# Former speaker Balochistan Assembly discusses LPG-Air Mix plants with SSGC management

In the light of the decision of Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) and directives from the Ministry for Petroleum and Natural Resources (MP&NR) regarding the installation of LPG-Air Mix / Synthetic Natural Gas (SNG) plants at 30 locations in the franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan, the former Speaker of Provincial Assembly of Balochistan, Mr. Matiullah Agha visited SSGC Head office on March 10, 2017, for discussion with SSGC's management.

Asim Tirmizi, Project Director (Liquefied Gases) briefed him about the basic operation of LPG-Air Mix plant and informed him regarding the proposed execution strategy for the installation of aforementioned LPG-Air Mix plants. He also

updated him regarding the current status of its implementation and progress made in this regard.

The former speaker asked the SSGC management to prioritize the LPG-Air Mix projects in the areas of Pashtun belt, upon which PD (LGs) requested for the former's support in the matters of Land Acquisition which is a major criteria for realization of SNG projects.

It must be mentioned here that SSGC opts for acquiring government land of minimum of 4 acres for its SNG plant and allied facilities in accordance with the requirements of applicable codes and standards. Mr. Tirmizi informed Mr. Agha that in the land acquisition process for the installation of LPG-Air Mix plants, local

administration including Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners and other representatives of local Revenue Departments i.e. Tapedars and Patwaris, etc. have to be engaged at various stages as per the Land Acquisition Act 1894. He requested Mr. Agha for his intervention in expediting work progress at these stages to which the latter responded positively.

Additionally, in the light of proposed execution strategy, the former speaker ensured his full cooperation for maximizing the availability of competent parties for operation of LPG-Air Mix plants on Built-Own-Operate (B.O.O.) basis. ●

# Kotri teams make inroads against gas theft



**S**SGC is waging a persistent battle to stem the rising trend of UFG or line losses. Recently, in Kotri, Sindh, a raid was undertaken by the concerned team led by Ayaz Jakhrani, ZM (Kotri) to clamp down on gas theft miscreants. Two

culprits who were involved in stealing gas directly from supply main were arrested by the local police.

It must be mentioned here that from July to November 2016, more than 615 households

of Kotri using gas illegally saw their connections dismantled. In volume terms, the raids led to saving of 56,000 mcf of gas that monetarily amounts to Rs. 30 million. **Q**

## GPR demo given to executives



In order to facilitate the location of buried gas pipes and detect off-shoots from gas mains, R&D Department conducted a two-day demonstration on Ground Penetrating Radar on March 27-28, 2017. The GPR was arranged by the University of Sindh and involved the services of Geo-Physicists from Oriental Engineers for giving a comprehensive demo, illustrating the strengths and capabilities of the apparatus. As a token of acknowledgment, five students from University of Sindh were also

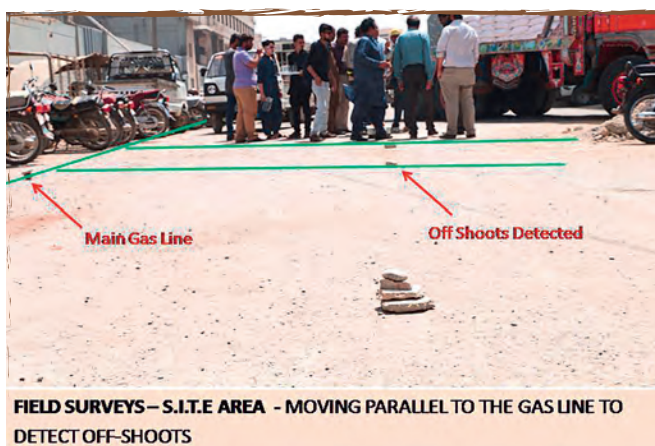
provided free training along with great hospitality from SSGC.

