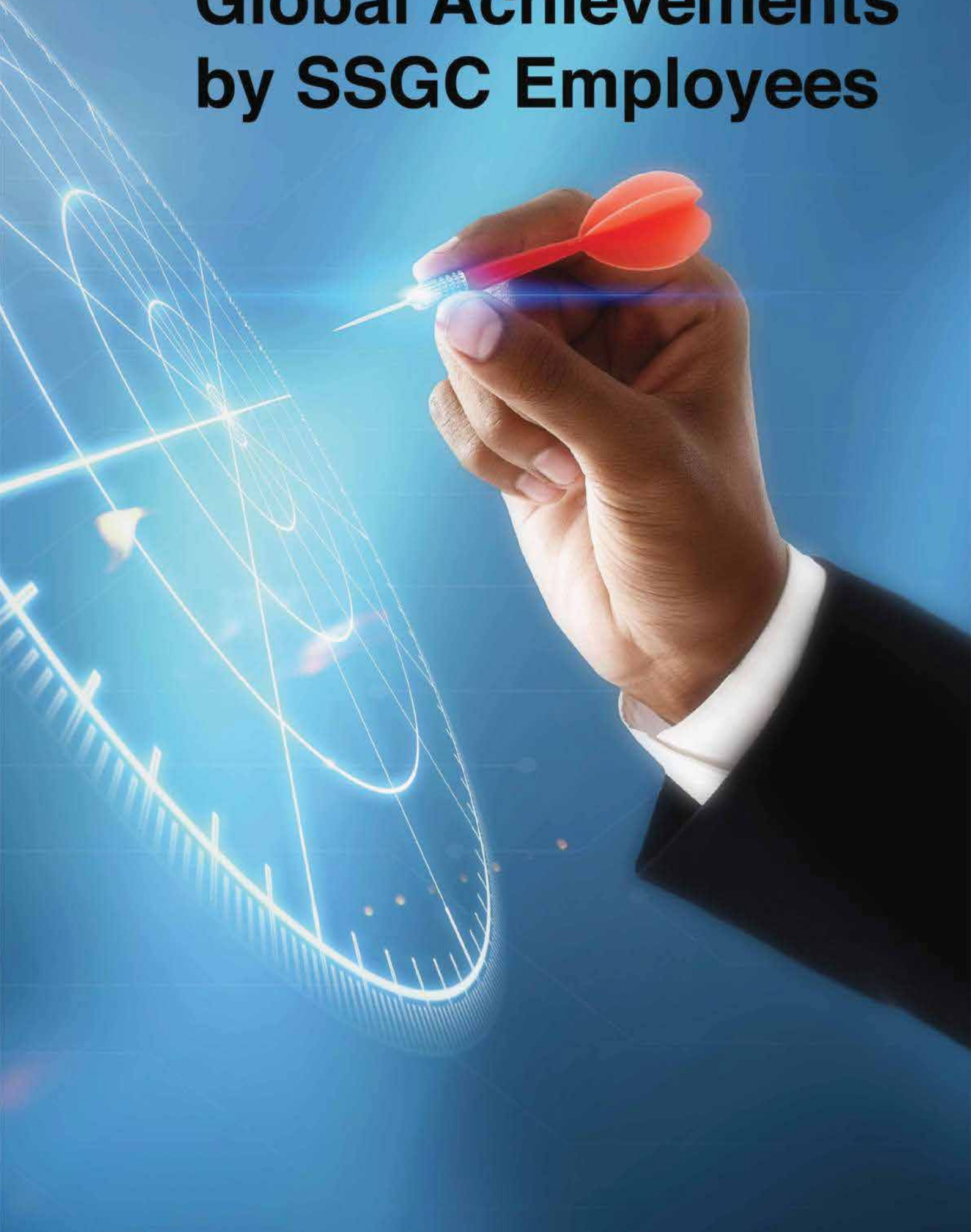
During the month of Ramazan, SSGC remained committed towards ensuring uninterrupted gas supply in its franchise areas. The Company followed the directives of the Prime Minister of Pakistan with regards to ensuring provision of gas for preparation of Sehri and Iftar.

Subsequently Amin Rajput, AMD SSGC, held several meetings with the top management and management members were deputed to personally visit locations onsite to ensure implementation of PM directives.

SSGC took following listed immediate actions to ensure steady gas supply during Ramazan, for compliance with PM directives:

- Increasing gas pressure by average 10% through SMSs to improve gas flow.
- Opening gas distribution centers 30-45 minutes before pre-mentioned Sehr and Iftar timings to improve system pressure, specially in areas located at the tail end of the distribution system.
- Arranging an additional 20 MMCFD gas from GOP to enhance transmission line pack to meet rising demand.
- Establishing control rooms at head office and regional offices to monitor gas supply and network status on a daily basis.
- Resolving low gas pressure complaints on an emergency basis at regional levels and submitting daily reports to senior management.

