THE PRIME MINISTER SAID THAT THE GOVERNMENT WAS WORKING ON WAYS TO PRODUCE ELECTRICITY THROUGH DIFFERENT OPTIONS. HE ADDED THAT THREE MORE POWER STATIONS THAT RUN ON LNG WOULD SOON BE OPERATIONAL AND MORE ELECTRICITY WILL BE ADDED TO THE NATIONAL GRID. HE SAID THAT WORK ON 1360MW COAL POWER PROJECT WAS ALSO NEARING COMPLETION.



P rime Minister Shahid Khaqan Abbasi has said that the government was committed to resolve the issue of energy shortage and has, in fact, successfully reduced the gap between demand and supply both in electricity and natural gas. Addressing the inaugural ceremony of the second Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) terminal at the Port Qasim, Karachi built by the private sector, the Prime Minister said that work was going on several power projects to overcome the challenge in the shortest possible time.

Pakistan is importing 600 million cubic feet per day (mmcf) of LNG through its first LNG terminal at Port Qasim. The new terminal would handle another 600 mmcf, taking the total imported volume to 1.2 billion cubic feet per day.

The Prime Minister said that when the PML-N government came into power in 2013 it was confronted with serious issues of power shortages, lawlessness and an economy in shambles. However, owing to the vision of its leadership and dedicated team, the country's economy has turned around and today it has a 5.3 percent growth rate. He said he anticipates to sustain the rate and take it up to 6 percent next year.

Mr. Abbasi said that the government was working on ways to produce electricity through different options, adding that three more power stations that run on LNG would soon be operational and more electricity will be added to the national grid. The Prime Minister said that work on 1360MW coal power project is also nearing completion.

The Prime Minister congratulated Pakistan GasPort Limited (PGPL) Chairman Iqbal Z Ahmed on achieving this milestone. He termed the LNG terminal a success story and added that all new terminals are in the private sector. He reiterated that the government is a facilitator between consumers and the suppliers and provides requisite regulatory framework.


Mr. Abbasi said that LNG is the cheapest fuel available in the country and would adequately meet the requirements of the commercial, industrial, domestic and CNG sectors.

He said there is immense potential for investment in the LNG sector as the country has a huge market for natural gas. ●

Governor Sindh performs ground breaking to gasify 100 villages



The present government is determined to provide all basic amenities to the people of Sindh in order to help improve their standard of living and remove a sense of deprivation from their lives.

This was stated by Mohammad Zubair, Governor Sindh during his keynote address at the groundbreaking ceremony for the supply of natural gas to more than 100 villages of Thatta and Sujawal. In accordance with the directives of the prime minister, the federal government and SSGC are taking the lead in the distribution of gas to scores of villages spread over a network of 400 kilometres. The projects are being constructed at a cost of Rs. 1.5 billion, out of which Rs. 1 billion is being financed by the Government of Pakistan and the rest by the SSGC. MPA Syed Aijaz Ali Shah Shirazi and MNA and Minister of State for National Food Security and Research Syed Ayaz Ali Shah Shirazi are the renowned residents of the villages.

The Governor unveiled the plaques to perform the groundbreaking of the gas distribution

projects at three locations of Thatta and Sujawal. He lauded the services of the Shirazi family for the people of Thatta, Sujawal and the adjoining towns and villages, and said that the massive scheme of providing gas to 100 villages was an example of that commitment. He also appreciated the efforts of the SSGC management to ensure an interrupted gas supply to every nook and corner of its franchise areas.

Nazim Thatta Syed Shafqat Shah Shirazi, Saeed Larik, ASGM (Distribution-North), Abdul Waheed Jumani, GM (Distribution-Lower Sindh), Abdul Rasheed Leghari, Regional Manager (Hyderabad) and public representatives and elders of Thatta and Sujawal also witnessed the ceremonies.

In his address, Mr. Larik explained the salient features of the above mentioned distribution projects to the audience. He said that already the SSGC had started working on around 80 distribution schemes and had in fact completed a survey of more than 85 villages for laying the pipelines. ○






Right time to invest in Pakistan's energy sector: Minister of State

Jam Kamal Khan, Minister of State spoke at a ministerial session of ADIPEC 2017, held in Abu Dhabi from November 13 to 16, 2017. The session was entitled 'Ministerial Panel: Creating Energy Opportunity through Foresight, Vision, Inspiration and Innovation' and featured energy ministers from UAE, Oman and Egypt, besides Pakistan.





Jam Kamal Khan, Pakistan's Minister of State for Petroleum Division (Ministry of Energy) has said that the country's energy sector offers excellent opportunities for foreign investors owing to a number of positive developments that have taken place of late on that front.

