SSGC is waging an all out war against gas theft, irrespective of the criminals' status. The company is assisted by law enforcement agencies in its raids and strict legal action against the offenders are being taken.

The Gas (Theft Control and Recovery) Act 2016 allows for following privileges to facilitate crackdown on gas theft.

Any officer of SSGC (Grade 17) or equivalent may search any premises suspected of Gas Theft

Gas Theft is cognizable, non-bailable crime

SSGC can ask assistance from any LEA or Agency of Federal or Provincial Govt. during Counter Gas Theft Operations

Establishment of 27 Gas Utility Courts in Sindh and 11 in Balochistan to prosecute Gas Theft Cases

Establishment of police station exclusively to handle Gas Theft

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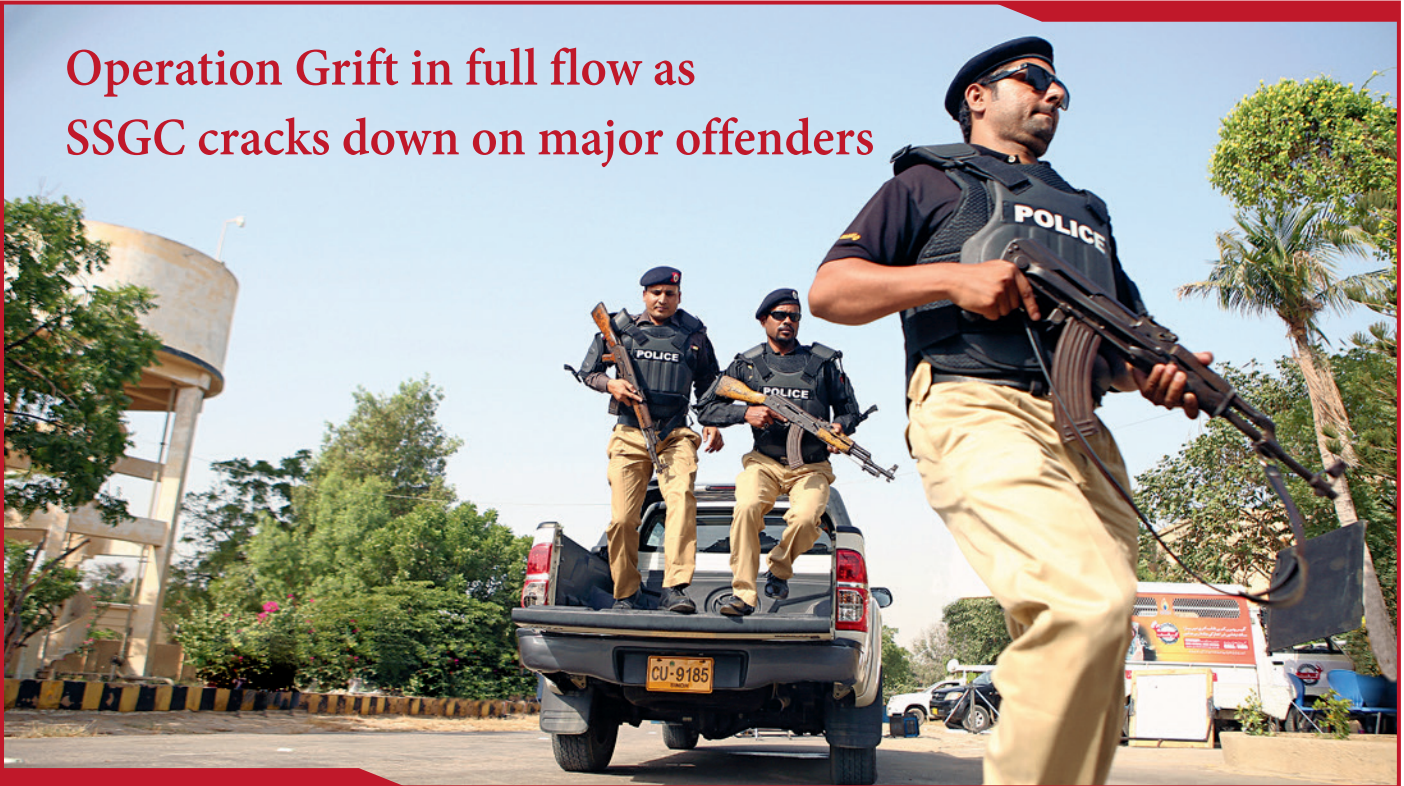

Operation Grift in full flow as SSGC cracks down on major offenders



SSGC's Counter Gas Theft Operations (CGTO) team continued to show zero tolerance to the customers involved in illegal use of gas. As part of Operation Grift, the team conducted several raids recently in Dadu, Sindh and Quetta, Balochistan and made handsome gains.