Ali, Rabia create history by winning gold for Pakistan at Asian Road and Para Cycling 2025



Pakistan and SSGC's star cyclist Ali Ilyas Jawaidd recently secured a historic gold medal in the 21.4 kms Individual Time Trial at the Asian Road and Para Cycling Championship 2025 held in Thailand. Veteran rider Rabia Garib also showed her prowess by securing a gold medal in the Championship

Ali Ilyas clinched 1st place with an impressive time of 26:30.56, averaging a speed of 48.41 kms/hr. Silver and bronze medals in the category were won by Thailand's Narongdat Sangchai and Thurakit Boonratanathanakorn. Both SSGC and Pakistan Cycling Federation managements felicitated Ali Ilyas on this grand win.

Ali Ilyas breaks his own record: Team SSGC outshines rivals to win National Track Cycling Championship

SSGC's Pro Cycling team recently dominated the 69th National Track Cycling Championship 2024 by surpassing its competitors in all the categories.

Star rider Ali Ilyas wrapped up an excellent year on wheels by breaking his own national track record in the 40-km Men's Individual Pursuit category. Veteran rider Rabia Garib won gold in the female category.

In male and female Individual Team Trial events, Aqib Shah and Rajia Shabbir too earned gold medals. SSGC outshined rival teams to also add Men and Women Team Sprint titles to its repertoire.

The 3-day event was staged in Lahore Velodrome by Pakistan Cycling Federation.



Traumatised yet resilient - SSGC's engineers back home after a successful LEA operation



For SSGC's Abdul Qayyum and Zahid Abro March 5, 2025 started in a normal fashion. Never in their wildest dreams, would they have imagined the kind of ordeal that they would have to confront for the next seven to eight days. The two officers work in the Corrosion Control Department, with Zahid being the supervisor and Abdul Qayyum, the Trainee Engineer. Both the Shikarpur-based engineers are highly agreeable gentlemen, committed and honest towards their job. Accompanied by their guard, head constable Asghar, the two engineers were on the way for a pipeline inspection job when they were ambushed by a gang of dacoits when their van got stuck in a muddy patch in Thull, Jacobabad and taken to an undisclosed location.

Dacoits and bandits based in these so-called kaacha areas have for long unleashed a reign of terror on the residents of Thull in Jacobabad and District Kashmore-Kandhkot, having been involved in blatant kidnapping, extortion and even murder. The news of the abduction of SSGC engineers with the head constable was obviously nothing short of shocking and traumatic not just for their families but for also their colleagues, SSGC's management and the Company's Security Department. The first task obviously was to ensure safe recovery of the kidnapped persons from the clutches of the ruthless dacoits.



SSGC's local Transmission Department and the Security team with full senior management support sprung into action, almost on an impulse. SSGC teams immediately touched base with all the security agencies including HQ 5 Corps Karachi, Pakistan Rangers, Sindh Police, SPs of Shikarpur, Jacobabad and Kashmore for ensuring the release of the kidnapped employees. A focal person was nominated to coordinate with the law enforcement agencies (LEAs). The Company's Transmission, HR and Security teams took the task of appeasing and assuring the families of the abductees about their safety, which they did admirably throughout the episode. Yet it was easier said than done as a virtual battle ensued between the dacoits and LEAs who were determined to uproot them in order to recover the engineers.

The LEAs soon found out what they were about to embark on by no means a simple recovery operation since the notorious Muchoo gang with a long track record of kidnapping and other heinous crimes was found involved in the kidnapping. The gang had their hide-outs spread all over the kaacha areas and to break their backs was clearly an arduous task. The gang members were notorious for their heavy handedness and merciless attitude. Hence a concrete plan had to be laid down, one to substantially weaken them and secondly to recover the abductees.

To recover the kidnapped personnel, a grand plan was launched to cripple the kidnappers' prolonged hold on the area and of course recover the hostages from their clutches. The execution plan involved setting up a field camp, conducting indiscriminate multiple raids on the hide-outs of the dacoits and patharidars and carry out constant drone surveillance of the dacoits' movement so as to close in on the target. The execution of the plan with the Sindh Police and local SPs on the forefront was by no means a child's play. Rather than employing a wait and watch policy, the police force went around demolishing the gang members hide-outs, killing dacoits in scuffles that ensued and apprehending their accomplices to get 'closer' to the gang of kidnappers to ensure the hostages' eventual recovery and safety. The accomplices too revealed during the investigation that the hostages were in the custody of the Muchoo gang which made the Sindh Police task relatively easier for tracking them down.

The dacoits, however, too were in no mood of beating a hasty retreat. The convoy of Kashmore police contingent at one point was also fired upon by the dacoits yet the police retaliated with drone strike. The decisive action was finally taken when drone surveillance helped to intercept the dacoits. The constant pressure imposed by the heavy police movement in the area eventually led to the dacoits retreating to their hide-outs which in turn helped the Police to target them to recover the abductees after a decisive encounter. Some of the Muchoo gang members were arrested during the successful swoop. While the LEAs were on ground executing their plan, the abductees were obviously going through a very traumatic and nerve wrecking experience. They were moved from one spot to another by the kidnappers and given very little food to eat. It is pertinent to appreciate the vital role IG Sindh Police Ghulam Nabi Memon and his team played in the eventual recovery by devising diverse resources to weaken the dacoits' hold. While the police operation was in full flow, IG Sindh Police met with AMD, SSGC Amin Rajput and assured him that the abducted Company employees would soon be recovered. Quite clearly, every word was backed by action.



