SSGC holds its 71st AGM to approve audited financial statements for FY '24-25



The 71st Annual General Meeting (AGM) of SSGC was held at the Arena in Karachi on November 27, 2025. A large number of SSGC's shareholders attended the AGM.

The AGM was convened to consider the Audited Financial Statements of the Company for the year ended June 30, 2025, together with the Directors' and Auditors' Report.

Directors on the Board of SSGC, Amin Rajput, AMD, SSGC, and divisional and departmental heads participated in the meeting. Shareholders discussed many facets of the Report and the Company's financial and operational performance during the fiscal year with the Directors and the management. The minutes of the 70th AGM were unanimously approved by the shareholders.

SSGC held an Extraordinary General Meeting (EOGM) on December 23, 2025 in Karachi to elect its Board of Directors for a three-year term.

SSGC continues its ambitious gas rehabilitation program with a ground breaking ceremony for F. B. Area blocks



The ground-breaking for the second phase of the massive rehabilitation scheme that began in FY 24-25 was held for Karachi's thickly populated FB Area where approximately 52 kms of new PE network will be laid to facilitate around 13,500 customers.

The ground breaking ceremony, held on October 30, 2025 was performed by Amin Rajput, AMD, SSGC. Saeed Rizvi, DMD (Operations), Ghulam Moeen Butt, SGM (Technical Services) and Ghulam Ali Meher, GM (P&C) were also present on the occasion. It is pertinent to mention here that in FY '24-25, SSGC initiated a three-year rehabilitation

program to replace majority of its age old steel pipelines with Polyethylene (PE) pipes from FY '24-25 till FY '26-27, considering the leakages observed in the aging steel distribution network in Karachi region.

This rehabilitation drive will not only enhance the operational control of the distribution networks but will also improve the network integrity and consumer complaint in Karachi Region. It will also facilitate the tail-end consumer of the network through better pressure and minimum complaints.





During FY 2024–25, approximately 2,500 kms of the network was successfully rehabilitated, covering major areas such as North Nazimabad, North Karachi, Malir, and Garden schemes and its benefit to the company and customer would appear in terms of UFG savings and customer satisfaction from next year. Rehabilitation initiative that SSGC took in DHA area in 2023-24 has significantly enhanced gas pressure at the consumer end,

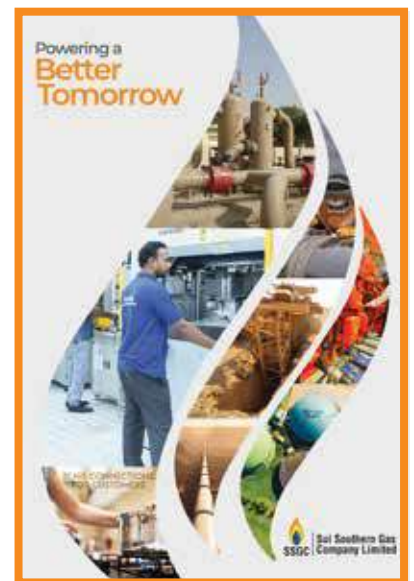
improved overall network integrity, and optimized gas losses as planned. Following the successful completion of first phase in FY 2024-25, SSGC has now launched the next phase for FY 2025–26, targeting the rehabilitation of another 2,500 kms of pipeline network across different areas comprising of majority are Gulshan-e-Iqbal, PECHS, Saddar and Orangi Town and few selected blocks / sectors of Korangi, Kemari and F. B. Area.



Annual Report 2024-25 published amidst impressive financial numbers

SSGC's Annual Report for FY 2024-25 was recently published featuring impressive financial numbers, with the Company returning to profitability after a hiatus of several years. The Report designed and published by the Company's Corporate Communication Department, was aptly entitled 'Powering a Better Tomorrow'.

The Corporate Communication Department took the lead in the compilation of departmental inputs and Directors' Report. On the other hand, Finance Department played a key role in compiling consolidated and unconsolidated accounts along with providing statistical information and general financial information. SSGC launched Winter Safety Campaign 2025 in Balochistan Region



SSGC launched its 2025-26 Winter Safety Awareness campaign through two different events held in Balochistan region that was attended by religious scholars and media representatives from the province in large numbers. The Fleet March was held at the Quetta Regional office, followed by the launch event which was held at the Serena Hotel.

At the launch event, keynote speaker, SSGC's Regional Head Raheel Malik, emphasized in his address that protecting human lives is a noble act. He advised the residents of colder regions in Balochistan to exercise caution while using gas-powered appliances. He further stated that numerous steps have been taken in utility management to minimize difficulties for consumers. Mr.

Malik assured attendees that the gas-related issues highlighted during the session would be addressed and appropriate recommendations will be submitted to the senior management.

Shahid Shaikh, Group General Manager Corporate Communication Department, welcomed the guests and expressed hope that this awareness event would contribute to saving precious lives. He also outlined the objectives of the launch, stressing that gas is a great blessing from God and requires careful handling to prevent accidents. He emphasized that the purpose of this important campaign is to raise awareness of safety precautions in gas usage, as negligence can lead to the tragic loss of life, specially while using gas-fired heaters.