The Minister of State was speaking at a ministerial session of ADIPEC 2017, one of the world's biggest oil and gas exhibition-cum-conference held in Abu Dhabi from November 13 to 16, 2017. The session was entitled 'Ministerial Panel: Creating Energy Opportunity through Foresight, Vision, Inspiration and Innovation' and featured energy ministers from UAE, Oman and Egypt, besides Pakistan. The elite panel at the Ministerial Session also included Sohail Mohammad Al Mazrouei, Minister of Energy and Industry, UAE, Mohammed Hamad Al

Rumhy, Minister of Oil and Gas, Sultanate of Oman and Tarek El Molla, Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources, Arab Republic of Egypt. The session was moderated by CNBC anchor Hadley Gamble.

The Minister stressed that Pakistan has significant consumption of energy, with the country's GDP growth anticipated at 6.5% in the coming year. This developing scenario, he said, is opening up new opportunities for foreign investors. The Minister emphasized that the country needs to improve its upstream resources and noted that especially in the field of Exploration and Production (E&P), there is a lot of room for foreign companies to come in and Pakistan is looking to increase its refining capacity.

Mr. Khan said that Pakistan has already built a robust infrastructure which includes the first

LNG Terminal that was completed in a record time of 335 days and a 342-km dedicated RLNG transmission pipeline from Port Qasim, Karachi through which re-gasified LNG is transmitted to local industries that require it most. He said that the second terminal will soon start operating and more such terminals will be installed in the future too.

Still, he said, a lot needs to be done since the entire energy sector has not been covered and gas and power requirements still need to be fulfilled. The Minister said that Pakistan is focusing on building enduring partnerships to avail opportunities in E&P, refining and LNG sectors. The Minister also talked about the importance of working with Egypt and Oman, emphasising on the value of Pakistan's potential LNG partnership with Oman. ●



Lt. General Javed Zia (R) becomes Chairman SSGC

Lieutenant General Javed Zia (Retd.) took over as Chairman, SSGC on November 16, 2017. He replaces Dr. Miftah Ismail who served as the Company's Chairman from November 7, 2013 to October 18, 2017.

Born in Karachi on February 23, 1954, Lieutenant General Javed Zia (Retd.) served Pakistan Army for 40 years. His illustrious career culminated into his elevation as Commander Southern Command at Balochistan in 2010-11. Prior to that, he served as DG Rangers Sindh, Deputy Chief of General Staff and as Adjutant General Pakistan Army. On the Corporate side, he has been Chairman, Askari Bank, Chairman, Army Welfare Trust, Senior Executive Member, Governing Body of DHA's Pakistan, Executive Head of DHA Islamabad and member of Policy Formulation Board of Fauji Foundation's Committee of Administration.

Lieutenant General Javed Zia (Retd.) served as Pakistan's Ambassador to Libya from 2014 to 2016. Safe evacuation of approximately 8,000 Pakistanis from Libya to Pakistan stands out as one of his notable contributions during that period. He has also served as United Nations (UN) peace keeper at Somalia in 1993-94. He holds Master's Degrees in Political Science and in Strategic Studies. The Chairman is a recipient of Hilal-e-Imtiaz (Military) and UN Service Medal (Bar).

Seminar with clerics

Every year SSGC embarks full throttle on 'Winter Safety Media Campaign' to create basic awareness for careful use of gas-fired appliances especially gas heaters with a focus to eliminate situations that lead to loss of precious human lives. The Company's team communicates formally with various stakeholders including clerics and media persons so that as opinion makers, they can convey these messages to their target audience.

Like in the past, the Company got the Campaign rolling this year on the 28th of November from Quetta Press Club, with a symposium attended by a large number of ulemas from Balochistan. The main thrust of the event was to reiterate the need to create awareness among the clerics about safe use of gas-fired appliances especially during the winters as well as, on the menace of natural gas theft.

The event was organized by SSGC's Corporate Communication Department in conjunction with the Company's Regional Office in Quetta. The clerics who participated in the program included Maulana Abdul Rahim Hai, Maulana Syed Habibullah Shah Chishti, Taj Agha of Anjuman Tajaran-e-Quetta, Hafiz Mazhar

Liaqat, Maulana Dr. Ata-ur-Rehman, Maulana Anwar-ul-Haq Haqqani, Maulana Mukhtar Ahmed, Maulana Abdul Rahman, Mufti Ahmed Khan and Maulana Ahmed Raza Qambrani and Abdul Qayum Kakar. SSGC was represented by Saeed Larik, ASGM (Distribution-North), Madni Siddiqui, DGM/Incharge (Distribution Balochistan Region), Shahbaz Islam, AGM (Corporate Communications), Mohammad Ali Gohar, Chief Manager (Media Relations), Shamshullah Kakar, CM (Customer Relations-Quetta), Amir Dutani, CM (HSE), Shehzad Alam, Chief Engineer and Safdar Hussain, Dy. Manager (Media Relations).