Three raids were conducted in different areas of Quetta. The first operation was conducted on a tandoor shop where domestic

connection was used to run a commercial business. Another raid was also undertaken on a domestic customer who was found using gas for commercial purpose for running a food joint. The third raid was undertaken on a domestic customer who was using gas for commercial purpose by operating water hydrant.

The CGTO team also carried out a joint raid in Dadu. The offender was found using gas

directly for commercial purposes for power generation by running a 20KW generator in a petrol pump in Johi.

Claims were raised accordingly and FIRs were being lodged against the offenders. Customers were advised to apply for commercial connection of RLNG. ➔

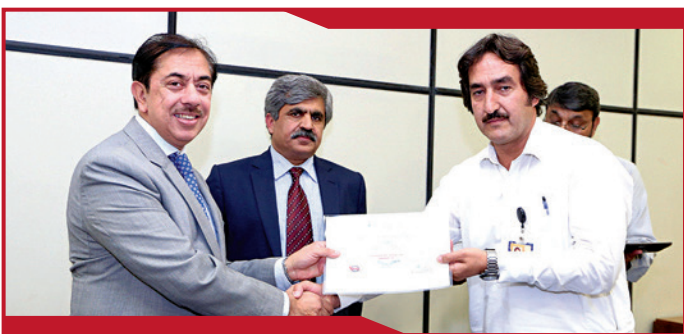
The executives and staff of the Department, led by its DG Brigadier (R) Mohammad Abuzar have emerged as a high precision unit dedicated towards clamping down on gas

theft cases across SSGC's franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan. To applaud and recognize the contribution of top performers in Balochistan and Upper/Lower Sindh Regions, a simple yet impressive Certificate Distribution ceremony entitled 'Performance Excellence Award' was held at the Head Office Auditorium on September 27, 2018.

Eighteen executives were awarded certificates by Amin Rajput, Acting MD, SSGC. The Acting MD and DG (SS and CGTO)

congratulated the executives, sub-ordinate staff and third party officials of the Department for their fine performance but reiterated that still much needs to be done to control rising cases of gas theft.

The occasion also provided an opportunity to discuss the various problems involved in the implementation of Gas Theft and Recovery Act 2016 and helped infuse motivation amongst the SS and CGTO team. 





Intelligence, operation, prosecution

Ever since its inception in July 2017, SSGC's SS and CGTO Department has moved from strength to strength by undertaking raids on domestic, commercial and industrial customers.

The department, with complete cooperation from SSGC Police and other law enforcement agencies has regularly raided commercial units running on domestic connections, factories tampering with regulators to run

their boilers and CNG stations violating off-days.

Around 940 such raids have been taken since July 1, 2017 to date. While 89 FIRs have been filed, 12 offenders have been apprehended and jailed. These focused operations that depend unfailingly on smart intelligence and effective prosecution have helped save to date 994 MMCF gas, which in monetary terms amount to Rs. 755 million. ■

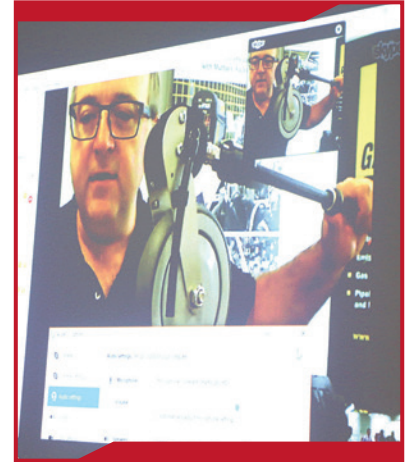

Webinar held on modern leak detection gadgets



On October 1, 2018, the R&D Department in collaboration with SAI International arranged a webinar on Modern Leak Detection Gadgets currently used by gas utility companies. The event was attended by senior managers and engineers from Distribution Karachi and R&D Department.

