

# SSGC management briefs Minister of Energy on gas load management plan



hulam Sarwar Khan, Federal Minister for Energy (Petroleum Division) held a meeting with the senior management of SSGC at the Company Head Office on December 14, 2018.

The Minister was given a comprehensive presentation on the Company operations and especially on the issue of Unaccounted-for-Gas (UFG), depletion of indigenous gas supplies and gas load management plan.

During the meeting, Amin Rajput, AMD, SSGC, Mohammad Wasim, DMD (Operations) and Imran Farookhi, DMD (Corporate

Services) discussed many facets of gas load management plan. They emphasized that while SSGC was already facing a shortfall of 180 mmcfd gas with the advent of winter, this deficit was further aggravated due to an additional shortfall of 50 mmcfd gas from Kunnar-Pasaki and Gambat gas fields, thus taking the total shortfall to 230 mmcfd.

The rising shortfall had compelled SSGC to drastically reduce gas to CNG Sector and captive power plants only, the Minister was told. The management dispelled the misconception that the utility has suspended gas supplies to all general industries. The Minister was categorically told that SSGC had

officially notified gas shut down for a period of three months i.e. from December 2018 to February 2019 to captive power plants of industries in October 2018.

The management explained that the notification was in accordance with clause #1 of the Contract for Supply of Gas between SSGC and the captive power customers which states that the latter will have to make dual fire arrangements to avoid loss of production as and when gas is not available during winter seasons. On the other hand, SSGC has continued to supply gas to export oriented, zero-rated and rice exporting industries, the management explained. •

The Minister expressed grave concern at the constant decline in the cumulative indigenous gas supplies which, as the SSGC management explained, will see an average decline rate of 8% per year for the next 10



years. He was told that the projected volume of 1,129 MMCFD for FY 2018-19 is projected to drop to 310 MMCFD for FY 2027-28.

He asked the management to make all



concerted efforts to reduce rising UFG trend.

The Minister said that he expects SSGC management to work closely with the Ministry to curb UFG. •
















#### SSGC determined to resolve gas pressure issues: AMD



SGC is fully conscious about the persistent issue of gas pressure and is making all out efforts to resolve supply and pressure issues in Quetta and other parts of Balochistan. This was stated by Amin Rajput, Acting MD, SSGC during a dinner hosted by SSGC for the notables of Balochistan

The gas utility is installing LPG-Air Mix (Synthetic Natural Gas) Plants in those far flung areas of Balochistan where gas pipelines cannot be laid through conventional arrangement, the AMD reiterated. Provincial Ministers including Zia Langove, Malik Naeem Khan Bazai and assembly members including Syed Fazal

Agha, Mobeen Ahmed Khilji, Akhtar Hussain Langove, Asghar Tareen, Malik Sikandar Khan Advocate and Nasrullah Zeray along with former provincial minister Babu Ameen Umrani and SSGC director Nawabzada Riaz Nosherwani attended the dinner held in a Quetta hotel on December 11, 2018. Apart from AMD, high ranking SSGC officials including Imran Farookhi, DMD (Corporate Services), Saeed Larik. Brigadier (Distribution-North), Mohammad Abuzar, DG (SS and CGTO) and Madni Siddiqui, GM (Distribution-Balochistan) were also present at the dinner.

The notables observed that during the winter season, Balochistan is faced with gas load

shedding and low pressure issues that is causing great inconvenience to its residents. They requested SSGC management to take serious notice of low pressure problems.

The Company management listened to the grievances intently and assured the legislators and other prominent personalities of the province that their issues are and will continue to be taken up seriously.

The AMD said that in order to reduce demand-supply shortfall in Balochistan, SSGC is installing LPG-Air Mix plants in remote regions thus providing the inhabitants with an alternative gas supply source.





# Industrialists assure SSGC of Sunday closure for better line pack



n the backdrop of gas shortfall in Karachi during winter, the industrial bodies and associations of the city held a meeting with the SSGC management in the Company Head Office on December 29, 2018. The SSGC management said that the prevalent crisis was temporary and assured the industrialists that the distribution issues confronted by their business units would be resolved soon. The management pointed out that overall domestic demand as well as huge demand in Balochistan and other areas due



to the winter season have further contributed to the load enhancement.

The meeting was chaired by Amin Rajput, Acting MD. Also present on the occasion were Mohammad Wasim, DMD (Operations), Saeed Larik, SGM (D-North), Kamran Nagi, GM/Incharge (D-South), Amir Mumtaz Khan, ASGM (General Services), Nadeem Qayuum, GM (D-Western Region), Shehryar Kazmi, GM (Billing) and other officials from the Coordination Cell and Corporate

Communications. The associations were led by notable industrialists including Zubair Motiwala and Junaid Makda.