In his address to the ulemas, ASGM (Distribution-North) stressed that natural gas theft is a serious issue in Balochistan especially during winters when consumption of gas increases manifold due to increased use of gas-fired appliances. He said that even though consumption rises as compared to in the normal months, there is no real change in consumer billing although the propensity to steal gas doubles. The ASGM requested the local clerics to stress in their religious congregations that gas theft is a major crime that leads to prison terms and imposition of heavy fines. Mr. Larik further added that the outcome of SSGC's Winter Safety Media

Awareness Campaign has been quite positive as the number of deaths resulting from negligence in the use of gas-fired appliances has fallen drastically in Balochistan and other areas since the last several years. He thanked the Ulemas for always supporting SSGC in this mission and hoped that they would continue to do so in the future too. The ASGM (D-N) dispelled the notion that gas meters run fast resulting in faulty reading. He said that SSGC follows in this regard international gas measurement standards.

In his vote of thanks, Madni Arafat Siddiqui, DGM / Incharge (Distribution-Balochistan Region) thanked the ulemas for participating in this program in impressive numbers. He said that serving customers of Balochistan for him and his team is priority number one.

In their speeches, the ulemas praised the role played by SSGC in creating mass awareness about safe use of natural gas during winters and also in educating consumers about the menace of gas theft. They suggested that in the future SSGC must take up such awareness campaigns to different localities in the cities and towns of the franchise provinces of Sindh and Balochistan. ●

Formal Campaign Launch

SSGC gives prime importance to Balochistan and is committed towards ensuring that its customers residing in this province gets uninterrupted gas supply.

This was stated by Saeed Larik, SSGC's ASGM (Distribution-North) while talking to the media persons at the formal launch of the Winter Safety Media Awareness Campaign held at the Regional Office, Quetta. The launch is an annual affair organized every winter in Quetta and is marked by a series of symposiums and media interactions that emphasize on safe and wise use of natural gas as well as communicate to the stakeholders about serious repercussions of gas theft.

While talking to the media, Mr. Larik said that SSGC is about to start work on a 34-km, 12" and 24" dia. gas pipeline from Shikarpur to Jacobabad. The commissioning of this pipeline, to be built at a cost of Rs. 3.3 billion will help inject 40 mmcf/d gas to Quetta and adjoining areas thus ensuring a marked improvement in overall gas supply, Mr. Larik said. He also informed the audience that SSGC is installing two compressors, one in Sibi and

another in Shikarpur in order to ensure that flow of gas pressure is improved especially during winters.

Earlier, ASGM (Distribution-North) officially launched the Winter Safety Media Awareness Campaign by cutting a ribbon. The ceremony was witnessed by a large number of media persons. Present on the occasion were Madni Siddiqui, DGM/Incharge (Distribution Balochistan Region), Shahbaz Islam, AGM (Corporate Communications), Mohammad Ali Gohar, Chief Manager (Media Relations - Corporate Communications), Shamsullah Kakar, Chief Manager (Customer Relations-Quetta), Safdar Hussain, Dy. Manager (Media Relations - Corporate Communications) and a large number of SSGC executives and staff.

Team SSGC participated in the launch by displaying colorful posters containing useful guidelines for using gas appliances safely and responsibly. A fleet of Company's customer service vans displaying striking images of SSGC's determination to uproot gas theft as well as visual messages about using gas safely during winters, were seen off by ASGM

(Distribution-North) and SSGC team. The overall branding of these vans was carried out by SSGC's Corporate Communication Department.

Talking to the media, ASGM (Distribution-North) reiterated that one of the main causes of UFG or line losses is natural gas theft which basically constitutes 50% of the total losses. He said that due to bitterly cold winters, consumption of gas increases manifold but instead of paying their bills, many users resort to gas theft which ultimately affects the Company's financial position. Mr. Larik added that in order to provide fuel to those areas that are far away from the distribution grid, SSGC is installing LPG-Air Mix Plants in Balochistan. ASGM (D-North) further added that the positive outcome of the winter safety awareness campaign conducted every year is that the number of deaths from callous use of natural gas has fallen sharply in Quetta and adjoining areas of late. He observed that stakeholders including media have played an important role in decreasing the number of fatalities and hoped that such support will continue. 🟡






Interaction with media

Madni Siddiqui, Provincial Head, Balochistan Region, SSGC has said that the Company is following the Government of Pakistan's directives of installing around 30 LPG-Air Mix plants in the far flung areas of Sindh and Balochistan. Mr. Siddiqui said that for ensuring gas to those areas that are far off from SSGC's distribution grid, already three LPG-Air Mix or Synthetic Natural Gas (SNG) plants are currently operational in Gwadar, Noshki and Surab in Balochistan and work on the two more plants in Awaran and Bela is nearly completion.