Ground-penetrating radar (GPR) is a geophysical method that uses radar pulses to image the sub-surface. GPR is a non destructive/evasive technique that has been used by geologists and geophysicists to study rock, soil, ice, fresh water, pavements and structures. With time, the technology has found its application in detection of buried utilities such as gas and water pipes mains. The GPR uses

high-frequency radio waves, usually in the range 10 MHz to 2.6 GHz to detect buried objects. A transmitter emits energy into the ground and when it encounters a buried object or a boundary between materials having different permittivity, energy is reflected back. A receiving antenna can then record the variations in the return signal. When moved perpendicular to a pipe, the indication of the pipe would be shown as a hyperbola. ▶







The demo was witnessed by executives from multiple departments with active participation from Distribution and S&M. Multiple scenarios were created in industrial areas including S.I.T.E Area, Binori Town and Korangi where the gas lines located with the help of GPR were verified by GIS drawings.

The GPR exactly pin-pointed the location of the gas lines with high accuracy. After the demo, a presentation detailing the theory and results was held in P&D Conference Room and was attended by senior

managers and executives from the Measurement, Distribution and Corporate Communications.

Efforts of Demo and Class room presentation were highly appreciated. It was concluded that GPR was:

- Suitable for locating both Metallic and Non-Metallic buried Pipes (PE Pipes)
- Beneficial for Tracing Un-Authorized buried tapings and off-shoots
- Useful in updating existing erroneous drawings and missing pipe networks on GIS with GPS coordinates

- Can be used to trace buried valve pits
- Soil can be analyzed for probable excavation in past to detect illegal connection and before laying of new pipeline network

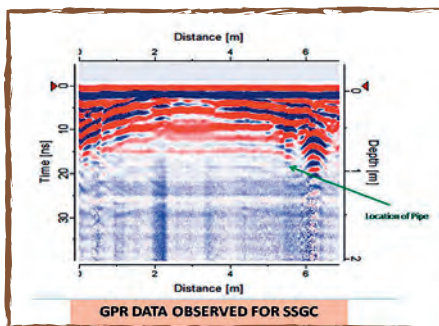
The overall demo was a success and the Company's senior management SSGC is looking towards investment in the procurement of GPR. ●

