he HR department organized a 2-day training program for the senior management of the Company on "Ethical Business Dealings, Conflict of Interest and Benefits of Good Corporate Governance" in line with the Board mandate to facilitate transformation of SSGC to a dynamic and well managed ethically and professionally run organization with high standard of corporate governance. Since the training program was for two days, it was carried out in two batches with a session for first batch held on 29th and 30th October and for the second batch carried out on 3rd and 4th December, 2019 in a Karachi hotel. The sessions were facilitated by distinguished faculty members from the Pakistan Institute of Corporate Governance (PICG) including Mr. Feroz Rizvi, Mr. Tariq Ikram and Mr. Badar Vellani. The sessions focused on the various facets and role of corporate governance in public sector organizations while emphasizing on the need for ethics and compliance with corporate laws and regulations. The workshop included role plays, case study and brain storming sessions.













Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah – A Leader, a Visionary and an Inspiration

ohammad Ali Jinnah was a man of great wisdom and intellect. Born on December 25, 1876, he envisioned the creation of Pakistan which turned into reality on 14th August 1947.

The eldest of seven siblings, Jinnah got the chance to attend London through an internship offered placed by his father's colleague, Sir Frederick Leigh Croft. Eager to accept the offer, Jinnah jumped on the bandwagon and headed off to London, where he eventually joined Lincoln's Inn, a renowned legal association that aided law students in studying and preparing for the bar. In May of 1896, Jinnah passed the bar exam, the youngest ever to have done so. After a couple of months, he returned to Bombay where he set up his own legal practice, and continued to work until 1945.

During his stay in London, Jinnah had frequently visited the House of Commons, which attracted him to politics. After returning to Bombay, along with his legal career, he started making a name for himself in politics, and eventually became an

Ambassador for Hindu Muslim unity while being a member of Congress. Initially, he believed that the rights of Muslims could be protected in a united India, however, with the passage of time, Jinnah realized that in order to preserve Muslims' traditions and protect their political interests, a separate Muslim homeland was a necessity.

During a 1940 meeting of the Muslim League at Lahore, Jinnah proposed the partition of India and the creation of Pakistan, in the area where Muslims constitute a majority. At this juncture, Jinnah was both displeased with Mohandas Gandhi's stance at the London Round Table Conference in 1939, and frustrated with the Muslim League. Much to Jinnah's chagrin, the Muslim League was on the verge of merging with the National League, with the goal of participating in provincial elections and potentially conceding to the establishment of a united India with majority Hindu rule.


To Jinnah's relief, in 1942 the Muslim League adopted the Pakistan Resolution to partition India into serveral states. Four years later,

Britain sent a cabinet mission to India to outline a constitution for transfer of power to India. India was then divided into three territories. The first was a Hindu majority, which makes up present-day India. The second was a Muslim area in the northwest, to be designated as Pakistan. The third was made up of Bengal and Assam, with a narrow Muslim majority. After a decade, the provinces would have the choice of opting out on the formation of a new federation. But when the Congress president expressed objections to implementing the plan, Jinnah also voted against it. The independent state of Pakistan that Jinnah had envisioned came to be on August 14, 1947. The following day, Jinnah was sworn in as Pakistan's first Governor-general. He was also made President of Pakistan's Constituent Assembly shortly before his death.


Jinnah was a visionary leader who foresaw the future and realized the need for a separate state for Muslims. Quaid-e-Azam is the embodiment of resilience, passion, and true leadership who made Pakistan happen.






















Major achievement: CC&B ver 2.4 goes live



racle Customer Care & Billing (CC&B) was rolled out in SSGC in 2007. Since then it is running the core Gas Utility Billing Engine and Customer Care business processes and is the face of the Company to our 3 million valued customers across Sindh and Balochistan provinces.

CC&B is undoubtedly the most business-critical and the bread-earning application of SSGC and hence it requires due care in terms of software upgrades and skillset enhancement of technical staff to ensure that such a critical application runs smoothly and serves the business and our customers round-the-clock without any interruptions.

CC&B was running at ver 2.3 in SSGC and was supported by its OEM (Oracle) through the Extended Support model which was scheduled to expire in 2019, after which Oracle's Sustaining Support model was to continue indefinitely.

IT Department took up the initiative to formulate a project team and get this critical application service upgraded so that the business could benefit from a newer version and a better support model from Oracle.

Hence a project team as per instructions from ASGM-IT (Mujtaba Ahmed) was established under the leadership of DGM-IT (Murtaza Lightwala) with approval from top management. This project team consisted of IT's CC&B and Database/System Administration sections. Due to the technological leap, Oracle Pakistan and their business partners were consulted to explore their offerings regarding project consultancy technical services.

It was learnt that technical consultancy model for the upgrade would mostly be remote through resources sitting abroad as there was lack of in-country expertise to offer technical consultancy for CC&B upgrade and the cost of which was exorbitant (circa US\$ 850k). With this challenge, CC&B Project team

decided to explore in-house upgrade opportunity and after some internal technical discussions and brain-storming sessions, project team decided to upgrade CC&B to version 2.4 using in-house resources only.