Mr. Siddiqui said this while talking to the media persons at a dinner reception hosted in honour of the media fraternity of Balochistan region at Serena Hotel, Quetta. The dinner was part of SSGC's Winter Safety Media Awareness Campaign launched every winter to propagate messages to the general public about safe use of gas and the menace of gas theft.



The Company's provincial head said that providing gas to the entire Balochistan is among the top priorities of the Company. He further added that so far 14 districts of the province have been provided natural gas and work is moving on in full throttle to distribute it to other districts too. Mr. Siddiqui said even if the Company's employees are involved in stealing gas they will not be spared and law will take its course on them.

On the subject of Winter Safety Awareness campaign that stresses on safe use of gas-fired appliances, Mr. Siddiqui said that before this Campaign intensified, on average 20 deaths used to be recorded in Balochistan region during winter times. Now primarily due to this mass campaign, the number of fatalities has been reduced to five on average, he said. He added that SSGC will not rest till the number of fatalities comes to zero.

Shahbaz Islam, Head of Corporate Communications, SSGC reiterated that while the Company is running a campaign to rein in gas thieves, success will only be ensured when the media, clerics, general public and other stakeholders will whole heartedly support the gas utility in its mission. Mr. Islam said that gas is Pakistan's lifeline and it is incumbent on every citizen of the country to play his due role in saving it for the future generations.

In his speech, Mr. Raza-ur-Rehman, President, Quetta Press Club said that still a lot of places in Balochistan have not yet got the facility of natural gas with the result that a sense of deprivation has been created among the



people of the province. He hoped that SSGC would continue to focus on providing gas to a maximum number of areas in the province. Mr. Rehman asked the SSGC management to look into the issue of wrong billing in Balochistan.

Khalid Ahmed, President Balochistan Union of Journalists expressed his happiness at the fact that the number of deaths and injuries from callous use of gas-fired appliances have dipped sharply and credited SSGC for this positive development. He hoped that SSGC will

continue to give priority to far flung areas of Balochistan by providing them with natural gas.

In their speeches, local clerics including Maulana Anwar-ul-Haq Haqqani and Professor Arshad Rashid stressed that gas is not just a rare natural resource but inarguably the best and most affordable fuel and as conscientious citizens we must do everything we can do to use it responsibly and ethically. ◉


A positive impact

A In the past, primarily due to lack of awareness, many customers demonstrated callousness in the use of gas-fired appliances.

They would not switch off their heaters

before sleeping with the result that a number of deaths and injuries were common occurrences. Thanks primarily to mass awareness programs such as SSGC's Winter Safety Campaigns, the number of fatalities have fallen sharply. For instance, in 2013-14,

21 deaths and 50 injuries were recorded which is a far cry from 2016-17 figures when only ten injuries and no deaths were reported, a sign of a better sense of awareness among the customers. ◉





Amin Rajput, Acting MD, SSGC has reiterated that there is Zero tolerance on Gas theft as it impacts severely on the Company's financial bottom line which is one of the main cause of our lines losses or UFG.

AMD, SSGC made these remarks while talking to the members of Korangi Association of Trade and Industry (KATI) in a meeting organized by the Association at KATI's Head Office in Karachi. In the meeting the AMD was accompanied by SSGC's Dr Ejaz Ahmed, SGM (Customer Services), Saeed Larik, ASGM (Distribution - North), Brigadier Mohammad Abuzar (Retd), Director General, Security Services and Control Gas Theft Operations (SS&CGTO), Shehryar

Kazmi, GM (Billing, Kamran Naji, GM (D South) and Major Muhammad Hussain (Retd), DGM (Coordination).

The KATI team expressed their concern that most of the investors / industrialists had plans to invest in Karachi but due to non availability of gas they did not come forward for the investment. President KATI, Tarik Malik said the gas pressure has increased and become better than before that has resulted in increase in general productions.

He stressed the need for uninterrupted gas supply and hoped that SSGC would look on top priority at the gas pressure and availability issues faced by the industrial sector.