After the meeting, while talking to the media, Mr. Motiwala said that the industrialists understood the issues explained to them by the SSGC management behind the prevalent shortfall and has assured SSGC of full compliance of industrial closure on the following Sunday so that the supply situation or line pack can be further improved.

















## Winter safety media campaign bringing about positive outcome in Balochistan: SSGC



areless use of gas-fired appliances during winters are a cause of unnecessary deaths and injuries especially in the bitterly cold regions. Every year, the Company launches 'Winter Safety Media Campaign' from Balochistan to create awareness about this hazard, through a blend of Below-the-Line and Above-the-Line activities. This year, a number of events were held on December 12 and 13, 2018 in Quetta.

On December 12, 2018, the Company's Corporate Communication Department, in conjunction with Regional Office, Quetta

organized an Ulema Conference at Quetta Press Club as part of their Social Contact Drive. The Conference, featured the local clerics who, as influential opinion leaders emphasized on the safe use of natural gas. They appreciated SSGC's role in stemming the declining trend of the number of deaths and injuries as a result of its safety awareness programs. The eminent clerics and social workers stressed on the customers to avoid gas theft since it was against the very tenets of Islamic beliefs and education. The speakers included Maulana Syed Muhibullah Agha, Allama Syed Hashmi Mosavi, Sayed

Habibullah Chishti, Professor Arshad Yameen, Mufti Muhammad Ahmed Qandhari and social worker Abdul Kakar. In their speeches, SSGC's Madni Arafat Siddiqui, GM (Distribution-Balochistan) and Shahbaz Islam, GM (HR and Corporate Communications) underscored the need to practice safe use of gas. They said that as a result of regular campaigns, there has been a sharp drop in the number of casualties and emphasized that gas theft was a main drain on SSGC's resources and called on Ulema and other opinion makers in Balochistan to discourage it in every forum.













Later in the evening, the organizers held a dinner in honour of media fraternity of Balochistan at a local hotel. SSGC's management represented by Amin Rajput, AMD, Imran Farookhi, DMD (Corporate Services), Saeed Larik, SGM (D-North), Madni Siddiqui, GM (D-Balochistan) and Shahbaz GM (HR and Islam Corporate Communications) addressed the media persons. They appreciated the fact that due to the annual winter safety campaign, the number of causalities from careless use of gas appliances has shrunk during the last couple of years. They thanked the media for propagating the message about taking

precautionary measures to the customers, with the result that so far no death has been reported from callous use of gas from anywhere in Balochistan, this winter.

In their remarks, President Quetta Press Club Raza Rehman and President of Balochistan Union of Journalists Khalil Ahmed pointed out at incidents of issues of low gas pressure in Quetta and other adjacent areas.

The MD assured them that the management of SSGC is closely looking into the issue of low pressure and is taking practical steps such as expanding transmission infrastructure across

Balochistan as well as setting up LPG-Air Mix plants to ensure uninterrupted gas supply to an ever increasing customer base.

On the 13th of December, the Campaign was formally launched from the Regional Office Quetta. The senior management, executives and staff took a collective oath to continue with its mission to propagate safe and wise use of gas to the masses.

The launch featured a roll out of around twenty newly branded 1199 Emergency vehicles that carried relevant messages related to gas theft and winter safety.

#### No respite for gas thieves



n a tip off from reliable sources, the Operations Wing of SSGC's Security Services and Counter Gas Theft Operations (SS and CGTO) Department conducted a joint raid on a fast food outlet, Pearl Fast Food in Khokrapar Malir.

The Wing, accompanied by the representatives of the Company's Customer Relations Department (CRD), DSM, SSGC police and FIR Cell conducted the raid on the outlet on December 26, 2018.

During the crackdown, it was observed that this already disconnected registered business unit was consuming gas directly through rubber pipe from the meter point.

Total load obtained was 745 cubic feet per hour (cf/hr). The team dismantled the direct connection. Summarily, culprit Saqib was arrested from the spot and FIR was lodged.

Accompanied by the same team, that day CGTO's Intelligence wing also raided a hotel in Karachi's Old Town area of Nanakwara in Saddar.

The team observed that a registered customer was found using gas directly through a rubber pipe for running the hotel. Total load obtained was 560 cf per hour.

The team removed the meter and disconnected the gas supply. While FIR was

registered, the SSGC Police is on the hunt to arrest the absconder.

