





iquefied Natural Gas may be an expensive fuel but given the widening demand-supply gap of natural gas, it is still a better alternative for industries. This was stated by Lt. General (R) Javed Zia, Chairman, SSGC while speaking as the chief guest at the meeting organized by the office bearers of Karachi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI). The Chairman was accompanied by SSGC's ASGM (Distribution-North) Saeed Ahmed Larik, Company Secretary Shoaib Ahmed, and Chief Manager, Corporate Communications Syed Imran Ahmed.

The Chairman said that the lifting of the moratorium on new industrial connections and availability of RLNG to the industries are positive developments. He said that so far SSGC has received more than 550 applications for RLNG connections and after due scrutiny they will be provided with connections.

This was SSGC Chairman's first visit to any trade association since his appointment on the Company's Board of Directors in November 2017. He said that one of the primary objectives of this visit was to seek KCCI support for jointly confronting challenges faced by SSGC including the issue of gas theft which is one of the contributory factors behind the menace of Unaccounted-for-Gas or line losses that has severely impacted the Company's financial position. The KCCI office bearers led by its President Muffasar Atta Malik assured the Chairman and his team that KCCI will leave no stone unturned in discouraging industrial units engaged in gas theft and will support SSGC wholeheartedly in apprehending the miscreants.

The Chairman stressed that the current SSGC management is determined to control the rising cases of gas theft and for the said purpose has restructured the concerned department and have placed this unit in charge of an experienced team that has intensified raids against gas thieves in the recent months besides filing FIRs against the culprits in the SSGC police station. He informed the KCCI office bearers that the Company has also started taking forceful action against crimes related to gas meter tampering.

The Chairman said that the Company is also focusing its efforts on regularizing gas load so that other units do not suffer from the unauthorized load expansion that also causes low pressure. At the conclusion, President KCCI presented a flower bouquet and a shield to the Chairman as a token of appreciation for the visit.










# SSGC invites engineers on board

he start of the new year proved to be a difficult one for the miscreants involved in gas theft.

SSGC's Security Services and Counter Gas Theft Operations (SS and CGTO) Team conducted raids on two business units in Federal B. Area and Mehmoodabad in Karachi on January 30, 2018. The SS & CGTO team in coordination with the Company's Customer Relations and SSGC police contingent undertook a raid on a corrugation factory where the owners were involved in stealing gas from direct line and consuming a total load of 925 cubic feet per hour to run their unit. SSGC Police arrested the factory owner Zahid Malik and lodged an FIR against him. Material used in stealing gas was also confiscated by the raiding team.

The same team raided a bakery in Mehmoodabad where the proprietors were stealing gas directly from main line and consuming a load of 1,100 cubic feet per hour to run the unit. The SSGC police nabbed the bakery owner Babar Khan and registered an FIR against him.

On the 20th of January, the team undertook raids in commercial units in Gulshan-e-lqbal and Malir. The raiding party carried out their operations in small factories involved in making sweets and confectionary items. The owners were

found tampering with gas meter and using gas directly for running their factories. The SSGC Police apprehended the owners and confiscated the material used in theft.

The SS & CGTO team also raided three restaurants located in North Nazimabad that were involved in using domestic connection for running their commercial concerns.

In January 2018, the teams also raided thread manufacturing factory in Nazimabad in Karachi and a tailoring shop in Jacobabad. FIRs were registered against the culprits.

SSGC has expressed its determination to uproot the menace of gas theft which is one of the major reasons behind the rising trend of Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG).

The Operation Grift campaign is in full flow, with the Company management determined to uproot the menace of gas theft.

The Gas (Theft Control and Recovery) Act, 2016 passed by the National Assembly and the recent establishment of Gas Theft utility courts have given the gas utilities a forceful mandate to take an unprecedented legal action against them.





Left Hand Drive vs. Right Hand Drive: A Short History
The majority of the world's population drives on the right-hand side of the road, and yet the first vehicles ever built where designed to be driven on the left-hand side. What factors caused this change in how we drive? We take a look at both right and left hand drive countries in this left hand drive vs. right hand drive comparison.

#### History of Left-Hand Driving

The trend of left-hand driving predates the automobile by centuries—all the way back to the medieval age of knights, swords, and constant warring.

Since 70–90 percent of the world's population favour using their right hands, during the times of King Arthur, soldiers and weapon-bearing citizens would prefer

walking on the left side of the road so that their strong right hand would be free to pull out their swords in case danger arose.

In addition, since they kept their sword sheath to their left, they would avoid hitting people with it as they walked past.

This trend never went away, and when madriving finally came about, the left side continued to be the natural preference.

History of Right-Hand Driving Then how did right-hand driving come about? It is thought to have originated during the French revolution.