Mr. Rajput said that LNG is the fuel of the future and its availability is indispensable to bridge the demand-supply gap of natural gas as well as overcoming energy crisis in the country. In this regards he said, SSGC has developed the requisite pipeline infrastructure for transmitting RLNG volumes. In a reply to a query about supply of RLNG to the industries in Sindh, the AMD SSGC said that in near future, RLNG will be transmitted/distributed as allocated by the Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division) to SSGC's franchise, there after, we will be able to supply gas to the industrial sector of our franchise provinces. This will result in elimination of weekly closure of gas to the industrial sector.

No escape – Raiding teams clamp down on gas theft

SSGC conducted raids against gas thieves in Afghan Basti adjacent to Sohrab Goth, where owners of a mini power house were found selling electricity which was being generated directly from a gas line.

SSGC's raiding team arrested Najibullah and confiscated the properties. Similar raid took place at Golden Spoon Restaurant located in Shah Faisal Colony where the culprits were found using gas directly from 401 PSI gas line.



FIR has been lodged against the main culprit Shakeel Ahmed.

SSGC is waging an all out war against natural gas theft, which is a primary cause of Unaccounted-for-Gas or UFG. UFG, another term for line losses has severely impacted the Company's financial bottomline. **●**

Brigadier (Retd), Abuzar said that the approval of Gas Act, formation of gas utility courts for prosecuting gas thieves in Sindh and Balochistan and formation of Gas Police Station dedicated for the said purpose, have helped SSGC in intensifying crackdowns on gas thieves. DG (SS&CGTO) said that for

meaningful results, SS&CGTO Department has been structured on more result-oriented lines, whereby experienced civilians and law enforcement officials are taking care of gas theft intelligence and prosecution and operations wings of the Department.

He said that, more Police Stations especially dedicated to penalizing gas thieves are being established.

DG (SS&CGTO) added that soon the Company would be launching a media campaign to highlight Gas Act and its penalties. The campaign, he said, is focused only on gas thieves from domestic, commercial and industrial sectors. He sought KATI's support in

identifying elements involved in gas theft related crimes.

Members of KATI lauded SSGC's ongoing drive against gas theft and anticipated that gas saved as a result will be passed on to the rightful and legal customers. After the meeting, Tariq Malik, KATI's President presented a shield to AMD Amin Rajput for gracing the occasion. Besides its President, KATI was represented at the meeting by Vice President Junaid Naqi, CEO KITE Masood Naqi, Committee Chairman (SSGC) Ahtshamuddin and former Presidents, Zahid Saeed, Shaikh Manzar Alam, S. M. Yahya, Shaikh Fazlul Jalil and Zubair Chaya. **●**

Amin Rajput, Acting MD, has said that LNG is the fuel of the future and its availability is indispensable to bridge the demand-supply gap of natural gas as well as overcoming energy crisis in the country.

In this regard, he said, SSGC has developed the requisite pipeline infrastructure for transmitting RLNG volumes to the consumption nodes in the northern part of the country. In a reply to a query about the supply of RLNG to the industries in Sindh, the SSGC AMD said that in near future, once RLNG is supplied to the industries in the company's franchise provinces, a weekly closure of gas will end permanently.

On the issue of natural gas theft, Rajput has reiterated that there is zero tolerance on gas theft as it impacts severely on SSGC's financial

bottom line, which is one of the main causes of lines losses or UFG.

Mr. Rajput made these remarks while talking to the members of Landhi Association of Trade and Industry (LATI) in a meeting held in SSGC House at Karachi.

The LATI team consisting on LATI President Islamudin M Zafar, General Secretary Mubeen Khan, and members M. Kamran Farukh and Kaleem Qureshi expressed their satisfaction over the increase of gas pressure being supplied to the industrial area and services provided to them by SSGC. LATI team demanded to revert the decision to end Sunday closure of gas supplies to the industries as it affects their production.



standardization and implementation of ISO-50001.



پاکستان توانائی کے شعبہ میں غیر ملکی کمپنیوں کی شراکت کا خواہاں ہے۔ وزیر مملکت پیٹرولیم ڈویژن



منسٹر ایل اجلاس کے اہم ہینل میں سہیل محمد امروٹی، منسٹر آف انرجی اینڈ انڈسٹری، یو۔ای۔ محمد حامد الرحمہ، منسٹر آف آئل اینڈ گیس، سلطنت عمان اور طارق المولیٰ منسٹر آف پیٹرولیم اینڈ منرل ریسورسز، مصر شامل تھے۔