Project team followed industry-recognized best practices and hence it was registered on Oracle Primavera followed by weekly team meetings to track progress on project deliverables.

Existing IT resources in CC&B and Database/System Administration sections have extensive experience of a decade (on average) operating CC&B and hence with enhanced motivation and boost of confidence they established the test environment of CC&B 2.4 (multiple iterations) where in-house tests (including Functional tests) of customer billing and all business processes automated through CC&B were thoroughly tested and identified technical issues were rectified accordingly. All this work was done in-house without procuring any external technical consultancy.

Project team conducted successful User Acceptance Testing (UAT) of CC&B ver 2.4 test environment in Q2 2019 following which full load testing of CC&B ver 2.4 was also launched in Q3 2019 to give another opportunity to all CC&B users to test the upgraded version's performance on full load and also to get more familiar with the new version.

Finally, after completing all core tasks and pre-requisites of the upgrade project, top management's approval was sought to upgrade CC&B to ver 2.4 after completion of October 2019 billing cycle and notifications to senior management and CC&B users were sent regarding the cutover schedule.

CC&B ver 2.3 was brought offline at night on November 7, 2019 and upgrade to the ver 2.4 was completed on the auspicious day of 12th Rabi-ul-Awwal (November 10, 2019) and that was when CC&B ver 2.4 went live in SSGC. Top management (specifically AMD and DMD-CS) and user departments were very supportive throughout, without which this business-critical upgrade would not have been possible.

The success story did not end here. Considering the criticality of CC&B application and its business importance, heightened monitoring and bubble support was immediately activated to ensure CC&B users do not face any technical issues while using the new version and reported issues (if any) are timely addressed.

At the end of November 2019 billing month, Post Project review was conducted where it was concluded that all business processes have successfully executed in CC&B ver 2.4 and the system has performed smooth operations along with improved user satisfaction and improved system response times (including very critical daily billing nightly streams).

Notably, no major issues related to any functionality or feature of CC&B ver 2.4 were reported by user departments since going live.

SGC is currently working on completing two gas pipelines that will help to mitigate the current gas demand-supply gap in Sindh and particularly in its largest load center Karachi.

The Company is presently working on completing 12" dia x 46 km line and the 8" dia. x 28 kms line that will inject additional volumes of gas into SSGC's system. The


commissioning of these two lines, will substantially help to bridge the demand-supply gap that the customers are confronted with in this winter season.






SSGC ladies also dominated the senior women event winning the first position while Punjab finished second.

company employees were present on the occasion. The arrangements were managed by the Meter Plant Department. •







HONEY

OGDCL uncovers oil and gas reserves in Sindh

il and Gas Development Company Ltd (OGDCL) has found new oil and gas reserves following drilling activities in potential areas of Sindh during exploration of Shale gas and Tight oil deposits, on Saturday.

According to local news channel reports, the sources familiar with the matter told the

media that authorities expect presence of 95 trillion cubic feet (TCF) Shale gas and 14 billion of stock tank barrels (BSTB) oil in place resources. The gas reserves are enough to fulfill the country's needs for 90 years.

Earlier in October, the company discovered oil and gas reserves at its Exploratory Well Tog number 1 in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa's (KP)

Kohat district. According to a preliminary test, the well could produce 50 Barrel per Day (BPD) of crude oil, and 4.1 Million Standard Cubic Feet per Day of (MMSCFD) gas.

The OGDCL had said that the discovery would increase hydrocarbon reserves in the country and the discovery would also have positive impact on the country's economy.





he world is still making huge oil discoveries. There's just nothing conventional about them.

Conventional oil and gas discoveries have fallen by the wayside since the shale boom and the subsequent oil price collapse. In fact, they've fallen to their lowest in 70 years. But there are still some amazing discoveries in the mysterious deep.

#1 Russia - 1.5 Bboe in Russian Arctic Waters Russia has discovered nearly 1.5 billion barrels of oil equivalent (Bboe) thanks to the Dinkov and Nyarmeyskoye finds on the Yamal peninsula shelf in the Kara Sea. In natural gas terms, that's a whopping 17 trillion cubic feet (Tcf).

#2 Guyana: More Than 6 Billion Barrels, And Climbing

ExxonMobil just put Guyana on the oil and gas map for the first time.

It's not just a big discovery; it's a huge discovery. In fact, it's a string of 14 discoveries so far - just from Exxon. Tullow Oil has also announced two discoveries.

Prior to the last three discoveries listed below, Guyana had already hit 6 billion barrels of oil equivalent in the Stabroek Block.

Then came these in rapid succession:

- Discovery No. 14: Tripletail-1, Exxon.
- Discovery No. 15: Jethro-1, Tullow

 Discovery No. 16: Joe-1, Tullow The potential for Guyana is huge, with some estimating Guyana's future production at 750,000 within the next five years

#3 Cyprus: Up to 8 trillion cubic feet of disputed gas

In February, Exxon made the biggest natural gas discovery in two years off the coast of Cyprus.

Exxon discovered an estimated 5-8 trillion cubic feet, which the European Union is greedily eyeing as a pathway to a new Mediterranean gas hub that will reduce Russian dominance in the region.