The renowned Napoleon
Bonaparte was left handed
and so he would order his

for attack. Overtime, this preference was
adopted in France and spread throughout
the region; however, the Britons and
Japanese, for example, have always driven on
the left-hand side.

Standard design for vehicles in countries that require driving on the left-hand side is to have the driver's seat located on the right side of the vehicle, and vice versa for countries where you drive on the right-hand side. But did you know that there are

countries that allow drivers the option of using either a right- or left-hand vehicle? Most European Union member states in particular allow for registration of RHD and LHD vehicles.

#### Interesting Facts about Left- and Right-Hand Driving

- Bolivia generally requires that traffic drive on the right-hand side except for on one road known as "El Camino de la Muerte" (The Road of Death).
- Rwanda and Burundi are the only East African Community countries still driving on the right-hand side.
- Most of the Lesser Antilles in the Caribbean have LHD private cars, despite the regulation stating that driving is on the left-hand side. This has particularly caused



many accidents in the U.S. Virgin Islands.

#### BP discovers North Sea Oil and Gas

ritish energy major BP has announced oil and gas discoveries in the North Sea, in a boost for the company and local industry. The discoveries were made in Capercaillie in the central North Sea, and in Achmelvich, west of Shetland, the company said in a statement.

BP fully owns the Capercaillie well, while the Achmelvich well is a partnership between operator BP (52.6 percent), Royal Dutch Shell (28 percent) and US peer Chevron (19.4 percent).

The Capercaillie well was drilled to 3,750

meters (12,303 feet) and found oil and gas. The Achmelvich well was drilled to 2,395 meters (7,857 feet) and located oil.

#### France's Dunkirk terminal in first LNG reload

rance's Dunkirk LNG import terminal, the country's fourth regasification facility, has performed its first-ever reloading operation.

The cargo of previously imported liquefied natural gas was loaded onboard Engie's LNG carrier, the 153,000-cbm Provalys. The LNG carrier arrived just a day after the French facility received its first-ever cargo from the Novatek-operated Yamal LNG project in Russia. LNG carrier Provalys left the Dunkirk facility on January 29, Dunkerque LNG, the terminal operator, said in a statement without providing any additional information.

Several media reported that the carrier could be heading towards Engie's Everett LNG terminal in what would be the second shipment of Russian LNG to reach the US following the recent arrival of the Gaselys in Boston.

#### Natural Gas will be world's main fossil fuel by 2040: BP predicts



ritish Petroleum anticipates that natural gas will take over oil as the world's main fossil fuel energy source by the year 2040, according to a new report.

"We see it (gas) take over from coal in the early 2030s... We think there is a very good case for gas actually overtaking oil post 2040 or just before 2040," Dominic Energy, BP's VP for strategic planning said during a

conference in Vienna on Wednesday.

Demand growth for gas—in just China alone—will rise 15 percent year-over-year, while global demand increases by 1.6 percent annually for a number of years. The oil demand curve, on the other hand, will slow to 0.8 percent growth in the meantime. "We do see a very strong chance that (gas) is going to be the largest source of primary energy into the future... By gas we mean natural gas, but

also ... we mean biogas, we mean bio-methane, we mean power-to-gas..." A previous forecast by the U.K.-based company said oil's share of global fossil fuel markets would shrink from 33 percent to 30 percent by 2035. Most of the gains would go to natural gas, which is considered better to the environment due to lower carbon emissions.

#### Don't drive aggressively!





Keeping traffic situation in Pakistan in view, busy and jammed routes might be your every day's fate. Driving on such routes is stressful and disturbing and triggers annoyance and impatience, but aggressive driving is never the answer.

Aggression can be defined as the sequence of behavior, the goal-response to which is the injury of the person toward whom it is directed. Aggression is always a consequence of frustration.

Aggressive driving can be defined as 'a syndrome of frustration-driven behaviors, enabled by the driver's environment'. These behaviors can either take the form of instrumental aggression that allows the

frustrated driver to move ahead at the cost of infringing on other road users' rights (e.g., weaving, running red lights, wrong side travel) or hostile aggression which is directed at the object of frustration (e.g., cursing/honking at other drivers, tailgating, flashing lights).

#### How to avoid becoming a victim?

Product of frustration is nothing but stress and depression for the individual. Following guidelines may help to avoid becoming the victim:

- Keep your emotions in check; don't take your frustrations out on other drivers.
- Plan ahead, allowing enough time for delays
- Focus on your own driving

- Do not tailgate or flash your headlights at another driver.
- Use your horn sparingly.

#### What to do when you encounter an Aggressive Driver:

Your safety is your responsibility. Stick to following guidelines when you encounter an Aggressive Driver:

- Get out of their way.
- Do not challenge them. Don't speed up, try to race, or do anything to aggravate them further.
- Avoid eye contact.
- Ignore gestures, and do not return them.
- If serious, involve local police.