یو۔ای کے توانائی کے وزیر نے کہا کہ پاکستان ریفاٹنگ انڈسٹری میں ترقی و توسیع کی بڑی گنجائش موجود ہے اور یو۔ای اس میں سرمایہ کاری کیلئے پوری طرح تیار ہے۔ وزیر موصوف نے مزید کہا کہ پاکستان میں ریٹرو ایبل انرجی کی بھی بڑی گنجائش ہے۔ عمان کے گیس اور آئل کے وزیر نے توانائی کے تحفظ کی اہمیت بیان کرتے ہوئے شراکاء پر ایل این جی کے استعمال پر زور دیا۔ انہوں نے اعتراف کیا کہ عمان میں گیس کے استعمال کے فروغ سے بڑی تبدیلی کی توقع ہے مگر اس کے ساتھ انہوں نے تسلیم کیا کہ پروڈکشن اور قیمت کے لحاظ سے کئی چیلنج موجود ہیں۔ مصر کے پیٹرولیم اور معدنی وسائل کے وزیر نے کہا کہ وہ مصر میں گیس کے استعمال میں اضافہ کے بارے میں بہت پرامید ہیں اور اب جبکہ ملک سیاسی شورش سے باہر نکل آیا ہے جو سرمایہ کاری کیلئے منفی اثر رکھتی تھی اور موجودہ صورتحال سرمایہ کاروں کیلئے پرکشش ہے۔

جناب جام کمال خان نے پاکستان کے آئل اینڈ گیس شعبہ کی ترقی پر بات کرتے ہوئے کہا کہ ہمیں اس میں پارٹنرشپ کی ضرورت ہے خاص طور پر ای اینڈ پی، ریفاٹنگ اور ایل این جی کے شعبہ میں بڑے مواقع موجود ہیں۔ انہوں نے مصر اور عمان کے ساتھ شراکت کی اہمیت پر بھی زور دیا اور عمان کے ساتھ پاکستان میں ایل این جی میں شراکت کو اہم قرار دیا۔

یاد رہے کہ ایڈپیک 2017 میں پاکستان کی موجودگی بہت نمایاں حیثیت کی حامل تھی۔ پیٹرولیم انٹرنیشنل ٹیٹ آف پاکستان نے نمائش میں پاکستان پیپلین قائم کیا جہاں پاکستان میں آئل اینڈ گیس کے شعبہ سے متعلق اہم معلومات فراہم کی گئی جن میں پاکستان اسٹیٹ آئل، پاکستان پیٹرولیم لمیٹڈ، آئل اینڈ گیس ڈیولپمنٹ کمپنی لمیٹڈ، سوئی سدرن گیس کمپنی، سوئی ناردرن گیس پائپ لائنز لمیٹڈ، ماری پیٹرولیم کمپنی لمیٹڈ، انٹرا اسٹیٹ گیس سسٹمز (پرائیویٹ) لمیٹڈ، گورنمنٹ ہولڈنگز (پرائیویٹ) لمیٹڈ، خیبر پختونخوا آئل اینڈ گیس ڈیولپمنٹ کمپنی اور پاکستان ایل این جی ڈیمنٹرز لمیٹڈ کے بارے میں معلومات شامل تھیں۔

پاکستان کے وزیر مملکت پیٹرولیم ڈویژن نے کہا کہ ملک میں توانائی کا استعمال نمایاں طور پر بڑھ گیا ہے اور آنے والے سال میں جی ڈی پی میں 16.5% اضافہ کی توقع ہے۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ ترقی کے اس پس منظر میں سرمایہ کاروں کیلئے نئے مواقع ہیں۔

وزیر مملکت ایڈپیک 2017 کے منسٹر ایل اجلاس سے خطاب کر رہے تھے جو دنیا کی سب سے بڑی آئل اینڈ گیس نمائش و کانفرنس میں سے ایک ہے جس کا انعقاد 13 تا 16 نومبر 2017 کو دبئی میں ہوا۔ اس دوروزہ شاندار تقریب کا موضوع تھا 'منسٹر ایل ہینل: پیش بینی، وژن، تحریک اور جدت کے ذریعہ توانائی کی تخلیق کے مواقع اور شراکت کرنے والوں میں یو۔ای، عمان، مصر اور پاکستان کے توانائی کے وزراء شامل تھے۔ اس اجلاس کے ماڈریٹری ایل این جی کے میزبان ہونے کیلئے تھے۔

وزیر مملکت نے بتایا کہ پاکستان پہلے ہی ایک بھر پور انفراسٹرکچر تشکیل دے چکا ہے جس میں پہلا ایل این جی ٹرمینل کراچی میں 335 دن کی ریکارڈ مدت میں مکمل کر دیا گیا ہے جہاں سے ان مقامی صنعتوں کو رتی گیسفاٹنڈ ایل این جی فراہم کی جا رہی ہے جنہیں اس کی اشد ضرورت تھی۔ انہوں نے بتایا کہ دوسرا ٹرمینل بھی جلد ہی کام شروع کر دے گا اور مستقبل میں ایسے اور بھی ٹرمینل قائم کئے جائیں گے۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ ابھی بھی بہت کچھ کرنے کی ضرورت ہے کیونکہ ابھی توانائی کے شعبہ کا مکمل احاطہ نہیں ہوا ہے اور توانائی کی ضرورتیں باقی ہیں۔ پاکستان میں توانائی کی