Operation Grift, the Company's anti-gas theft drive has proved to be a major deterrence against gas thieves since it kicked off in July 2017.

SSGC will not show any leniency towards any gas thief, no matter how influential the person is and will ensure that his rightful place is behind bars. Natural gas is a national resource and it is incumbent on each one of us to conserve it. Gas theft is a crime against community and SSGC seeks support of every citizen in nabbing the culprits.

#### One arrested as anti-gas theft raids intensify

SSGC tightened its noose on gas thieves by conducting a number of raids during the last few days in its franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan.

As per the directives of the higher management, a joint inspection-cum-raid was undertaken in New Khan Super Shaheen Shinwari Restaurant located in Malir Cantonment, Karachi by the representatives of SSGC's Measurement, Sales and Security Services and Counter Gas Theft Operations Department (SS and CGTO) departments along with SSGC Police and FIR Cell teams.

The team observed that the owner of the hotel was stealing gas through direct line. Restaurant owner named Muhammad Sabir s/o Muhammed Tahir was using 650 CFT/ HR gas.

The raiding party disconnected the rubber pipes and other material being used in theft

and arrested Muhammad Sabir.

The SS and CGTO Department, Nawabshah carried out a raid in Bahria City Nawabshah where the culprit was using domestic gas connection for commercial power generation by reversing the gas meter.

The team disconnected the theft network, with theft load to be charged accordingly.

Similarly, a raid carried out on KDA Flats, Gulshan Shiraz, Surjani Town, Karachi where gas thieves were stealing gas illegally by using rubber pipes which were confiscated, with theft load to be charged accordingly.

Crackdown against such culprits will be more intensified in the future since rising theft cases badly affect the Company's financial position.

# Riding for success - SSGC wins silver in National Track Cycling Championships





SGC emerged as the top three teams in the local cycling circuit when it earned the Silver Medal on conclusion of the four-day National Track Cycling Championship 2018 held at the Lahore Cycling Velodrome. The event, held under the aegis of Pakistan Cycling Federation was organized by SSGC. Pakistan Army secured gold while WAPDA had to be contented with a bronze medal. Apart from the top three winners, the championship featured men and women cyclists from POF Wah, HEC, Islamabad and four provincial teams. The top three teams also dominated the individual and team contests during these four days. In the 3-lap Sprint Finals, Shakeel of SSGC won the gold medal while Arsalan and Zahid of Pakistan Army won silver and bronze medals respectively.

Rider Abdul Razzaq of SSGC won the 4-km Men's Individual Pursuit race, successfully reaching the finish line in 5 minutes and 4 seconds. The 2nd and 3rd spots were secured by Arsalan Anjum of Pakistan Army and Izzat Ullah of WAPDA who lost to the SSGC winner by a difference of one and two seconds respectively. On the other hand, while the 1,000 meter Team Sprint finals was won by WAPDA, Pakistan Army and SSGC, respectively, in the 1000-meter Individual Time Trial contest, Arsalan (WAPDA), Izzat Ullah (Pakistan Army) and Shakeel (SSGC) won the first three spots in a closely contested race. The 30-laps Omnium finals was won by Arsalan while Waheed and Razzaq of SSGC secured 2nd and 3rd places.

The event was inaugurated by Amer Tufail, DMD SNGPL. Lt. Colonel (R) Shoaib Ahmed, Secretary SSGC Sports Board and other SSGC officials welcomed the chief guests and riders from across Pakistan. Imran Farookhi, DMD (Corporate Services) SSGC was chief guest on the 2nd day of the event.









n auction is a sale process in which potential buyers place competitive bids on assets or services. The open ascending price auction is the most common form of auction being used today. An auctioneer may announce prices, bidders may call out their bids openly against one another and the bids continue to increase (increments). The bidders know the competing bid amounts and continues its bid decisions until it either is declared the winner of the auction or drops out of the auction. However, if the seller has set a minimum sale price in advance (the reserve price) and the final bid does not reach that price the item remains unsold.

Disposal Section of Stores Department led by Chief Engineer(Stores) primarily engaged in

disposal of retired vehicles, fixed assets and scrap materials through open auction activities. The objective of Disposal Section is to maintain transparency in the process of disposing off material during the entire auction process. Disposal executives are also a part of inspection team for material declared as retired by user Department comprising of fixed assets and scrap materials. Disposal Section's scope is to coordinate with various departments during the entire process of auction. Scope of Disposal Section is also extended to receipt of retired vehicles/assets alongwith all requisite documentation and formalities from internal SSGC user departments.