Many notable Ulemas graced the occasion with their presence, out of which Maulana Anwar ul Haq Haqani, Pir Syed Habibullah Shah Chishti, Molana Hafiz Syed Samiullah Agha, Allama Hashim Ali Mosavi, Mufti Muhammad Naeem, and Reverend Pastor Simon Basheer stressed on the precautions that should be taken during winters, especially while using gas fired appliances.

They also assured to share the session's message in their Friday sermons and other addresses to raise public awareness of these critical safety measures. Representing

کی شکایات میں بھی کمی آئے گی۔ اس کے علاوہ نیٹ ورک کے آخری صارفین کو بہتر گیس پریشر کی فراہمی اور نوگیس کی شکایات کے خاتمے میں بھی مدد ملے گی۔

حادثات سے بچا جاسکے۔ ان کا کہنا تھا کہ اس اہم مہم کا مقصد گیس کے محفوظ استعمال سے متعلق احتیاطی تدابیر سے عوام کو آگاہ کرنا ہے کیونکہ غفلت قیمتی جانوں کے ضیاع کا سبب بن سکتی ہے۔

اس موقع پر مجموعی طور پر 14 علمائے کرام نے شرکت کی، جن میں مولانا انور الحق حقانی، پیر سید حبیب اللہ شاہ چشتی، مولانا حافظ سید سمیع اللہ آغا، علامہ ہاشم علی موسوی، مفتی محمد نعیم اور ریورنڈ پادری سائمن بشیر شامل تھے۔ مقررین نے بالخصوص سردیوں میں گیس سے چلنے والے آلات کے استعمال کے دوران احتیاطی تدابیر پر زور دیا اور اس عزم کا اظہار کیا کہ وہ جمعہ کے خطبات اور دیگر مواقع پر ان حفاظتی پیغامات کو عام کریں گے تاکہ عوام میں آگاہی پیدا کی جاسکے۔

میڈیا برادری کی نمائندگی کرتے ہوئے کوئٹہ پریس کلب کے صدر عرفان سعید اور بلوچستان یونین آف جرنلسٹس کے سینئر نائب صدر منظور بلوچ نے آگاہی مہم کی بھرپور حمایت کی یقین دہانی کرائی۔ انہوں نے بعض اہم مسائل کی نشاندہی بھی کی، جن میں سے کچھ کو کمپنی براہ راست حل کر سکتی ہے جبکہ بعض کے لیے حکومتی سطح پر اقدامات کی ضرورت ہے۔

تقریب کا اختتام پر تکلف عشاء سے ہوا۔ سوئی سدرن کے سرکاری ترجمان سلمان احمد صدیقی نے تقریب کے فرائض بطور نظامت انجام دیے۔

سوئی سدرن گیس کمپنی نے کوئٹہ ریجن میں 2025-26 کی ونٹر سیفٹی آگاہی مہم کا باقاعدہ آغاز کر دیا۔ اس سلسلے میں منعقدہ سیشن میں بلوچستان بھر سے بڑی تعداد میں مذہبی اسکالر اور میڈیا نمائندگان نے شرکت کی۔ مہم کا آغاز کوئٹہ ریجنل آفس سے فلیٹ مارچ کے ذریعے ہوا، جس کے بعد لائٹنگ تقریب سرین ہوٹل میں منعقد کی گئی۔

تقریب کے کلیدی مقرر، سوئی سدرن کے ریجنل ہیڈ راجیل ملک نے اپنے خطاب میں کہا کہ انسانی جانوں کا تحفظ ایک عظیم فریضہ ہے۔ انہوں نے بلوچستان کے سرد علاقوں کے رہائشیوں کو گیس سے چلنے والے آلات کے استعمال میں احتیاط برتنے کا مشورہ دیا۔ انہوں نے مزید بتایا کہ صارفین کو سہولت فراہم کرنے اور مشکلات کم کرنے کے لیے یوٹیلیٹی میجمنٹ کے حوالے سے متعدد اقدامات کیے گئے ہیں۔ راجیل ملک نے شرکاء کو یقین دلایا کہ اجلاس میں اجاگر کیے گئے گیس سے متعلق مسائل کو حل کیا جائے گا اور مناسب سفارشات اعلیٰ انتظامیہ کو پیش کی جائیں گی۔

گروپ جنرل مینیجر کارپوریٹ کمیونیکیشن ڈیپارٹمنٹ، شاہد شیخ نے مہمانوں کا خیر مقدم کرتے ہوئے امید ظاہر کی کہ یہ آگاہی مہم قیمتی انسانی جانوں کے تحفظ میں معاون ثابت ہوگی۔ انہوں نے تقریب کے مقاصد پر روشنی ڈالتے ہوئے کہا کہ گیس اللہ تعالیٰ کی ایک عظیم نعمت ہے جسے احتیاط سے استعمال کرنا نہایت ضروری ہے تاکہ