ہوئے بتایا کہ یو ایف جی بلائن کے نقصانات کی بڑی وجہ قدرتی گیس کی چوری ہے جو کل نقصانات کا 55% ہے۔ انہوں نے کہا کہ شدید سردی کے باعث گیس کا استعمال بہت زیادہ بڑھ جاتا ہے لیکن کئی لوگ اس کا بل ادا کرنے کی بجائے گیس چوری کرنے لگتے ہیں جس سے لامحالہ طور پر کمپنی کو مالی نقصان پہنچتا ہے۔ سید لاڑک نے مزید کہا کہ جو علاقے ڈسٹری بیوٹن گریڈ سے بہت زیادہ فاصلے پر ہیں، ان کو فیول گیس فراہمی کے لئے ایس ایس جی سی بلوچستان میں ایل پی جی ایئر گیس کس پلانٹس نصب کر رہی ہے۔ ایسا ہی ایک پلانٹ آواران میں تکمیل کے آخری مرحلہ میں ہے۔

اس پلانٹ سے فی گھنٹہ 50 ایم بی ٹی یو کے حساب سے سینتھیک نیچرل گیس فراہم کی جائے گی۔ اے ایس جی ایم (ڈی۔ نارٹھ) نے یہ بھی بتایا کہ ہر سال موسم سرما میں حفاظتی و آگاہی مہم چلانے سے مثبت نتائج سامنے آتے ہیں اور کوئٹہ اور اس سے ملحق علاقوں میں گیس کے غیر محتاط طریقے سے استعمال کے باعث ہونے والی اموات میں کمی واقع ہوئی ہے۔ انہوں نے اس بات کا اظہار کیا کہ اسٹیک ہولڈرز اور میڈیا نے بھی ان حادثات میں کمی لانے میں اہم کردار ادا کیا ہے۔

ایس ایس جی سی نے اس تقریب کی نمائش کی جن میں گیس کی اشیاء کے محفوظ اور محتاط استعمال کیلئے رہنمائی کی گئی تھی اس کے علاوہ کمپنی کی کسٹمر سروس کی گاڑیوں کے ایک دستے نے بھی مختلف علاقوں کا دورہ کیا۔ ان گاڑیوں پر ایس ایس جی سی کی گیس کی چوری کے خاتمے کے عزم اور سردیوں میں گیس کے محتاط استعمال کے بارے میں بصری پیغامات چھاپا تھے۔ ان گاڑیوں کو اے ایس جی ایم (ڈسٹری بیوٹن۔ نارٹھ) نے روانہ کیا۔ ان گاڑیوں کی مجموعی طور پر برانڈنگ ایس ایس جی سی کے کارپوریٹ کمیونیکیشن ڈپارٹمنٹ نے کی تھی۔

اے ایس جی ایم (ڈسٹری بیوٹن۔ نارٹھ) نے میڈیا سے باتیں کرتے

ایس ایس جی سی بلوچستان کو انتہائی اہمیت دیتی ہے اور اس بات کو یقینی بناتی ہے کہ اس صوبے کے عوام کو بلا تھقل گیس فراہم کی جائے۔ ان خیالات کا اظہار ایس ایس جی سی کے اے ایس جی ایم (ڈسٹری بیوٹن۔ نارٹھ) سید احمد لاڑک نے موسم سرما کی تحفظ و آگاہی مہم کا آغاز کرتے وقت ریجنل آفس کوئٹہ میں میڈیا کے نمائندوں سے گفتگو کرتے ہوئے کیا، اس مہم کا اہتمام ہر سال سردیوں کے آغاز پر کوئٹہ میں منعقد ہونے والی مختلف تقریبات کے دوران کیا جاتا ہے جن میں سمپوزیم کے علاوہ میڈیا کے تعاون سے قدرتی گیس کے محتاط طور پر استعمال کی آگہی دی جاتی ہے اور اس کے ساتھ اسٹیک ہولڈرز کو یاد دہانی کرائی جاتی ہے کہ گیس کی چوری قانونی طور پر جرم ہے۔