The webinar was hosted by Mr. Christopher, representative from Gazomat, France. Gazomat specializes in the design, development, manufacturing and servicing of electronic detection equipment for the survey of gas distribution networks, as well as for operator protection in hazardous environments. The Company has an experience of over 25 years in supplying powerful gas detection instruments.

The webinar began with Mr. Christopher giving an overview of the gadgets under the portfolio of Gazomat. He showcased the

latest GAZOCSCAN handheld laser methane detector and explained its features in details.

Key features include tuneable diode laser absorption spectroscopy technology (TDLAS), configurable alarms, 8 hours of operational battery, connectivity with mobile for tracking and logging leak survey coordinates and path, ATEX certified, light weight, option to attach camera and no requirement for routine calibrations. With its quick response time and long range, the device can be most suitable for SSGC Leak Survey Teams.

Mr. Christopher also briefed the participants on the NG-Mesh, another product which uses cellar network to report gas leak status from remote stand-alone locations. It is a methane emissions monitoring system which provides 24/7 monitoring, on-site surveys, report preparation and data storage. The data collected is automatically transferred

securely to the web software, eliminating the need for paper records manual data transcribing and transfer.

Automated notifications and alerts are sent to designated personnel via app when leaks occur over a certain threshold. NG-Mesh can be installed on CMS, SMS and TBS to report potential leaks that can be hazardous. Other products showcased was a bicycle version of Gas Leak Surveying equipment specifically for areas where leak detection vehicle cannot access.

Amir Mumtaz Khan, ASGM (GS), Mohammad Kamran, DGM (R&D) and Salah Uddin, DGM/I/C Distribution Central led the discussions with active cross questioning. ASGM (GS) gave the concluding remarks while thanking Mr. Christopher for his insights. ●

A dinner for SSGC cricket team

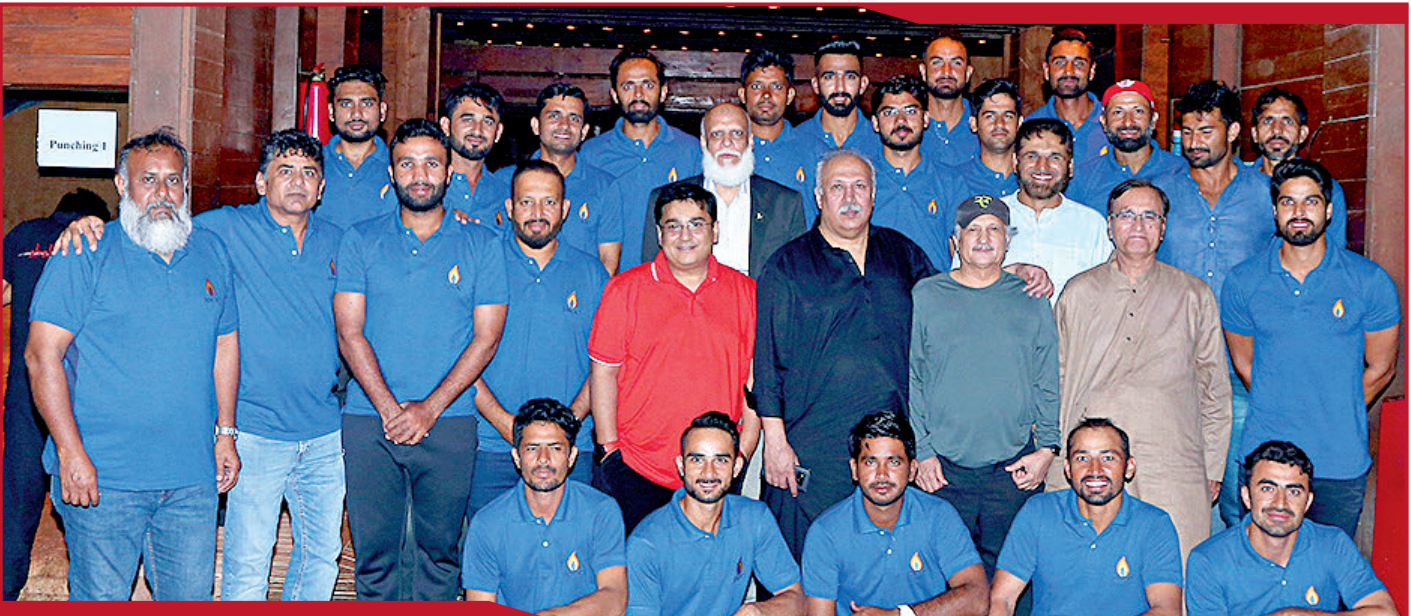

Incident investigation and root cause analysis



Life is more precious than anything in the world, it is irrecoverable, and all efforts should be to save lives around us. It is unfortunate that we always leave everything to Almighty Allah, and remain casual even in our life related foreseeable hazards. Incidents always come uninformed. These are undesired and unplanned events, which leave irrecoverable impacts on the life.

