



SSGC contributes Rs. 30 million to COVID-19 Relief Fund

SGC contributed Rs. 30 million to PM's COVID-19 Relief Fund. The announcement to this effect was made by Chairperson SSGC Dr. Shamshad Akhtar during the Ehsaas Telethon transmission that went on air in a number of Pakistani channels in late April 2020.

SSGC achieves more prosecution success

The honourable judge (District and Sessions Judge) of Gas Utility Court in Karachi West recently dismissed the bail of an accused name Javed for stealing gas directly from the main line and sent him back to the jail custody.

Meanwhile, on the direction of Gas utility Court/ Session Judge Larkana, two accused namely Zohaib Ahmed and Waqar Ahmed submitted theft claims, in favor of SSGC. FIR was lodged against the two accused as per (Gas Theft Control and Recovery Act), 2016, in the jurisdiction of Agra District Khairpur Police Station for illegally using gas for ice factory. In the 4th post arrest bail application, Allah Muhammad who was charged with illegal direct connection of gas for running a restaurant, submitted the remaining theft claim towards the final settlement of quantum of loss to SSGC. FIR was lodged against the accused in Karachi. Three earlier bail applications of accused were rejected by the Honourable Court.

The Honorable High Court of Sindh Bench Larkana of Honorable Justice confirmed bail application of accused Irfan Ali Abro on the directions of High Court after the accused deposited the quantum of loss in favour of SSGC. FIR was lodged against the accused for running an ice factory on the commercial basis through direct gas from SSGC's service line.

The Prosecution Wing of the SS and CGTO department argued the cases. The three joint survey teams comprising of the the representatives of the Company's Measurement, Sales, and SS &CGTO Departments, carried out detailed inspection of some eight factories in Karachi. Detailed reports are being initiated for necessary actions by Sales, Measurement and Billing Departments for violations of Gas Sales Agreements, Extra Connected Load and meter size, to be addressed by given timelines.

The Technical Wing of Security Services and Counter Gas Theft Operations (SS and CGTO) team carried out a technical analysis of cyber locks, industrial meters and EVCs as part of Operation Grift, the Company's anti-gas theft campaign, in seven industrial units in Karachi's Eastern Zone. All pre-programmed locks, after reconfiguration were installed and EVCs of three of the units were found malfunctioning. Field Activities were created in the system for Measurement Departments to rectify faults and process short billing claims.


SGC is responding promptly to customer complaints even during these tough times.

SGC has made it a point to ensure all its executives and workers on the field strictly follow guidelines for


protecting themselves and people around them from COVID-19. Recently, Anwar Baloch ADGM (D)/HOSBU and Sardar Khan Badani,



The Iron Lady - Asma is alive in our hearts

I believe that the Almighty chooses special people to test them with hardships and I am one of them - Asma Butt

n the night of April 7, 2020, SSGC lost a real fighter. One of the most respected members of the SSGC fraternity, Asma Butt left for heavenly abode. She had battled her way through myriad difficulties and successfully beat the deadly disease of cancer twice. In doing so, Asma became a source of inspiration for many around her. She didn't just carry out her routine tasks as In-charge of MD's Secretariat. She was the President of SSGCWA, the association she effectually used for helping female employees polish their abilities and resolve their issues while standing on their own two feet. Asma struggled indefatigably for the empowerment of female employees and via SSGCWA gave them a platform to stand up and be counted.

She was a teenager, studying in eighth grade, when her father, having suffered from ill health, passed away. Soon after her father's death, Asma Butt, being the eldest of three siblings, took it upon herself to support her siblings and widowed mother. Her burden eased to an extent when she landed a job at a private company after her graduation. A few more jobs later, in the early 2000s she began her stint at SSGC as a human resource executive and in a short span of time, earned the acclaim of her superiors due to her



dedication and hard work. It was not long before she was chosen to assist the Company's senior management. Asma's impressive professional growth came about against a backdrop of grave personal tragedies. She lost her husband of heart attack just three and a half years into the marriage. She was shattered yet life for her had to go on. Instead of lamenting the loss for long, she once again began her battle against all odds. Asma resumed her education, completed her MBA and all this time, continued with her day job at SSGC as its active member. Nevertheless, her struggle was not to end yet.

In 2015 she was diagnosed with cancer. She had two choices – one to give up and the


other to beat it. She selected the second option. Asma went through many painful chemotherapy sessions while remaining on leave from work for several months. By the time her treatment ended, she was exhausted yet undefeated. She used her struggle against cancer to inspire other men and women fighting the deadly disease. She was a member of a cancer support group at AKUH, inspiring others to brave cancer. She narrated her experience of battling the disease in seminars. All this time she led SSGCWA ably while enthusiastically playing a pivotal role in bringing into fore issues such as environment preservation and women's rights through symposiums and speakers' sessions inside and outside SSGC.

A couple of years ago, she was diagnosed with the deadly disease again. This time around, it had affected her liver. The experience was more painful and exhausting than the previous one, and the treatment more intense. Yet she battled on, only to lose the battle on the night of April 7, 2020. The indomitable will and the resilience Asma displayed during her lifetime is something SSGC will never forget. Asma, you will always be in our hearts. For inspiration, we will always look up to you.

andemic on course to cause largest decrease in emissions ever recorded, six times larger than the previous record drop in 2009 following global financial downturn, says International Energy Agency.

Global energy demands are set to plunge amid the worst shock to the sector in 70 years due to the coronavirus crisis, with fossil fuels on course for a historic decline and renewables set to gather greater momentum, according to the world's energy watchdog.

The International Energy Agency said the world's CO2 emissions are expected to fall by 8 per cent this year as a result of the pandemic, which has shut down much of the global economy and caused a collapse in energy demand seven times greater than the decline after the 2008 global financial crisis.

The IEA's Global Energy Review projects that energy demand will fall 6 per cent in 2020, which the agency described as "unprecedented", and "the equivalent of losing the entire energy demand of India". Renewable electricity is forecast to be the

only energy source resilient to the enormous slump caused by the pandemic and the only area expected to see growth in 2020.

"This is a historic shock to the entire energy world. Amid today's unparalleled health and economic crises, the plunge in demand for nearly all major fuels is staggering, especially for coal, oil and gas.

Only renewables are holding up during the previously unheard of slump in electricity use," said IEA executive director Dr Fatih Birol.