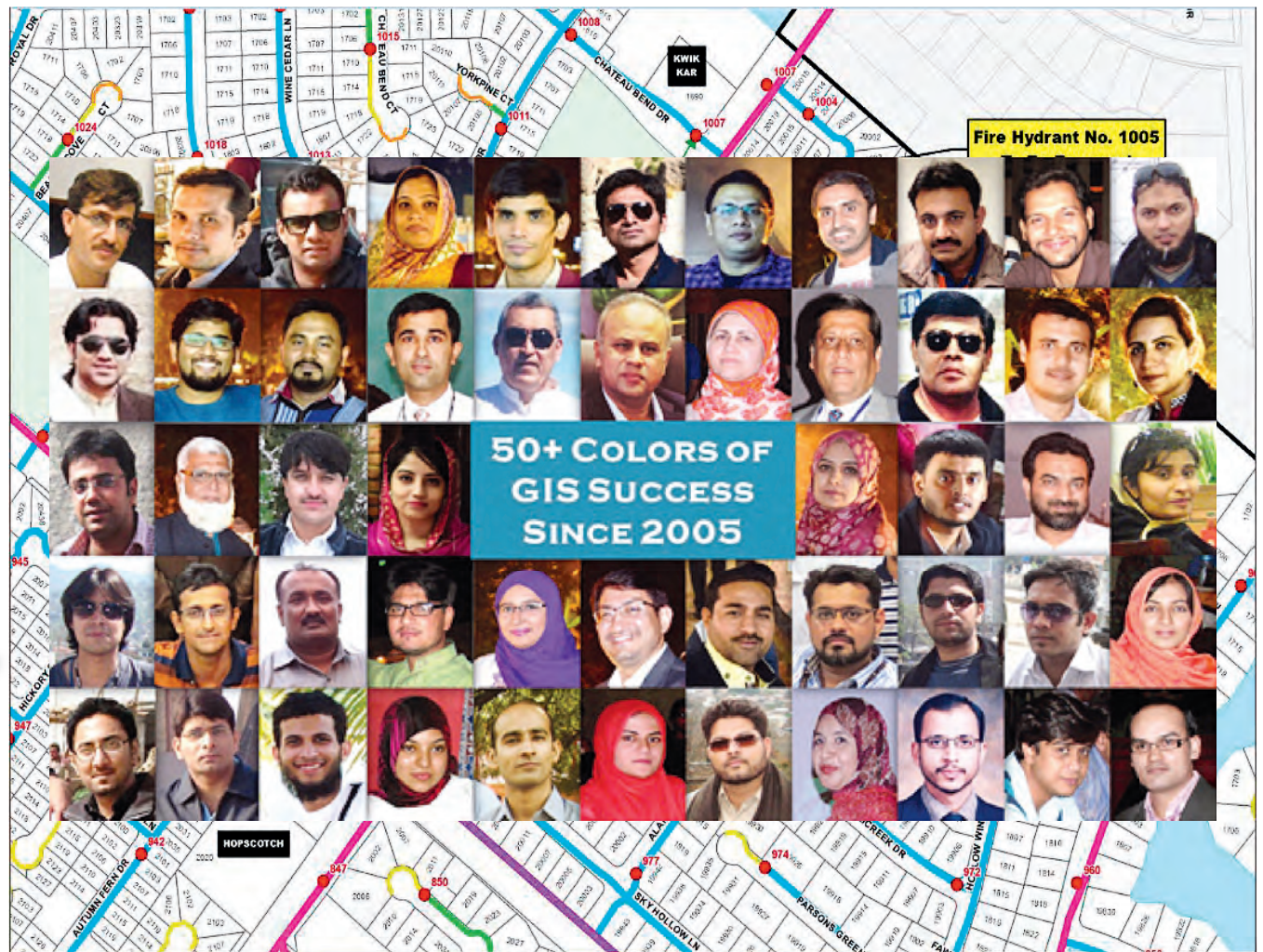

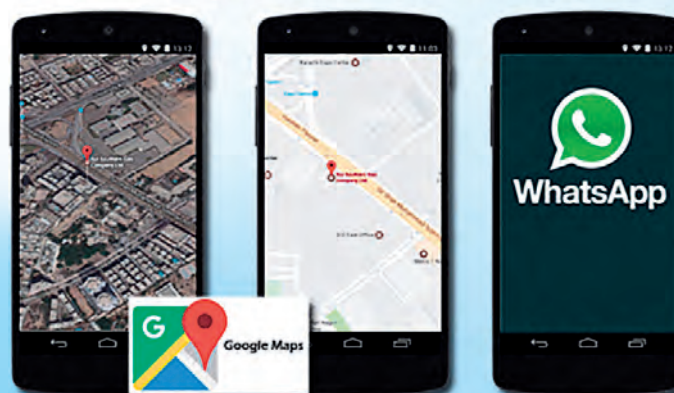






## Seven Easy Steps “Improved Emergency Response/Rescue”

5. Emergency callers get screenshot / GPS coordinates of smart phone / mobile.
6. Emergency callers share screenshot / GPS coordinates with emergency call center.
7. Emergency call centers transfer Google Map's location via WhatsApp to nearest emergency respondent.

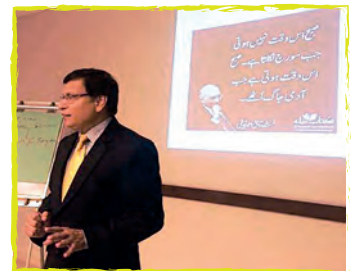
## Building a prolific team Learning and Development Centre holds workshop