HSE Management system is totally based on risk assessment and management with incident investigation and root cause analysis given due importance in HSE Management

system. Incident investigation and finding root cause is a difficult task, and must be investigated in such a way that same type of incident may not reoccur in future.

It is universally proved that:

- 96% failure comes from people, who have the habit of making excuses
- The first duty of business is to survive and the guiding principle of business economics is not the maximization of profit, it is the avoidance of loss (Peter Drucker)
- All incidents and injuries are preventable, on and off the job.

- 90% incidents at work place are due to human behavior

WHY INVESTIGATION:

- It is a moral obligation
- It is a legal obligation meant to avoid litigations and to present it in Courts, if required
- To identify system failure.
- To identify physical and environmental conditions/failures.
- To determine root cause.

Following are the possible immediate contributing to the causes behind diverse incidents:

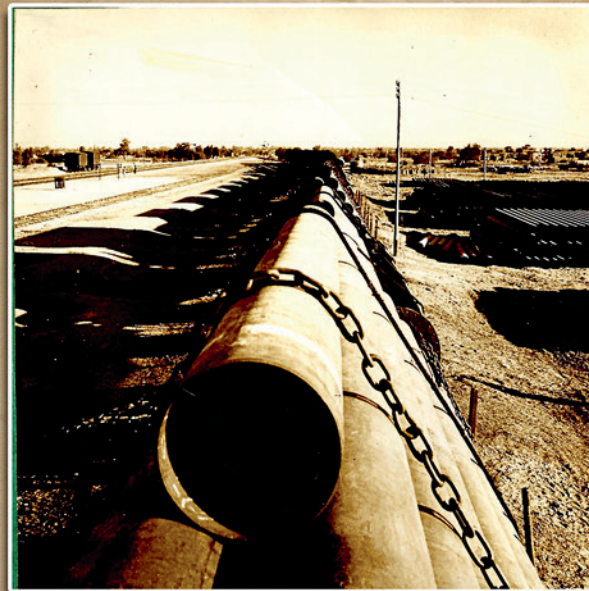
Diabetes and healthy eating - Some pointers

LNG demand on the rise, China supersedes Japan in natural gas imports

China is on track to become the world's largest importer of natural gas this year, overtaking long-standing leaders Japan and South Korea.

The rise in China's imports has had a significant impact on liquefied natural gas (LNG) prices in Asia. Price of LNG has more than doubled to USD 11.20 per million British thermal units (Btu) in July this year from USD 5.45 last December.

China has imported 57.18 million tons of gas from the start of the year to August, overtaking Japan's 56.45 million tons. The rise in demand from China will greatly impact international trade in LNG as such trades are

largely based on long-term contracts. On Monday, Kazakhstan's national gas shipping company KazTransGaz completed a 5-year deal with China's Petrol China to double its natural gas exports to the country to 10 billion cubic meters per year.

Natural gas, which is the cleanest source of fossil fuels is set to play a larger role in China's energy requirements as the country looks to cut down on air pollution. In addition, natural gas is also essential for the development of new energy sources such as solar or wind energy by serving as a backup during certain times when production stalls especially during cloudy weather or lack of wind. Currently, natural gas only accounts for 7% of China's total energy supply. In comparison,

the average usage for most developed economies stand at around 30%, showing the vast potential in China's natural gas market. China hopes to increase natural gas usage to 10% within the next few years with a longer-term target of more than 15% eventually.

Gas production has also been steadily increasing in China by 9% a year over the past decade. Conversely, crude oil production in the country has remained relatively constant over the same period, showing China's determination in working towards cleaner energy. ■

The future of global LNG is here



Clobal liquefied natural gas (LNG) markets have evolved in just a few years, morphing from a somewhat limited supply of the super-cooled fuel as recently as four years ago to an ongoing supply glut that will likely last well into the next decade, perhaps shorter than that if China's procurement of the cleaner burning hydrocarbon continues its current trajectory. However, LNG markets will never be the same again. It all started with Australia's massive LNG project development boom that added more volumes onto markets in the Asia-Pacific region, which accounts for a staggering 72 percent of all global LNG demand, with that number foretasted to tick up to 75 percent soon.