Previously selection of auctioneer was arranged through open tendering who used

to charge hefty services charges i.e 8-9 lacs per auction. Mr. Khalid Hussain Bhutto, DM(Disposal) voluntarily took over the charge as "Auctioneer" resultantly saving substantial amount in every auction.

It is worth mentioning here that performing duty as auctioneer is an exclusive and diverse job which requires natural ability to persuade bidders, capability to speak extempore in front of audience, stamina to stand and speak for long hours till the culmination of auction activities. Mr. Bhutto showed excellent communication skills and consistently outshined company's revenue due to in depth knowledge of auction activities, operating procedures and existing market trends.

The most significant distinguishing factor of open auction is that the current highest bid is always available to potential bidders. The process starts by inviting multiple buyers to the auction. More prospective buyers usually translates to competitive bidding that pushes the price higher, enabling the company to maximize its profit from the sale. Over the past 5 years Disposal Section of Stores Department has been playing a pivotal role in organizing open auction activities at KT Store. The historical trend clearly indicates the success of open auction activities which lead to swell the revenue growth in the SSGC book of accounts during subsequent years. Corporate Social Responsibility, for most organizations, is usually the last item on the agenda after ensuring a healthy bottom-line. However, time has proven that organizations that pay much attention to it while pursuing profits stay around for much longer. Over the last 50 years, environmentalists and social justice advocates have fought for the expansion of the traditional 'bottom line' in business to include more than figures.

To this end, the Triple Bottom Line concept of "profit, people, and planet" was developed for gauging the overall success of any business. The term 'Corporate Social Responsibility' which became popular in the 1960s refers to the responsibility of companies to positively impact their environment, customers, employees, stakeholders and members of the general public.

Since early 2000s, when SSGC first started investing in CSR related projects, the Company has demonstrated that profit taking and responsible corporate citizenship need not be mutually exclusive. As a premier public sector utility, SSGC is responsible for providing uninterrupted gas supply to its customers across Sindh and Balochistan. Being a responsible entity, SSGC is obligated by the Regulatory Authority to allocate a reasonable sum to undertake CSR-driven initiatives. Since 2004, the Company has been committed towards this objective with the mindset and motivation to reach out to maximum possible stakeholders. The Company has dedicatedly invested in projects in the areas of education, healthcare, environment and community development in its franchise areas of Sindh and Balochistan. Need analysis, scopina, planning, site surveys and execution of each CSR-related project are carried out either on solo basis or through strategic local partnerships with key governmental, non-governmental, not-for educational and health institutions. In many of the projects and especially of the brick and mortar type, the services of the Civil Works Department are taken into account. The Company's collaborative partners in CSR activities are reputed educational and healthcare institutions and established NGOs, who share with it the same vision of making a tangible difference in the lives of the communities whose cause we take up.

To ensure swift delivery, maximum on ground impact and sustainability of social investments, all executions occur after due interventions and mutual agreement with stakeholders. The implementation of CSR projects is carried out in two basic ways; one, by providing monetary support to organizations of high repute, adequate local presence and relevant experience. These organizations approach the CSR Unit and submit their proposals. These proposals are then reviewed to assess the need, scope and impact of that particular project on the community. The second approach involves providing brick and mortar support to educational institutions. In addition, scholarships are provided to deserving and meritorious students of the Company's franchise areas. Before embarking on any project, the CSR Unit studies and investigates the proposals received, carries out the required assessments and monitors the projects in terms of progress, delivery and impact on the beneficiaries. At the end of the day, cohesion, consistency and transparency are ensured.

There is complete dedication in every initiative that SSGC takes on the CSR front, be it in the area of education, health, environment and community development. The major CSR focus and hence the biggest share of the budgetary pie has always been on educational initiatives. In the beginning, the concentration was primarily on monetary and brick and mortar support to educational institutions for giving them a new lease of life through renovation of their structures and equipping them with required paraphernalia such as computers and furniture. Then SSGC moved on to providing scholarships to meritorious and deserving students enrolled in reputed institutions such as IBA, IoBM,

LUMS, NED, MUET, QUEST, IBA Sukkar and BUITEMS. Many of these students who belonged to marginalized communities, are now gainfully employed and following their passion.