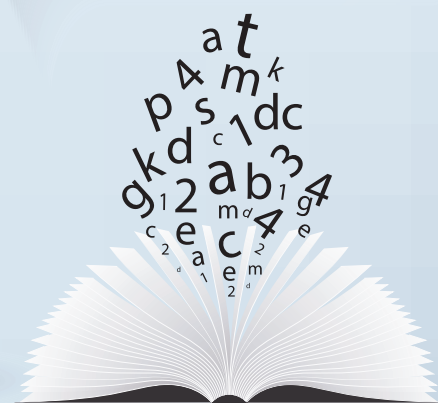

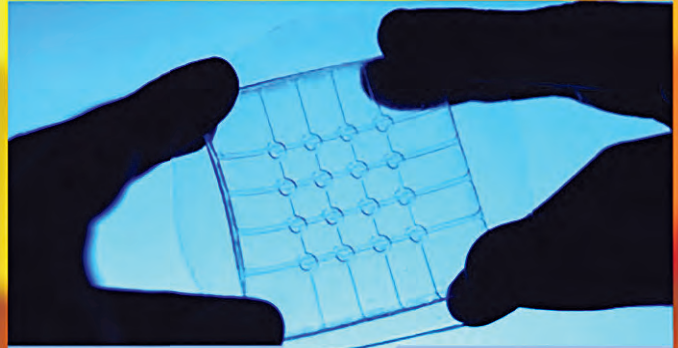

## Transparent Touchpad



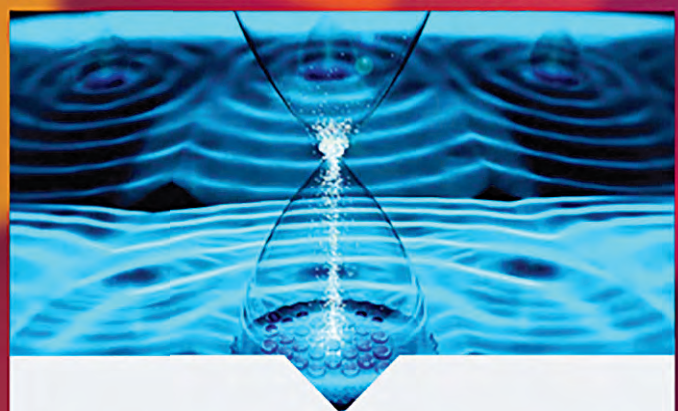
A new transparent, flexible touch-pad can sense the touch of a finger even when the material is stretched or bent, which could help engineers one day create advanced wearable touch screens.

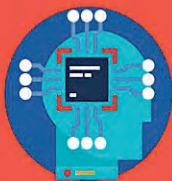

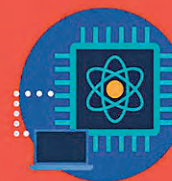

## IGU releases 2017 World LNG Report


The International Gas Union (IGU) recently released its 2017 World LNG Report, examining the current state of the Global LNG Industry. The latest report highlights the dynamic 2016 experienced by the global LNG industry - with significant growth in LNG supply projects, as well as increases in demand for LNG as a fuel from new and existing markets across the globe. Global LNG trade in 2016 reached a record 258 million tonnes (MT) - an increase of 5% from 2015, and the largest ever year for LNG trade. This dramatic increase is particularly noticeable when compared with the average 0.5% growth rate of the previous four years.

This jump can primarily be attributed to a significant increase in new supply, due

largely to the start of exports from the US Gulf of Mexico, as well as the start of commercial operations in Australia Pacific LNG, among others. These new projects come about as governments, businesses and consumers become increasingly aware of the advantages of natural gas in the global energy mix, and are encouraging trends pointing to further growth in the LNG market.

There were also significant increases in demand as LNG finds a role as a fuel of choice in new markets. The most pronounced increase in demand comes from Asian markets, with China's LNG consumption increasing dramatically by roughly 35% to 27 million tonnes per annum (MTPA). On the flip-side, some

markets - including Japan and South Korea as the two largest - have shown signs of satiation as other forms of energy come to the fore, in part showing the flexible value of LNG as a fuel source. This was particularly prevalent in Brazil, where a resurgence in hydro power has reduced demand for LNG by 80%.