In February 2014, spot prices for LNG in Asia breached the \$20/MMBtu mark creating fiscal angst for major LNG importers,

particularly Japan. Soon after, with prices trending downward, a market reversal for major LNG producers that were used to controlling the shots was underway. They had to scramble to make up for lost revenue as both prices spiraled downward and as LNG buyers were pushing for new shorter term contracts, the removal of restrictive clauses and even the renegotiating of these long term deals.

Concurrently, a secondary market for the super-cooled fuel was also developing, led by Japan and others who were taking advantage of their new found freedom amid a well lubricated market. In essence, buyers were now becoming sellers and creating trading houses, and making the super-cooled fuel trade more like a true commodity, in some aspects similar to the world's top traded commodities crude oil

and iron ore. While it will take several more years for LNG to continue to undergo both fundamental and systemic changes for that to happen, the movement is unstoppable.

In this light, Australian energy firm Woodside said that is signed a provisional deal with German commodities house Uniper to sell 2.4 million tonnes of LNG per year over a four year period, starting in 2019. The LNG will be supplied from Woodside's portfolio sources to markets in Europe and Asia, Woodside Chief Executive Peter Coleman said in the statement. A report in the Australian Financial Review said that this disclosure marked the Australian company's ambitions to enter global trading, which has stretch well beyond its usual market foot print in the Asia-Pacific region. ●

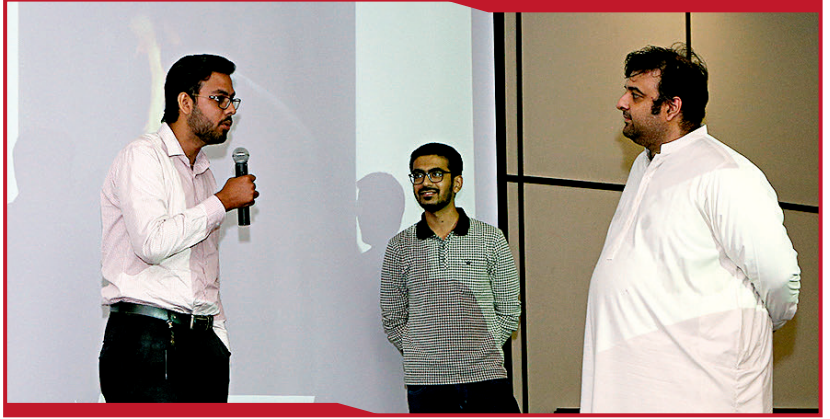

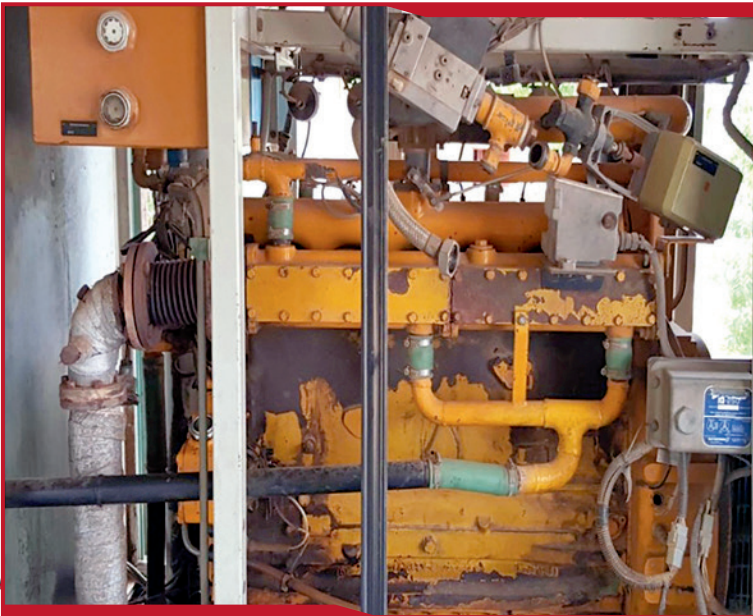