After the episode, AMD SSGC and his senior management welcomed Zahid and Qayyum to the SSGC Head Office in Karachi and admired their



extraordinary resilience despite having gone through nearly eight days of constant trauma. The two engineers said that while they were not subjected to physical torture by the kidnappers yet the mental agony they went through would invariably get overwhelming. The AMD assured the engineers of every support and congratulated Sindh Police for its extraordinary recovery operation as well as concerned SSGC teams for constantly monitoring the developing situations and coordinating brilliantly with the LEAs throughout the episode.

SSGC Ramazan Ration Drive reaches out to the less-privileged in Balochistan

SSGC's Ramazan Ration Drive was successfully executed in Balochistan this Ramazan with a distribution of 2,000 ration boxes to the less-privileged population listed in the registered database of two reputed not-for-profit organizations Lasbela Welfare Trust (LWT) and Jam Mohammad Foundation (JMF). This ration drive was carried out for the second year in succession by SSGC on the special directives of Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan. SSGC's Corporate Communication Department managed the entire distribution process and coordination with the NGOs. CCD's DGM Salman A. Siddiqui was once again designated as SSGC's focal person to implement the drive in a timely fashion. in coordination with various stakeholders.

The Drive started with the distribution of boxes in Uthal in Lasbela district on March 26, 2025. 500 ration boxes were provided to the less-privileged population. SSGC's Zonal Manager Hub, Mr. Shoaib Hameed travelled from Hub to Uthal to distribute the ration boxes in a simple yet impressive ceremony organized by LWT at SMC Park.

The Drive entered its second phase on March 27th with a well-organized distribution of 750 ration boxes by JMF to the poor and deserving residents of Bela city in district Lasbela, Balochistan. JMF organized the ceremony at Degree College, Bela that was formally inaugurated with prayers by Chairman Municipal Corporation Bela, S. Shah Jehan Shah.

The 3rd phase continued with the distribution of 500 ration boxes to the poor and needy residents of Awaran, Balochistan in a ceremony organized by JMF on March 28. The 2025 Drive successfully ended in Bela, Balochistan on the 29th of March where JMF volunteers provided 250 ration boxes by going door-to-door in various rural and urban areas to facilitate those residents who did not wish to collect the ration in a public gathering.



Valiant effort: Gas pipeline damaged by sabotage act repaired in record time



Braving bitterly cold weather conditions, SSGC's technical teams completed repair work on the 18" dia. gas pipeline that was damaged in January 2025 at Quetta by-pass after a sabotage activity, well before the scheduled time.

The blast resulted in major part of Balochistan becoming deprived of gas. Gas was restored in the affected areas that include Kuchlaak, Bostaan, Yaroo, Karbala, Haran Zai and Pishin in Upper Balochistan and in areas of Quetta city including Airport Road, Nawa Killi, Jinnah Town, Khanu Zai, A-one city and Hazaar Ganji.

SSGC's management closely monitored this gas restoration process. This was yet another demonstration of SSGC teams rising in a crisis situation and delivering the goods.

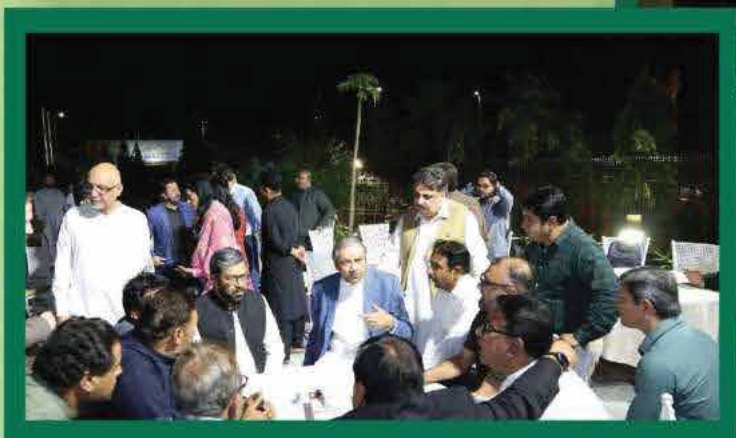

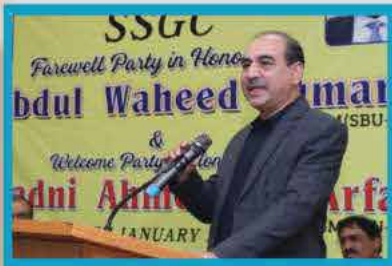