In 2016 global liquefaction capacity reached 339.7 MTPA - building on the 2015 measurement of 301.5 MTPA and growing at a consistent rate. This growth includes new projects such as Sabine Pass LNG, as well as Gorgon LNG and Australia Pacific LNG. 

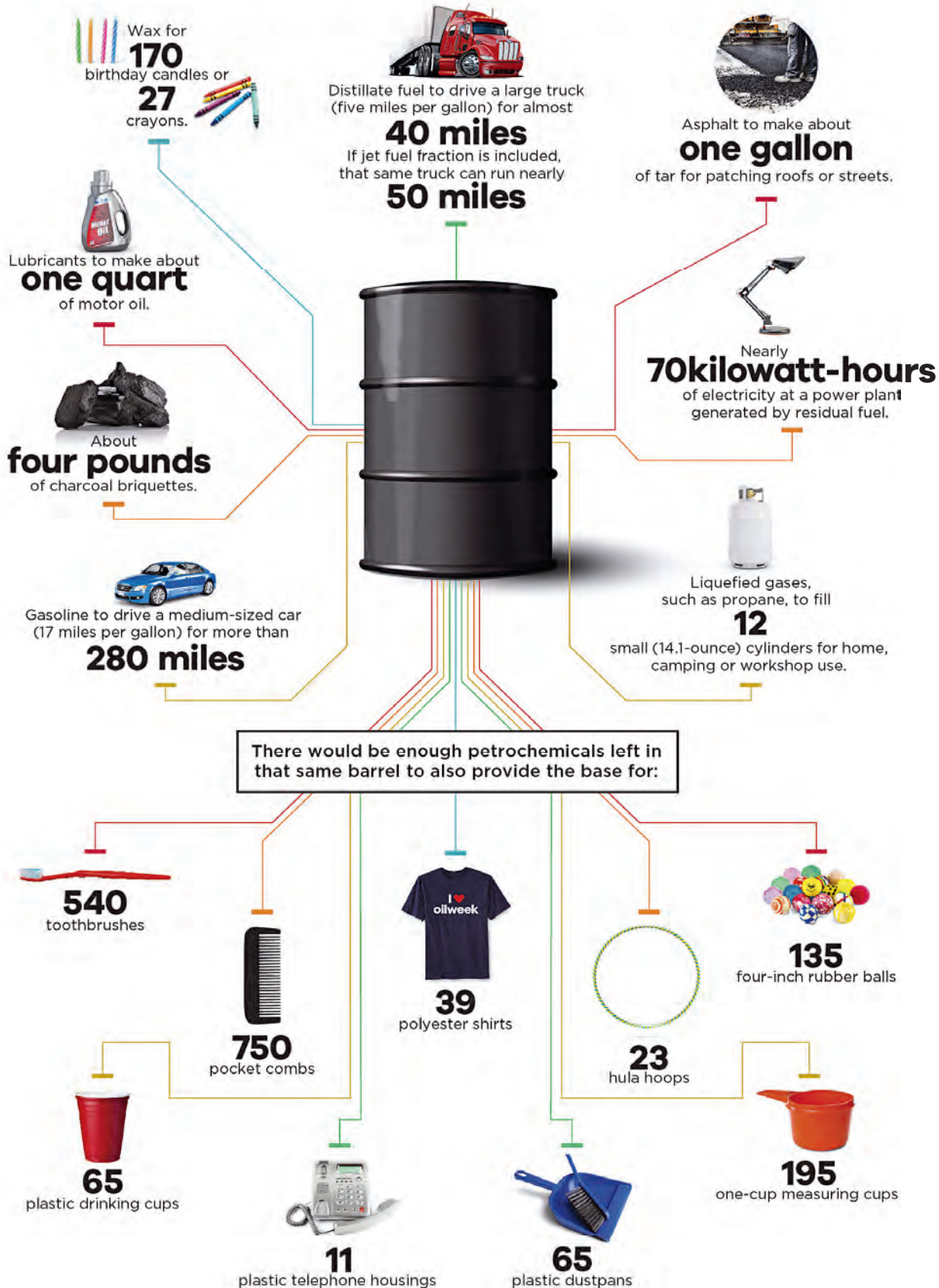

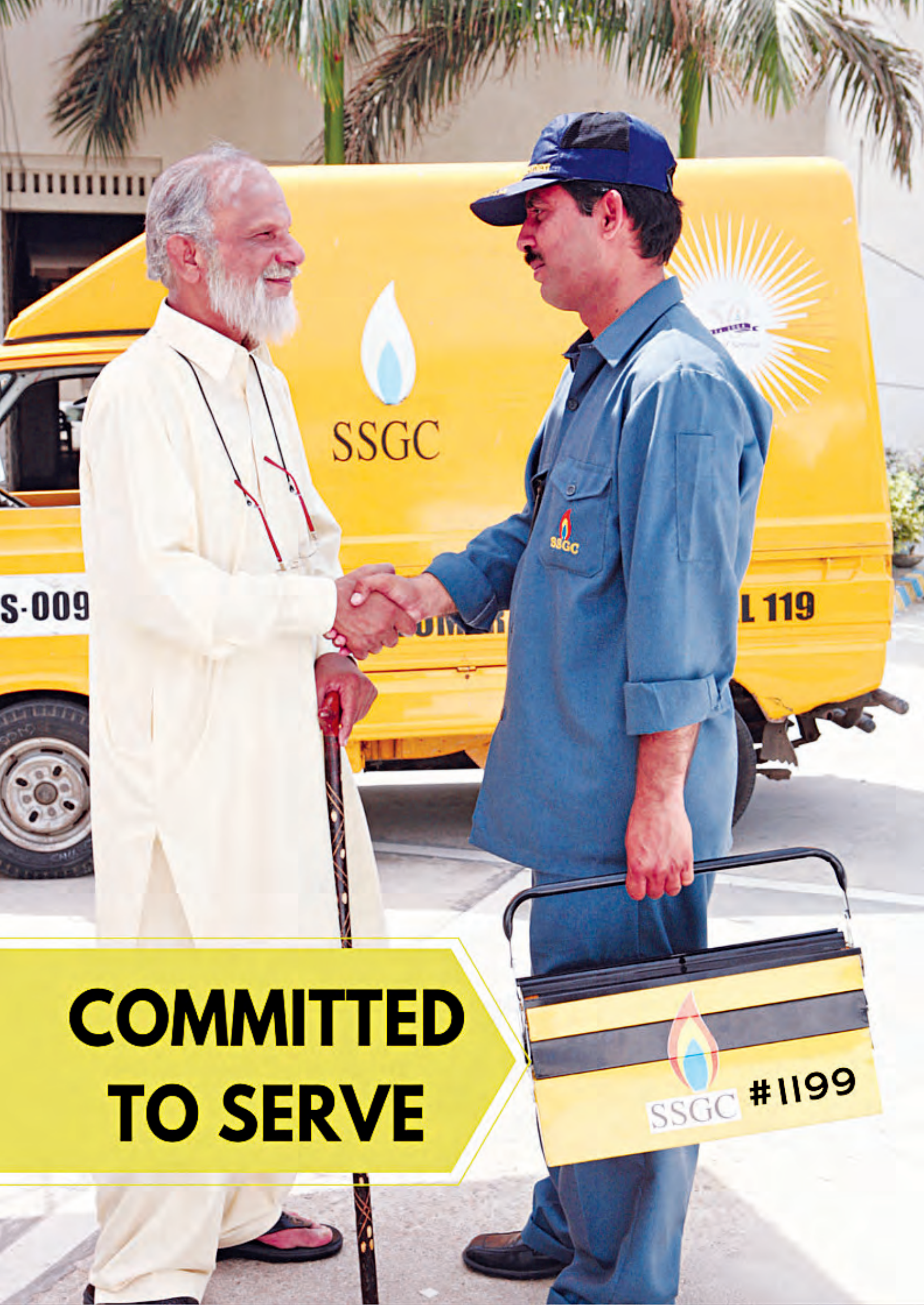
# What can you make from one barrel of oil?