In the recent times, SSGC have expanded its support to aid institutions such as The Hunar Foundation that works towards ensuring skilled-based employment. At the same time it collaborates with institutions such as Family Educational Services Foundation (FESF) and Markaz-e-Umeed to make disabled and special children self-sufficient. Similarly, in the field of healthcare, SSGC has partnered with NGOs like Marie Adelaide Leprosy Centre (MALC), SIUT and Edhi Foundation and is proud of the fact that they are a part of our CSR repertoire. In the area of environment and community development, SSGC is undertaking sustainable projects with positive long-term impact. The Company has collaborated with IUCN in its drive to conserve mangroves by planting samplings, embarked on projects with Thardeep Rural Programme Program that were aimed at providing clean drinking water through dug-wells and with WWF for setting collaborated up bio-gas plants at localities in District Thatta. SSGC has been very conscious about a sense of deprivation that exists in Balochistan and many of its CSR projects are aimed at the marginalized communities of areas across Balochistan.

As always, in the very event they pursued to create awareness about the distinctive abilities of these special needs children


through tableau and dance performances. They honored these children by understanding and accepting their existence and celebrating their achievements and contributions with the corporate guests they always invite on such occasions.

The Mehfil was adroitly conducted by Chief Manager (Media Relations), Muhammad Ali Gohar.





## Pakistan, World Bank sign \$100 million agreement for 'Sindh Solar Energy Project'

he government of Pakistan and WB signed a Financing Agreement worth \$100 million for "Sindh Solar Energy

Project" with the objective to increase solar power generation and access to electricity in Sindh Province.

The project will support the deployment of solar power in Sindh spanning three market segments: utility scale, distributed generation, and at the household level.

Utility-Scale Solar includes development of solar parks to support private sector

investment and launching of Pakistan's first competitive bidding for solar power production, starting with an initial 50 MW pilot solar auction.

Distributed Solar includes at least 20 MW of distributed solar PV on the rooftops and other available space on and around public sector buildings in Karachi, Hyderabad and other districts of Sindh Province.

Provision of Solar Home Systems to 200,000 households in areas with low or no electricity

The total cost of the project is \$105.0 million. The International Development Association (IDA) will extend financing of \$ 100.0 million for the project and Government of Sindh will contribute \$ 5.0 million.

Public funding will be used to leverage private sector investment and/or expertise in the three segments, with an emphasis on long-term sustainability, developing domestic solar PV experience, and the emergence of self-sustaining markets.

#### 2019 - A record breaking year for LNG?



018 has seen a rise in the importance of environmentalism and the overall attention for cleaner energy sources. In contrast to the unilateral U.S. withdrawal from the Paris Climate Agreement, the rest of the world is increasingly unified in its determination to counter global warming. The relative clean nature of natural gas and its abundance has made it an ideal source of energy to replace dirtier coal and supplement renewables. 2019 will see a record number of LNG projects reach their final investment decision moment (FID). However, a couple of projects have a higher chance of receiving a green light due to political, economic, and geographic reasons.

The global LNG market has steadily gained in size while the focus of attention has significantly moved to the east where seven LNG buyers account for more than half of the global market:

- CNOOC (China)
- CPC (Taiwan)
- JERA (Japan)
- KOGAS (South Korea)

- PetroChina
- · Sinopec (China)
- Tokyo Gas (Japan)

Furthermore, demand in the Asia-Pacific region is set to grow another 60 percent to reach 337 mtpa by 2030. In comparison, the size of the global market excluding Asia is only 75 mtpa currently. The major factor driving expansion is China which was responsible for 50 percent of last year's global demand growth. It is expected that Chinese LNG demand will continue growing as the Asian country aims for cleaner skies over its cities and a lower-emission economy. According to Wood Mackenzie director Nicholas Browne "market liberalization and uncertainty on longer-term demand in more mature markets, such as Japan, South Korea, and Taiwan, will mean more room for spot and short-term purchases, while oil indexation will continue to dominate the markets due to familiarity and ability to hedge". Increasingly global sales are more spot market driven which benefits certain producers such as U.S. based companies.

Despite changes on the demand side, announcements on the supply side promise to have an even bigger impact in 2019. While the number of projects being sanctioned is similar to the last couple of years, the capacity of the facilities is different. The average development to receive an FID in 2019 is over twice the size of the projects in the preceding years. According to Wood Mackenzie, the following projects are considered the "frontrunners":

- · Novatek's Arctic-2 in Russia
- · One or more projects in Mozambique
- Three U.S. projects
- "Expansion and backfill projects" in Australia and Papua New Guinea

These investments alone warrant a total capital investment of over \$50 billion. This number doesn't yet even include the expansion of Qatar's LNG industry which lifted its self-imposed moratorium on the world's single largest gas field, North Dome. •