میڈیا کے سوالات کا جواب دیتے ہوئے سید لاڑک نے کہا ایس ایس جی سی کی جانب سے شکار پور سے جیکب آباد تک "12 اور 24 ڈی اے کی 34 کلومیٹر طویل پائپ لائن بچھانے کا کام جلد مکمل ہو جائے گا۔ 3.3 بلین روپے سے قائم ہونے والی اس پائپ لائن سے کوئٹہ اور اس کے ملحقہ علاقوں کو 140 ایم ایم ایف ڈی گیس فراہم ہوگی اور مجموعی طور پر گیس کی فراہمی میں بہتری پیدا ہوگی۔



وزیر اعظم نے دوسرے ایل این جی ٹرینل کا افتتاح کیا



اس موقع پر وزیر اعظم نے اقبال زیڈ احمد، چیئرمین پاکستان گیس پورٹ لمیٹڈ (پی جی ایل) کو یہ شاندار سنگ میل عبور کرنے پر مبارکباد پیش کی اور اس ایل این جی ٹرینل کی تعمیر کو ایک کامیاب پیشرفت قرار دیا۔ یہ تمام نئے ٹرینل نئی شعبے کی ملکیت ہیں۔ انہوں نے زور دیا کہ حکومت صارفین اور سپلائرز کے بیچ میں صرف ایک سہولت کار ہے اور ضروری قانونی فریم ورک اور تحفظ مہیا کرتی ہے۔

وزیر اعظم شاہد خاقان عباسی نے ایل این جی کو ایک سستا ایندھن قرار دیا جو ملک کی تجارتی، صنعتی، گھریلو اور سی این جی سیکٹر کی ضروریات بخوبی پوری کر سکتا ہے۔ آخر میں انہوں نے صنعتکاروں کو ایل این جی سیکٹر میں سرمایہ کاری کی دعوت دیتے ہوئے کہا کہ اس وقت ملک میں قدرتی گیس کی وسیع مارکیٹ ہونے کی وجہ سے ایل این جی سیکٹر میں سرمایہ کاری کے شاندار مواقع موجود ہیں۔

حکومت کو اقتدار سنبھالتے ہی بہت سے مسائل سے نہرو آزا ہونا پڑا جن میں توانائی کا بحران لاقانونیت اور کمزور معاشی صورتحال شامل تھی لیکن ان کی قیادت کے نظریے اور اس مقصد کے حصول کیلئے ایک مخلص اور منحنی نیم کے بدولت ملک کی معاشی صورتحال نے پلٹا کھلایا اور آج ملک کی ترقی کی شرح رفتار 5.3 فیصد ہے۔ انہوں نے اُمید ظاہر کی کہ نہ صرف وہ اس کو برقرار رکھیں گے بلکہ اس کو 6 فیصد تک لے کے جائیں گے۔

وزیر اعظم نے مزید کہا کہ حکومت گزشتہ کچھ عرصے سے بجلی کی پیداوار میں اضافے کیلئے مختلف طریقوں کو بروئے کار لارہی تھی اور اس سلسلے میں تین مزید پاور اسٹیشنز جو کہ ایل این جی پر چلائے جانے تھے ان کا اب آغاز کر دیا جائے گا جس کے نتیجے میں مزید بجلی قومی گڑ میں شامل ہو سکے گی۔ اس کے علاوہ 1360 میگا واٹ کول پاور پراجیکٹ بھی تکمیل کے مراحل میں ہے۔

وزیر اعظم شاہد خاقان عباسی نے کہا ہے کہ حکومت آغاز ہی سے توانائی کے بحران پر قابو پانے کیلئے کوشش کر رہی ہے اور اس سلسلے میں حکومت نے نہایت کامیابی کے ساتھ بجلی و قدرتی گیس کی طلب اور رسد کے فرق پر قابو پایا ہے۔ یہ بات انہوں نے پورٹ قاسم پر دوسرے ایل این جی ٹرینل کے افتتاح کے موقع پر کہی جو کہ نئی شعبے کی جانب سے تعمیر کیا گیا ہے۔ انہوں نے مزید بتایا کہ اس بحران پر قابو پانے کیلئے نہایت تیز رفتاری کے ساتھ بہت سارے منصوبوں پر کام جاری ہے۔

پاکستان اس وقت اپنے پہلے ایل این جی ٹرینل سے یومیہ 600 ملین کیوبک فٹ (ایم ایم سی ایف ڈی) ایل این جی درآمد کر رہا ہے، اب اس نئے ٹرینل سے مزید 600 ایم ایم ایف سی ڈی کا اضافہ ہوگا جس کے نتیجے میں کل درآمدی حجم یومیہ 1.2 ملین کیوبک فٹ تک پہنچ جائے گا۔ وزیر اعظم نے اپنے خطاب میں بتایا کہ 2013 میں پی ایم ایل این جی