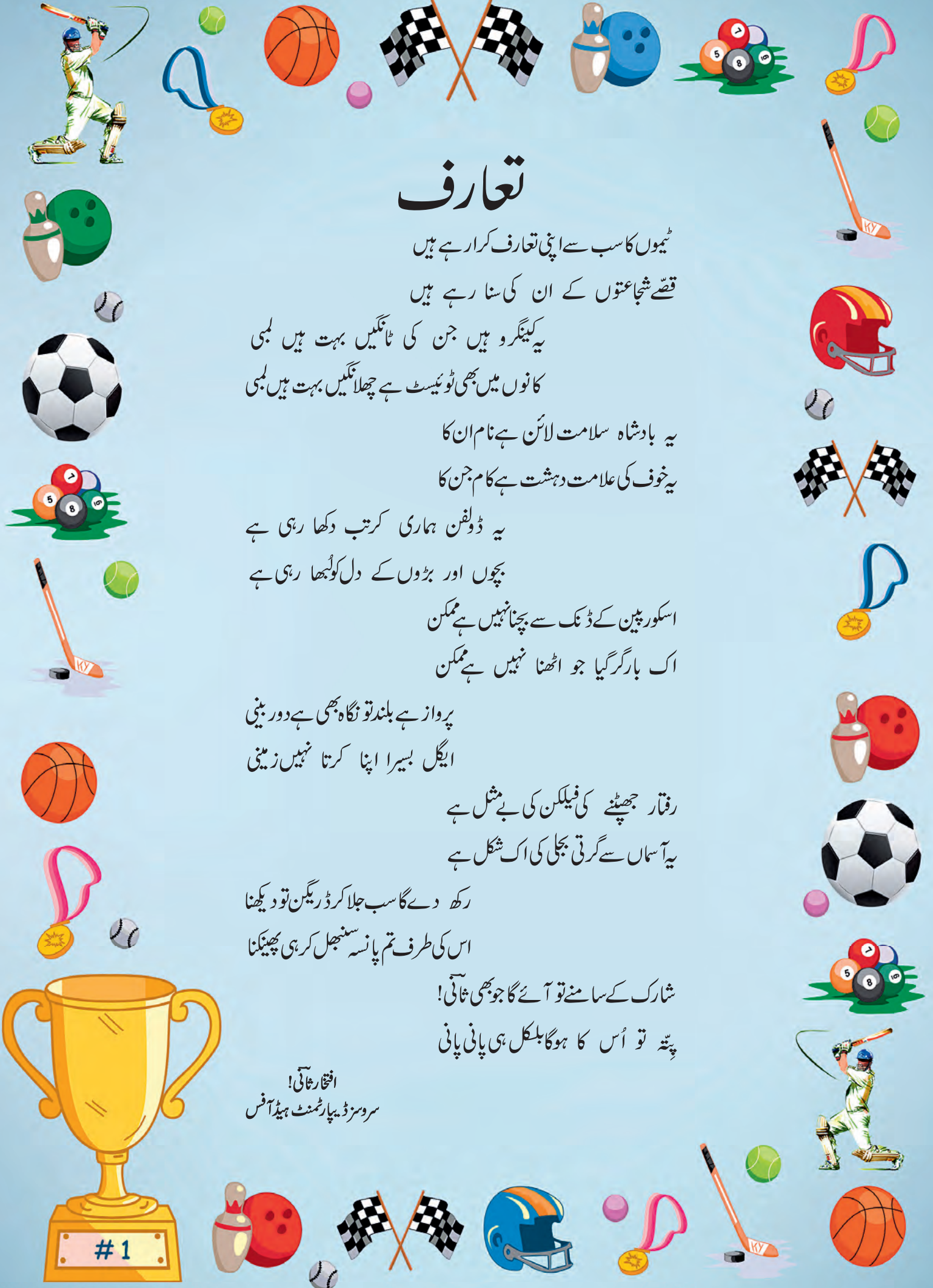
